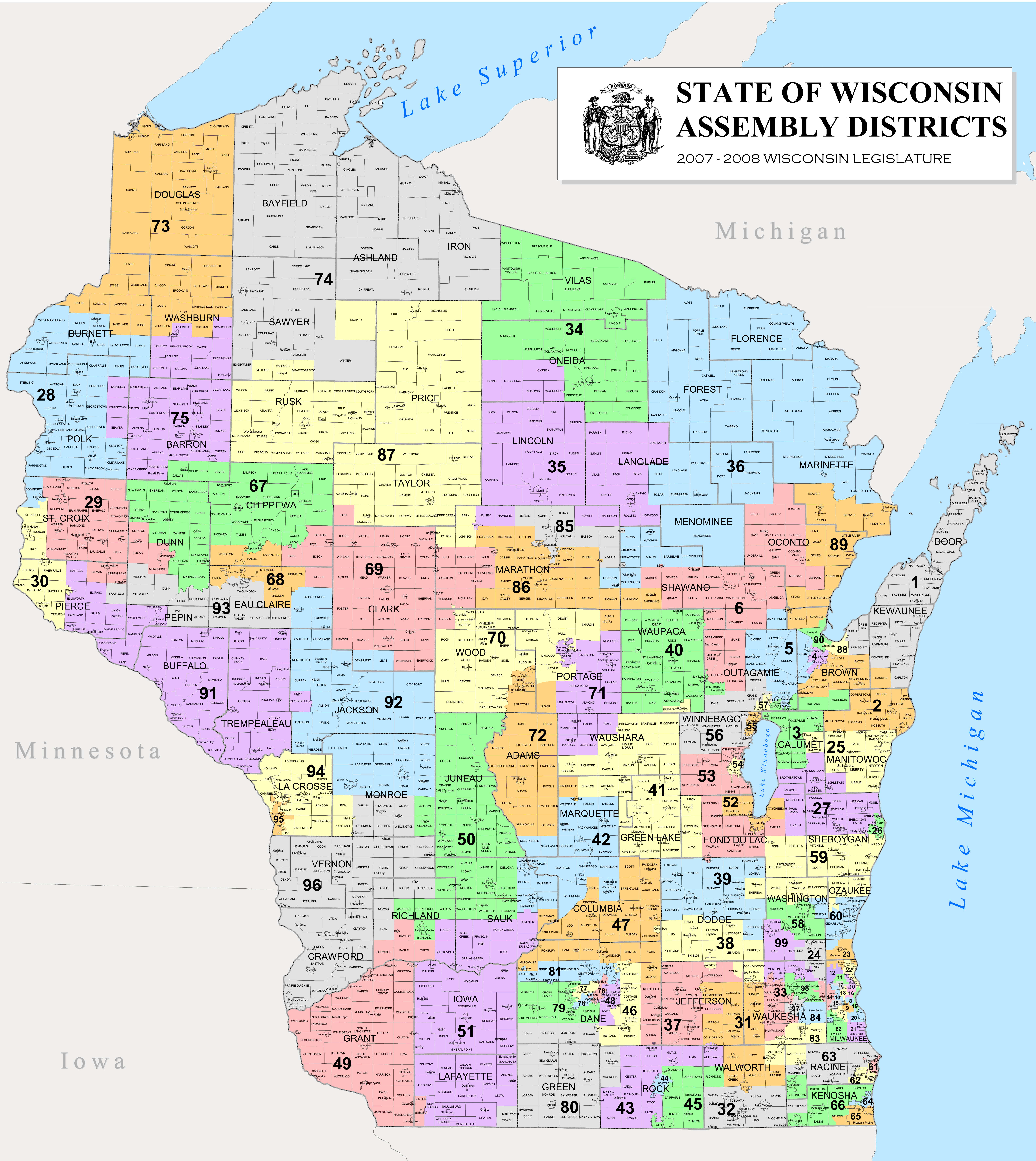


STATE OF WISCONSIN ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS
