## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into operation those sections of the Human Rights Act 2001 that are not already in force. These sections relate to the substantive provisions of the Act.

The provisions which confer the power to make subordinate legislation under the Act – section 1(4), (5) and (6); sections 13 and 14; section 17; section 18; section 19 (to the extent necessary for the operation of the other provisions brought into force); and section 23 were brought into operation by the Human Rights Act 2001 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2001 – SD 65/01.

The Act has been amended by the Human Rights Act 2001 (First Protocol) Order 2002 – SD 110/02 – and by the Human Rights Act 2001 (13th Protocol) Order 2004 – SD 645/04.
