CHAIRMAN KEVIN J. MARTIN ANNOUNCES ACTING LEGAL ADVISOR, MEDIA ISSUES AND ACTING LEGAL ADVISOR, WIRELINE ISSUES

Washington, DC - Today, Federal Communications Commission Chairman Kevin J. Martin announced that Elizabeth Andrion is serving as his Acting Legal Advisor for Media Issues and Amy Bender is serving as his Acting Legal Advisor for Wireline Issues.
