I, Martin Cullen, Minister for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 8, 10(1)(a) and (3)(a) of the Roads Act 1993 (No. 14 of 1993), and the National Roads and Road Traffic (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 298 of 2002) (as adapted by the Public Enterprise (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 305 of 2002)), after consultation with the National Roads Authority, hereby order as follows:

 (1) This Order may be cited as the Roads Act 1993 (Classification of National Roads) Order 2006.

(2) This Order comes into operation on 13 April 2006.

2. Each public road mentioned by number beside the letter N in column (1) opposite a description of the road in column (2), of Schedule 1 is classified as a national road and is a national primary road.

3. Each public road mentioned by number beside the letter N in column (1) opposite a description of the road in column (2), of Schedule 2 is classified as a national road and is a national secondary road.

4. Each proposed public road mentioned in column (1) opposite a description of the road in column (2), of Schedule 3 is classified as a national road.

- 5. Reference in a Schedule to the letter -
 - (a) N followed by a number is a reference to a particular national road,
 - (b) R followed by a number is a reference to a particular regional road, and
 - (c) M followed by a number is a reference to a particular national road or regional road or part of it which is a motorway.

6. The Orders referred to in Schedule 4 are revoked.
