Thanks to fast development of industry, Trnava has gained the character of an important industrial centre and has become a significant power junction.



URBAN PATTERN

TRNAVA

During its development Trnava has preserved the character of compact town with relatively unambiguously located functions. The centre of the seat is a multifunctional city which creates the historical core surrounded by walls on the eastern and western sides. They are directly interlocked by marked residential areas with mainly mass residential construction. The residential areas also occur in the north-eastern and south-western parts of town. The specific living conditions are offered by the local district Modranka with the character of country settlement. Trnava is the seat of the Trnava region, Trnava district and from 1 December 2001, the seat of the Trnava municipality.

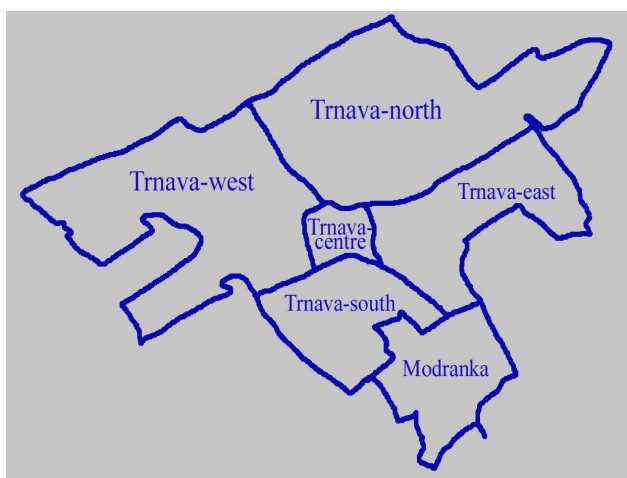
From a land point of view, the agricultural land resource has the largest representation with 76.14 % and arable land 73.36% of Trnava.

From a town development point of view, the largest changes to the area happened in the seventies, when Hrnčiarovce (28 November 1971), Modranka (1 January 1972) and Biely Kostol (1 January 1974) were associated to Trnava while the town reached an area of 8 986 ha and with a built-up area of 1 462 ha. Trnava consisted of eight urban districts (1. Staré Mesto, 2. Kopánka, 3. Hlboká, 4. Tulipán, 5. Nové Mesto, 6. Modranka, 7. Hrnčiarovce, 8. Biely Kostol). On 1 January 1993 Biely Kostol was split from Trnava and on 1 January 1994 Hrnčiarovce nad Parnou also split. Since 1 July 2002 the town has consisted of 6 urban districts (Trnava Centre, Trnava West, Trnava North, Trnava East, Trnava South, Modranka).

LOCATION

TRNAVA

Trnava is situated on the rim of the West Slovak lowland a distance about 50 km from Bratislava, the capital of the Slovak Republic (SR).

The town is crossed by a highway and the main railway corridor connecting the west and east of SR. The distance to a significant European town, Vienna, is 95 km.

Trnava plays the important role of the secondary core of the so-called Central European region. The Central European region is part of the European production triangle Paris – Berlin – Vienna that creates the base of the European economy with:

- The highest energetic power
- The highest production of industry
- The highest production of agriculture (per 1 ha of land)
- The highest consumption per capita in Europe
- The highest quality of social and technical infrastructure
- The most modern technology in Europe and the world
- High developed transport



From the point of view of finishing nowadays and creation of the future land structure the Central European region is a large bi-polar region with a marked radial and circular system of town settlements of I. and II. categories. The main poles of the Central European region are created by centres such as Vienna and Bratislava (primary cores), the secondary cores of I. and II. categories are located on the main circular system which is connected by radials with the main poles.

Trnava is a core of I. category where St. Polten, Znojmo, Sopron, W. Neustadt, Eisenstadt also belong. The cores of the second category are Břeclav, Krems, Hollabrun, Mosonmagyaróvár, Dunajská Streda and Galanta.

