

LOCAL RULE AND MOTION FORM FOR RECIPROCAL ADMISSION TO THE U.S. DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF ILLINOIS

Members of another district in Illinois may join the general bar of the Northern District of Illinois by reciprocal admission. Petitioners must complete a motion accompanied by a copy of their certificate of admission for the Illinois District Court where they are a member, along with the \$150.00 filing fee.

LR83.10 (g) - General Bar

On receipt of completed petition form indicating that the petitioner has taken the oath of office, or on receipt of the attorney's own motion accompanied by a copy of the attorney's Certificate of Admission to practice in another District of Illinois and by the attorney's certification that the attorney is admitted in that district and that his or her right to practice law is not suspended by order of court in any jurisdiction, the clerk shall promptly issue a certificate indicating that petitioner has been admitted to the general bar of this Court and add petitioner's name in the list of attorneys admitted to that bar.
