Manhattan Loft Corporation's biggest challenge to date, is the conversion of the old Midland Grand Hotel at St Pancras, which closed as long ago as 1935, into a modern luxury hotel and 67 apartments. The project provides for the retention and restoration of the magnificent Gothic Revival facade, The principal public rooms will also be faithfully restored, together with the spectacular main staircase.

The apartments, combining a dramatic period setting with every modern convenience, will be amongst the finest in Europe and have been largely sold off plan. Residents will be able to jump in a lift and arrive at the check-in for cross-Channel rail services, scheduled to serve St Pancras from 2007. The surrounding area is being rapidly regenerated as a prime business and residential district, with excellent links to the City and West End and a large new mixed use quarter planned for the former railway lands to the north of the station.