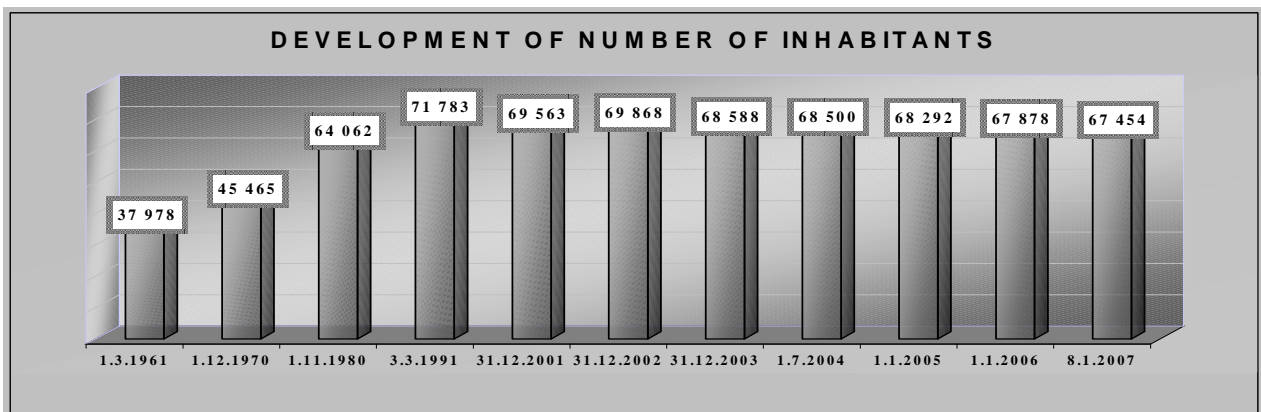
Trnava region and its core area - Trnava is situated on one of the main urbanisation axis of Slovakia: north – south, that is created by Váh valley belt settlement from Žilina towards Bratislava. This main urbanisation axis is crossed by secondary axes which is one of the important joining points of Slovakia and Moravia (Czech Republic). The meeting point of these urbanisation axes is Trnava and its interesting territory.

Trnava carries out the function of administrative, economic, cultural and scientific and research centre of the District and Trnava Autonomous Region.

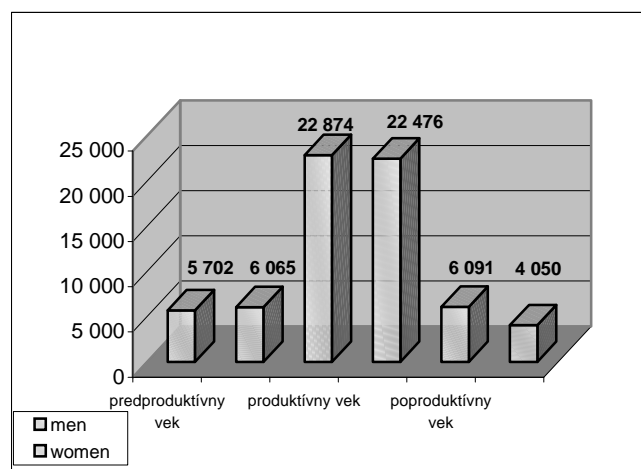
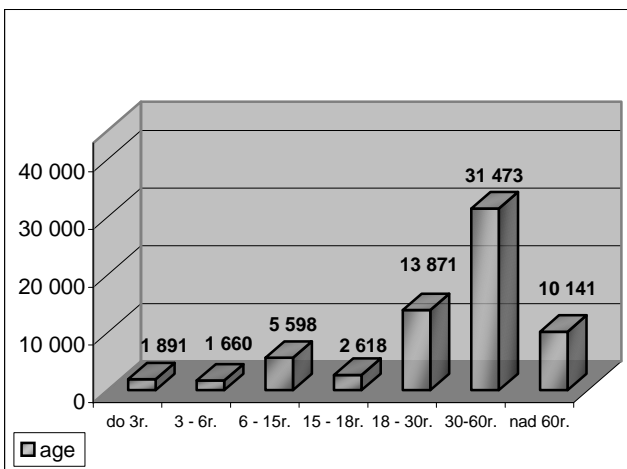
In the period 1970 – 1991 Trnava registered a dynamic increase in population. The average annual increase reached 1164 inhabitants, whilst in the period 1970 – 1980 the average annual increase was 1529 inhabitants and in the period 1981 – 1991 approximately 799 inhabitants. The positive trend resulting from a favourable age composition of the population has considerably changed in last decade, when the average annual increase, in the first half, decreased to about 281 inhabitants and in the second half down to 94 inhabitants.

