Ohio's diverse economy and welcoming business environment have created numerous opportunities for employers and workers in a variety of industries. From retail and manufacturing to healthcare and financial services, Ohio is home to an array of market-leading employers. *Ohio's Major Employers* is an informative, must-read report that provides an in-depth review of the leading employers that drive Ohio's economy. I am pleased to present these twelve tables of data in three sections for your review.

With more than 150 stores and four distribution centers, Wal-Mart Stores has been identified as the private sector employer with the largest total employee headcount in Ohio. Healthcare facilities such as The Cleveland Clinic and retail giants like Kroger make up the remaining top ten. The list identifies 91 firms and institutions that have 3,000 or more employees.

Section two highlights lists of Ohio companies published in national magazines. Cardinal Health of Dublin is identified as having the largest annual revenues of any public corporation in Ohio. *Fortune Magazine* identifies 60 public corporations with headquarters in Ohio in its Top 1000 Corporations list published in April of each year. Ohio is fifth in the nation for the number of headquarters in the State. Lists from *Forbes*, *Standard & Poors*, and *Inc Magazine* are also highlighted in this section.

Summary of Ohio Operations Ranked by Employment

- ❖ **Wal-Mart** (1) with approximately 172 retail operations and four distribution centers has the largest employment headcount (52,000) of Ohio's Private Sector Employers. While many of its employees are part time, Wal-Mart's presence is felt in every community across the state.
- ❖ Other national retailers employing significant numbers of Ohioans include **Kroger** (2) at 36,500, **Bob Evans** (8) at 17,500, **Meijer** (10) at 16,300, and **Sears Holding** and **Target** (12) at 15,000.
- ❖ Through mergers and acquisitions, many hospital groups have been propelled onto the largest employers list. **Cleveland Clinic** (3) at 29,000, **Catholic Healthcare Partners** (5) at 23,000, **University Hospitals** (6) at 21,800, and **OhioHealth** (14) at 14,500 are all examples of growing hospital/health networks.
- ❖ **General Electric, Honda Motor Co, and Procter & Gamble** with 14,000 workers each tied for 17th (employment totals include administrative, R&D, and distribution workers). **General Motors** (22) employing 12,300 people is the second largest motor vehicle employer in Ohio (behind Honda Motor) followed by **Ford Motor Co** (29) at 9,900.
- ❖ **Wright-Patterson Air Force Base** near Dayton employs 18,260 civilian (10,690) and military personnel (7,570). At 8,145 acres, the Air Base is considered the largest employer at a single site in the state.
- ❖ As a major financial center, Ohio has significant operations of **JP Morgan Chase** (9) employing 17,100, **National City Corp** (15) employing 14,250, **Nationwide Mutual Insurance** (16) employing 14,135, **KeyCorp** (31) employing 9,690 and **Fifth Third** (34) employing 9,500.
