 - d. Desired depth of water during the seasons and a plan to achieve the desired depth of water.
 - e. Number, type and size of structures if needed.
 - f. Plan map with legend.
- 5. Operation and maintenance plan to include at a minimum the requirements found in the Wetland Wildlife Habitat Management Standard (644).
- 6. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice.
- 7. Certifications that the design meets NRCS practice standard and specifications and complies with applicable laws and regulations.
- 8. Design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables:

- 1. Pre-application conference with client.
- 2. Application assistance as requested by the client.
- 3. Designs, job sheets, IA-CPA-4 seeding sheets, plans and specifications needed by client to implement installation of planned practices.
- 4. Facilitate and implement required wetland wildlife habitat management plan modifications with client and original designer.
- 5. Certification that the application process meets wetland wildlife habitat management plan.
- 6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
- 7. Certification that the application process and materials meet NRCS standards and specifications.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables:

- 1. Records of application:
 - a. Type and extent of practice(s) applied with appropriate documentation recorded in client file.
 - b. Map or aerial photo with legend showing practice application location.
- 2. Certification that the installation meets NRCS standards and specifications.
- 3. Certification that structures meet NRCS design specifications if applicable.
- 4. Certification that the Operation and Maintenance Plan was reviewed with the client.
- 5. Certification of completed seeding(s) on signed IA-CPA-4.
- 6. Progress reporting.
