I want to apologize... I owe you an apology and more.

I have not been as sensitive to your position and helping you as you have been to me. I guess part of it is my perception that you don't really need me... you're at the top, you've got experience and expertise and contacts and can get things done. But you're right- if it doesn't compromise us professionally, we ought to act in ways that help one another... and it is important for you in this political climate. That's not to say that I've ever done anything to purposely not help you, but I don't think I've been as conscious of acting in a way that will help you (ie who I quote at board meetings, or using/not using you in ways that are minor to my story but significant to your professional well being).

It was stupid of me to not think that the story today would affect you. I have no good excuse or explanation, other than that I didn't think. Pure and simple. You're right when you say it doesn't add to the story. While I had to bring up the situation, I should have been more considerate in the way in which I went about it (knowing how sensitive and important the issue is to you and what a risk it was). Just like I should know that when certain issues are discussed or that you orchestrated certain things, that I ought to give you credit for them.

But it's easy to say should have. I told you last week that I'm not everyone else. And likewise, you aren't everyone else. Not to me. I need to start acting that way.

And I need to be more aware of how these things affect you. I will try harder to do that. Thank you for talking to me about why you were upset and explaining it in a rational and calm way. It means a lot to me.

If you want to talk more, I'm around. I can come over there, I can meet you somewhere, just let me know. I am sorry.

I don't know where we go from here. The conversation we just had made me feel even worse.

Overwhelmingly, I'm hurt by your actions and lack thereof yesterday. You knew that it was important for me to see you yesterday. And you did nothing to make that happen. Even after Alex was gone, you did nothing to try and see me. Furthermore, you couldn't even give me the courtesy of any sort of communication or response. No explanation. No remorse. Nothing. What do you think that says to me?

This is a pattern that has emerged over the past several weeks that you seem to expect me to understand and live with. It doesn't seem to matter to you how much I want to see you or how long it's been. If it's not convenient, you simply don't do it. You don't set aside time for me. You don't make time. And to me, it's unacceptable. It's a way that I do not want my box to get bigger.

If you want me to be understanding of you, you need to be so of me. You need to communicate, you need to make an effort. And it's not just about tit for tat, as you like to say. It's about feeling that we're working together toward the same thing, that my efforts are recognized and vice versa. Saying the discussion is over, not wanting to talk about it; that only makes it worse.

You say that you don't want to lose me, but I don't see you doing much that reflects that, to show me that I matter, that you even want this. In fact, you seem to be trying harder than ever to maintain your status quo, to push me

I have made a public records request at FIU for all monies they have paid to lobbyists annually per lobbyist from 2003 through 2006 . I have also requested that the issues they were lobbying for be disclosed. This will smoke out what I need from them.

I have met telephonically with the House Rules and Calendar Committee Aide and discussed the requirements of filing a complaint. I met face to face with an Ethics Commission Attorney in Tallyho Monday and retrieved the forms to file that complaint. The info from FIU will propel that complaint, if it is made. I met with The Miami Herald reporters and Chief Researcher in Tallyho again on Monday. Ditto for the Tallahassee Democrat reporter, and the Florida Times Union's Tallyho Bureau Chief. All of them will question Gov. Crist and the Hispanic Caucus when they arrive about their actions. Crist will be asked why he vetoed based on a letter of unanimous support from Rep Soto for the Hispanic Caucus when 11 of 15 members of that caucus voted for the bill. Rep Soto will b
