EASY

SIZES

Afghan - 44" x 66"/112 cm x 167.5 cm Throw - 35" x 50"/89 cm127 cm



N.Y. Yarns

MATERIALS

Afghan – 16 balls – 1.75 oz (50 g) 83 yds (76m) NY Yarns GYPSY (90% Acrylic, 10% Wool) in color #1 green/blue/purple
Throw [not shown] –11 balls in color #5 red/blue/purple/gold

• Size M-13 (9mm) hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

• Yarn needle

GAUGE

• 15 sts (1 pattern repeat from point to point) = 8 1/2" (21.5cm)

• 3 rows (at point) = 4" (10cm) in pattern BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Dc2tog (double crochet decrease) Yarn over (yo), insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo, draw through 2 loops on hook, yo, draw through all loops on hook. Dc3tog (decrease 2 double crochet) [Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yo, draw through all loops on hook. Cluster (dc5tog) [Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops] 5 times, yo, draw through all loops on hook.

AFGHAN

Chain 122.

Row 1 Work dc2tog across 3rd and 4th ch from hook, *dc in each of next 9 ch, 5 dc in next ch, dc in each of next 9 ch, cluster worked across next 5 ch; rep from * across to within last 3 ch, dc3tog worked across last 3 ch, turn – 5 pattern repeats. **Row 2** Ch 2, skip first st, dc2tog worked across next 2 dc, *dc in each of next 9 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 9 dc, cluster worked across next 5 sts; rep from * across to within last 3 dc, dc3tog worked across last 3 dc, turn – 5 pattern repeats. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 64". At end of last row, do not turn.

BORDER

Round 1 With right-side facing, working across side edge, ch 1, 2 sc in each rowend st across side edge, sc in each ch across bottom edge, 2 sc in each row-end st across side edge, sc in each st across top edge, slip st in first sc to join. Fasten off.

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

THROW

Chain 98.

Work same as Afghan pattern, except repeat from * 2 times instead of 3 times for all rows. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 49". At end of last row, ch 1, do not turn. Work border same as for afghan.

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.
