Information Paper

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Requirement.

Program initiated in response to guidance from Commandant of the Marine Corps (CMC) for development of an improved PT uniform. CMC's guidance delivered in a speech to Marine Corps Base, Quantico officers and higher level civilians in November 2006. In January 2007 PM ICE received a signed information paper by CMC. Target mandatory possession date for all hands has been set for Oct 2009.

Description.

The suit will be comprised of a jacket and matching pant suitable for Marines to wear while training or on liberty. The design will be compatible with other PT uniform items that comprise the complete PT uniform system currently in the sea bag. The current t-shirts, shorts and sweatshirt and sweatpants will remain in the sea bag. Running Suits will include the following characteristics: moisture management, reflectivity, antimicrobial characteristics, breath-ability, quick drying, water resistance and improved durability properties in material and in design features.

Design

The final running suit design was selected based on the performance of the suit and the overall acceptance by Marines through various web surveys, limited user tests, and field user testing. The performance attributes of the new running suit are designed with high end top of the line fabric technologies and superior design attributes that reflect the need of Marines in an active environment.
