OFFICE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY TITLE: Amendment of Parts 1, 21, 73, 74 and 101 of the Commission's Rules to Facilitate the Provision of Fixed and Mobile Broadband Access. Educational and Other Advanced Services in the 2150-2162 and 2500-2690 MHz Bands (WT Docket No. 03-66. Docket No. 02-364); and Amendment of Part 2 of the Commission's Rules to Allocate Spectrum Below 3 GHz for Mobile and Fixed Services to Support the Introduction of New Advanced Wireless Services, Including Third Generation Wireless Systems (ET Docket No. 00-258).

SUMMARY: The Commission will consider a Third Order on Reconsideration and Sixth Memorandum Opinion and Order addressing spectrum sharing among incumbent and future services in the 2495-2500 MHz band. The Commission will also consider a Fourth Memorandum Opinion and Order, Declaratory Ruling, and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking concerning changes to the service rules applicable to the Broadband Radio Service and the Educational Broadband Service.

5 WIRELESS TELE-COMMUNICATIONS

TITLE: Biennial Regulatory Review – Amendment of Parts 1, 22, 24, 27 and 90 to Streamline and Harmonize Various Rules Affecting Wireless Radio Services (WT Docket No. 03-264)

SUMMARY: The Commission will consider a Third Report and Order concerning changes to the radiated power rules applicable to certain wireless services.