We may state that natural population growth will be minimal. That means that the demographic development of Trnava could be provided by an increased migration of population. Today and especially in the near future, the economic and social reasons of migration will dominate. It can be expected that the depression of living standard, loss of employment, housing price increase and substantive stagnation of new housing construction, will be reasons for a limitation in the extent of migration from the countryside to the town within the district and also outside the district. The consequence of this is that the decreasing trend in the development of number of inhabitants should considerably slow or stop.

Housing construction issues are dealt with by the approved Territorial Plan of the City of Trnava, updated as per January 1, 2005; therein areas are specified for the mass and individual housing construction in the current status, as well as in the prognosticated period after 2020. Since November 2003, under the methodical instruction by the Ministry of Agriculture of SR, borders of the built-up area in the city of Trnava are expanded by 124 hectare for the housing construction needs counting 724 family houses and 3,365 apartments in apartment houses (the area is in private ownership). To a considerable extent, the fact mentioned previously is a limitation factor for the construction of apartments.

Nowadays, in the city of Trnava, the construction of two residential houses is carried out, consisting of 98 and 88 rental apartments. Simultaneously, to cope with housing problems, the city is preparing, on its own grounds, a location of 30 hectare to build 1,500 apartments in the form of low-rise housing development.

Housing construction in the city is also carried out by private companies. For the time being, in accordance with building permits, the construction of several apartment houses is being realized consisting of 408 apartments.

On the basis of information collected with regard to the situation on the housing market, we can state that there is a permanent interest, particularly, in apartments in older apartment houses and, as far as new apartment houses are concerned, the interest is focused to smaller apartments with 1 and 2 rooms. Comparing to 2003, when the car manufacturer PSA Peugeot-Citroën was located in Trnava, the demand for apartments has slightly dropped.

The town of Trnava is the seat of the District and Region and from the viewpoint of road and rail transport has a very favourable position. Although it does not have direct connection to air and waterway transport, an accessible airport is in Vienna, which is 95 km (75 min.) away, in Bratislava, which is 50 km (40 min.) away and in Piešťany, 35 km (20 min.). An agro-airport is also operated on the northeast edge of the town. Trnava creates an important crossing not only for the interstate road network, but also for roads of European importance. Important traffic routes traverse the town – road No. I/51, which goes from Czech Republic to south of Slovakia, known also as Via Bohemica, which at the same time connects the town with the part of motorway D1- Bratislava - Žilina and road No. I/61 from Bratislava to Považie, parallel with motorway D1.

1. Road Traffic

The base of the traffic framework is an inner circle around its centre. From the stated network, routes continue in the direction of the present main routes of roads of I. and II. class and so they form the radial circle network. An inner town circle complements the external bypass of the town, the southeast part of which is built and a northern part is being prepared. After it is put into operation, connection of roads I/51 from Nitra and II/504 to Modra as well as connection to industrial zones of town, shall improve.

Parking in the centre of the town is regulated by an obligation to pay parking fees with the possibility to park free of charge on the hold parking lots in the suburbs of the town.

Besides preparatory works to finish building of a town bypass, the crossings of the most stretched communications are being gradually reconstructed in order to increase permeability and safeness of road traffic.

The building of new industrial parks also indirectly affects the building of routes in new residential areas.

GREEN ON PUBLIC AREA

The town of Trnava is systematically improving its public greenery.

In 2006, several tens of young perspective trees were planted in **stage 2 of the renovation work in the Pri Kalvárii and Janko Kráľ parks of Trnava.** Landscaping and the seeding of grass will continue in the Janko Kráľ Park. The attractiveness of the second section of the park will be enhanced by a new recreation area with a children's playground and sports facilities.

