- Outside of Henry County, Ind. and Anoka County, Minn., all top 20 counties were located in the American southwest.
- Apache is the seventh most common language spoken in Arizona and the 18th most common language spoken in New Mexico.
- Apache is the third most common language spoken at home in Greenlee County, Ariz., Gila County, Ariz., Graham County, Ariz., and Navajo County, Ariz.
- In the United States, 1 of every 19,779 people age five and older speaks Apache at home. In Arizona, this figure is 1 in 429 people, while in New Mexico 1 in 1,809 residents is an Apache speaker.
- Within the counties, Graham County, Ariz. has the greatest rate of Apache speakers (1 in every 16.2 residents), followed by Gila County, Ariz. (1 in every 17.0 residents) and Navajo County, Ariz. (1 in every 17.1 residents).
