Lesson 4: I Am the Good Shepherd

A. INTRODUCTION

"I am the good shepherd.

The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep"
(John 10:11).

- 1. What is a shepherd? One who takes care of the sheep.
 - a. It is the owner. "His own sheep" (John 10:4).
 - b. A <u>son</u> of an owner. "Jesse said . . . there remaineth the youngest, he keepeth the sheep" (I Sam. 16:11).
 - c. A daughter. "Rachel came with her father's sheep" (Gen. 29:9).
 - d. A hireling. "Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks" (Gen. 30:36).
- 2. Jesus linked His divine nature to an ordinary occupation. "I Am the Good Shepherd" (John 10:11).
- 3. Who was prepared for <u>leadership</u> by being a shepherd?
 - a. "And the Lord told you (David) you will be the shepherd of my people Israel" (II Sam. 3:2, *LB*).
 - b. "Moses kept the flock of Jethro" (Ex. 3:1).
 - c. "Amos a shepherd from the town of Tekoa" (Amos 1:1, LB).

B. WHAT ARE THE QUALITIES OF A SHEPHERD?

- 1. He knows us <u>intimately</u>. "I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep" (John 10:14).
- 2. He calls each of us <u>by name</u>. "Calleth his own sheep by name" (John 10:3).
- 3. He <u>sleeps</u> at the door of sheepfold. "I am the door of the sheep" (John 10:7).
- 4. He sends us <u>out each morning</u>. "He putteth forth his own sheep" (John 10:4).
- 5. The sheep that belong to Jesus recognize <u>His voice</u>. "The sheep hear his voice" (John 10:3). "I am the good shepherd . . . and am known of mine" (John 10:14).

- 6. The shepherd goes <u>before us to lead us.</u> "When he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them" (John 10:4).
 - a. To search for good <u>pasture</u>. "He leadeth me into green pastures" (Ps. 23:2).
 - b. To search for <u>water</u>. "He leadeth me beside still waters" (Ps. 23:2).
- 7. The sheep who belong to Jesus <u>follow</u> Him. "The sheep hear his voice, and he . . . leadeth them out" (John 10:3).
- 8. The shepherd has a <u>personal interest</u> in my well-being. "The hireling fleeth... careth not for the sheep" (John 10:13).
 - a. "The hireling fleeth" (10:13). Paid ministers.
 - b. "The stranger they will not follow." <u>Unsaved ministers</u>.
 - c. "He that entereth not by the door . . . robber" (10:1). <u>False</u> teachers.
 - d. "The thief . . . to steal and kill" (10:10). Satan or his followers.
 - e. "The wolf . . . scattereth the sheep" (10:12). <u>Christian</u> persecutors.
- 9. The shepherd's chief care is to feed me spiritual food. "Those preparest a table before me" (Ps. 23:5).
- 10. The shepherd must also find us something <u>to drink</u>. "He leadeth me beside still waters" (Ps. 23:2).
- 11. The shepherd must protect us <u>from danger</u>. "Thy rod and thy staff protect me" (Ps. 23:4).
- 12. The shepherd must not <u>retreat from danger</u>. "Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion and a bear . . . I went after it and smote it and delivered it out of its mouth" (I Sam. 17:34-35).
- 13. The shepherd goest after <u>lost sheep</u>. "If he loses one of them . . . leave the ninety and nine . . . and go after that which is lost" (Luke 15:4).

C. WHAT SHEEP EXPERIENCE UNDER THE SHEPHERD'S CARE

- 1. Sheep are <u>satisfied</u>. "I shall not want" (Ps. 23:1).
- 2. Sheep can <u>rest</u>. "He maketh me to lie down in green pastures" (Ps. 23:2).
- 3. Sheep have <u>eternal life</u>. "My sheep hear my voice . . . and they follow me, and I give them eternal life" (John 10:27-28).

- a. You must first <u>listen</u> to Jesus. "Faith cometh . . . by the word of God" (Rom. 10:17).
- b. You must become his disciple. "Follow Me" (John 10:27).
- 4. Sheep are not <u>afraid</u>. "Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, the Lord is with me" (Ps. 23:4, *ELT*).
- 5. Sheep are <u>protected</u>. "The good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep" (John 10:11).
- 6. Sheep will be <u>healed</u> (spiritually and physically). "Thou annointest my head with oil" (Ps. 23:5).
- 7. Sheep will have <u>spiritual abundance</u>. "My cup runneth over" (Ps. 23:5).
- 8. Sheep have <u>eternal security</u>. "I give unto them (sheep) eternal life and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand" (10:28).
- 9. Sheep will go to Heaven. "I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever" (Ps. 23:6).