In 2006 renovation work was also started in a small park on the square of Slovenské učení tovarišstvo and in the central section of Ján Hlúbik Street.

New green areas appeared on Hlboká Street and on the location of the former railway track from Trnava to Kúty on Beethoven Street. Approximately 4.6 ha of new land with 257 adult trees, which can be finished into a quality park for relaxation were added to the public greenery.

The town is continuing its **revitalization and planting of street verdure** – on the following streets: Moyzešova, Študentská, L.van Beethovena, Orgovánová and on the premises of the FK Lokomotíva.

According to the plan, tens of trees, bushes, shrubs and flowerbeds were planted and will be planted by the end of 2006 in the areas in between blocks of flats in residential areas and along streets and newly established parking lots of J. Botto, Botanická, Mozartova, Študentská, A. Kubinu, E. Podjavorinskej, Na hlinách, Zelenečská, CMZ and many others.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Waste Disposal – waste dump Trnava – Zavorská road



The town of Trnava built a waste dump, which started its operation in 1998. The total area of the site is 13.52 ha. Its capacity is 1,800,000 m³ and the anticipated lifetime is until 2026. The average amount of deposited waste per year is 85,000 tons. The capacity of the first two cassettes is slowly being reached. The third cassette should be finished in June 2006. The waste dump fulfills all contemporary valid legislative requirements and its operation is managed to minimize the environmental impact.

Waste Exploitation – Composting Plant



In 1999 the composting plant started its operation. Almost 90% of the green waste produced by the town is processed here in the form of fills. Grass, leaves, crushed wood and small amounts of stabilized pressed sediment are changed through the composting processes into high quality organic fertilizer in the course of 3 to 4 weeks. The composting plant has a capacity of 1,500 tons of finished compost per year.

Waste Exploitation - Separating and Processing of Secondary Materials



The separation finishing line for the separated collection for the town of Trnava and its surrounding municipalities started its operation in 2004. The facility is capable of processing 1,000 up to 1,500 kilos of secondary raw materials in one work shift depending on the type of material. Presently up to three types of PET bottles, two types of mixed plastic materials, two types of polythene foil, glass, textile, paper and cardboard are separated on this line.

Operation of Collection Yards



6 collection yards for bulky and problem waste designated for natural persons – citizens of Trnava are operating on the territory of the town. Waste is collected free of charge based on proof of permanent residence.

The town of Trnava was awarded a long-term rating evaluation of A- (stable prospect) in the Slovak Crown transactions category. In the category of foreign currency transactions, the town of Trnava was awarded a rating evaluation of BBB+ (stable prospect). The short-term rating evaluation of the town of Trnava is S2+, which constitutes the best possible short-term rating evaluation for entities achieving an A- long-term rating evaluation.

Justification:

- In the field of the fulfillment of the strategic goals, the town continuously implements the visions and intentions established by its updated Program of Economic and Social Development. The town of Trnava perceives the provision of sustainable growth as its fundamental mission; this puts demands on the strategic and conceptual planning in particular. That is why the town creates concepts for various areas of life, despite the fact that their elaboration is not always a legal requirement. Recently, the Energy Concept and the Housing Development Program for 2006 – 2011 were adopted while the General Traffic Plan is in the elaboration phase.
- The financial situation of the town of Trnava is characterized by continual annual income growth. In 2006 it achieved SKK 1.75 billion which constitutes almost 5% growth in comparison with 2005. The result of the economy of the town of Trnava for 2006 constituted SKK 94,199,000 which is purposefully bound and shall be used in 2007.
- 2006 was also characterized by distinctive investment development. Besides PSA Peugeot Citroën, significant investment continues in housing development, infrastructure development and investment in the school system, sports, social and cultural areas. The town development is financed from several resources. Subsidies and the town's own income constitute a substantial part and the projects are co-financed from refundable financial resources. That is why the town's credit indebtedness increased in 2006, when the value of the indebtedness indicator towards the current income reached the level of 40% and the value of the debt service indicator towards the current income constituted 4.55%. The town does not register any outstanding debts past the due date.
- Slovak Rating Agency positively perceives the changes recorded in the area of managing at the municipal office. In July 1, 2007 the town implemented a new organizational structure which creates more space for project management. Higher demands are also placed on lower level personnel. They are delegated higher competencies and higher responsibility for the delegated

