6.2L / 6.5L Stud Girdle **Installation Instructions**

Thank you for purchasing the DSG 6.2L / 6.5L Stud Girdle Kit

- 1. Studs go in place of #2, #3 and #4 outside main bolts (short bolts).
- 2. Make sure all threaded holes are clean and free of burrs.
- Install studs into block until bottomed. Finger tight only. 3.
- Install girdle over studs, lubricate washers and nuts with supplied moly lubricant. 4.
- 5. On 12mm nuts - torque evenly on each girdle to 80 ft. lbs. with moly lubricant or 120 ft. lbs. with engine oil.
- 6. On 10mm nuts - torque evenly on each girdle to 48 ft. lbs. with moly lubricant or 60 ft. lbs. with engine oil.
- Rotate crankshaft over. Check that the girdle does not protrude over the outside 7. of the main cap, to cause interference with the crank throws. There must be a minimum of .020 clearance between the crank throw and the girdle. If the girdle interferes with the crank, simply grind the tabs as required.

Note: Girdles should go onto studs easily. If the girdle binds going onto the studs, simply file the holes as required.