I. Employment

In the town of Trnava there was a moderate decrease in unemployment. Stable employment subjects are especially large companies with foreign equity participation, such as Sachs, Swedwood, Sony, Johns Manville Slovakia, but also newly founded companies such as Invensys and Boge. The highest increase of employment showed in the business branch (Tesco, Kaufland, Billa and Lidl).

An increase in employment is expected when the production in automobile works of PSA Peugeot Citroën in Trnava in 2006 will be put in action, which shall produce 300,000 automobiles per year, and at the same time it shall employ 3500 people in a three-shift operation and 6000–7000 people in the supplier's department.

II. Income

The average annual nominal salary per employee in 2005 grew by 0.9% in comparison with 2004 in the district of Trnava. The district recorded the highest salaries in the fields of industry, real estate sales and leasing and construction.

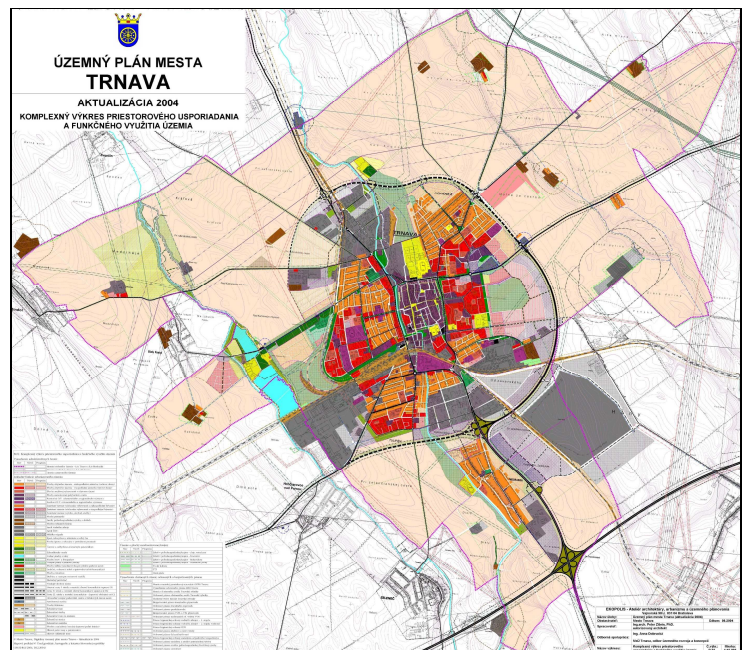

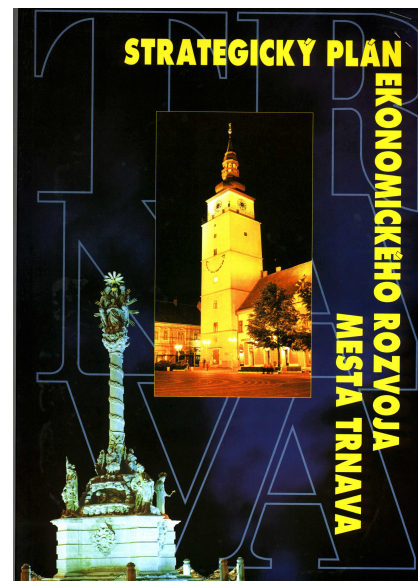

SCHOOL SYSTEM AND EDUCATION

TRNAVA

Trnava has continued in its tradition of „ **the town of education** „ since Trnava University was founded (1635 – 1777). We practise the system of lifelong education in our town. The system includes the whole range of school institutions and facilities (state and independent), from kindergartens to the University of the Third Age, including different leisure time centres, youth organizations and civic associations that fill children and youth's free time.

The county town of Trnava with its 67,000 inhabitants has a good educational structure of secondary school leavers and university graduates. This creates good preconditions of its further development in the area of industry, services, health care, food industry, education and other branches.

In the 2006/2007 school year, 19 kindergartens (1,615 children), 8 elementary schools (5,976 children), 2 elementary art schools and Kalokagiata – the leisure time center (1,683 children) became part of the administrative network of the town of Trnava after implementation of rationalization measures.

“THE HEALTHY TOWN” PROJECT - In 1996 the town of Trnava began its participation in **The Healthy Town** Project under the auspices of the World Health Organization. A year later it became the member of the Association of Healthy Towns of Slovakia. This project is a part of the National program of Health Support, approved by the Government of the Slovak Republic and supported by USAID/EHP (the United States Agency for the International Development).

Monitoring and elaboration of “the **Health Profile**” every 5 years is a part of this project. It provides information regarding the demographic, economic and social background of the populace.

One of the tasks of “**Trnava, the Healthy Town**” is to support NGOs and other organizations in fulfilling the Project program. The annual provision of financial subsidies for the implementation of individual projects is one of the methods of this support.

Public Health School: health-education activity in cooperation with Trnava University’s Faculty of Healthcare and Social Work, designed for the general public.

Nutrition Course: prepared in cooperation with the Life and Health civic association. In the course of 10 meetings the citizens can observe the preparation of healthy meals, find out about healthy eating, how food effects health and illnesses and how to prevent illnesses through suitable nutrition. Upon completion of the course, the participants receive a book of recipes of healthy meals.

Earth Day: in cooperation with the Kalokagatia Leisure Time Center, organizes this event targeted at environmental education.

Day of Daffodils: The town of Trnava has participated in the national public charity collection in support of the fight against cancer in cooperation with the League against Cancer – Venus Club and Kalokagatia LTC in Trnava since 2001.

World Tobacco Free Day: This day is proclaimed as World Tobacco Free Day by the World Health Organization. At this occasion the measuring of pulmonary functions by Spiro meter is organized for citizens in cooperation with specialists from the Družba Clinic at Trojičné Square.

World Blood Donor Day: This event is organized in cooperation with the National Transfusion Service in Trnava on the occasion of the World Blood Donor Day. Its objectives are to recruit new blood donors and to promote blood donating.

Health Days: The fundamental event organized by the Trnava Healthy Town Office. It takes place at the town hall, the Mikuláš Schneider Trnavsky Elementary Art School, The Catholic Association of Slovakia and Trojičné Square. Other coordinators are: the Regional Office of Public Health, Kalokagatia CLT, The Secondary Health School in Trnava, The territorial association of the Slovak Red Cross and the Center for Public Education in Trnava.

Health Days are divided into three areas.

The first field, carried out by the Regional Office of Public Health includes the provision of health education information, consultations, anthropometric examinations, biochemical examinations, the standard measuring of blood pressure and body fat and analyses of exhaled air by MICRO CO .

The second area is comprised of promotional activities of nutritional health care product companies.

The third area is characterized by a cultural social program and accompanying activities.

Drug Awareness Week: A cycle of educational activities for students of elementary and secondary schools with lecturers from the Center for the Treatment of Drug Addictions in Bratislava and the organizing of a seminar for teachers, coordinators and educational advisors about alcoholism. The partners of this project are The Center for Public Education in Trnava and the Regional Office of Public Health in Trnava.

Stop Smoking: An activity dedicated to the support of the fight against smoking. The town of Trnava, in cooperation with the center of Educational and Psychological Prevention at the Pedagogical Psychological Clinic in Trnava and the Regional Office of Public Health organizes this event in which students exchange apples for cigarettes.

In addition to its year round activities, in 2002/2003 Trnava became a pilot town in the project “The Rights of Patients in Slovakia.” In 2004 it became a testing town in the project entitled “Evaluation of Health Impacts” carried out by the WHO, the European Union and the Association of Healthy Towns of Slovakia.
