ARROWHEAD

Work began in 2007 on an ambitious four-year, S375-million project that will conclude in 2010 with the completion of the New Arrowhead. Funded by a S250 million contribution from the taxpayers of Jackson County, Missouri via a 3/8-cent sales tax and a S125 million investment by the Hunt Family, the fully refurbished facility will offer Chiefs fans a host of modern amenities, while preserving the stadium's unique character and rich history.

All fans will benefit from concourses throughout the stadium that will be widened by 60 percent, while the number of restroom fixtures will increase by more than 120 percent. Enhanced scoreboards and ribbon boards will also add to the fan experience.





A heroic-sized statue of Lamar Hunt will greet fans as they enter the Founder's Plaza, an area honoring Hunt's vision as a sportsman, a business leader and an innovator. A 28,000-square-foot Hall of Honor inside the New Arrowhead will celebrate the franchise's history and accomplishments through interactive displays.

The dub level will feature a spacious, fully-endosed, dimate-controlled concourse. A new dub concourse and lounge will have varied seating options, upscale food and beverage offerings, and easy access to new escalators and elevators.





THE NEW ARROWHEAD...RENOVATION/CONSTRUCTION

The New Arrowhead will celebrate the rich history of the Kansas City Chiefs and build upon the best gameday experience in professional sports.

What will you experience in 2008?

Arrowhead's renovation is ongoing. The exterior of the stadium is undergoing the greatest change now. The interior and bowl areas, however, will look very much the same in 2008. You may enter and exit at all four ramp greas for all levels of the stadium (including the Arrowhead Club and suites). Some limited lower bowl entry/exit will be available in the end zones

All gate entrances into the parking areas of the sports complex remain the same as in past years. Buses will drop off on the north side of Lot M and pick up in this approximate location.

We encourage our season ticket holders to register your e-mail address with us so that you will receive construction updates that might affect your parking or entry into the stadium. Your e-mail can be updated via your My Chiefs Account (see page 15).

REMEMBERING OUR FOUNDER, LAMAR HUNT: 1932-2006

Recognized as one of the greatest sportsmen in American history, Lamar Hunt served as the guiding force behind the formation of both the American Football League and the Kansas City Chiefs franchise. Hunt served as a positive influence on the game for 47 years dating back to his conception of the American Football League in '59. He was the first AFL figure to be enshrined into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in '72, a remarkable feat considering he became involved in the game just 13 years earlier. Despite his many accomplishments, Hunt's humility was one of his most unwavering and endearing traits. While he modestly declined to take credit for his efforts, he truly played an important role in the design, ongoing development and direction of the modern-day National Football League. He was a contributor to the design of the NFL playoff format. He is also credited with accidentally putting the name "Super Bowl" on the NFL's championship game. Hunt had also lobbied for many years that an additional Thanksgiving Day game be added to the NFL schedule, and in 2006, those efforts were rewarded when the Chiefs hosted the first-ever Thanksaiving contest at Arrowhead Stadium. Perhaps Hunt's biggest influence on the league over the years was his quiet yet persuasive voice of reason. Hunt's name is rightfully mentioned alongside other legendary family surnames in pro football history such as Halas, Mara and Rooney for his commitment to putting the betterment of the league ghead of any potential individual gain.

Hunt was born on August 2, 1932, in El Dorado, Arkansas and peacefully passed away December 13th, 2006, at Presbyterian Hospital in Dallas, Texas.

Policies & Procedures





CHIFFS FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

The Kansas City Chiefs are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our fans. When attending a game, the stadium staff will proactively intervene to support an environment where event patrons, their guests and other fans can enjoy the event, free from the following behaviors:

- Foul, obscene, offensive or abusive language or actions
- Standing and/or obstructing the view of other fans
- Intoxication or other signs of impairment
- Smoking except in designated greas
- Fighting and unruly or inconsiderate behavior
- Obscene or indecent clothing or signs
- Conduct that endangers spectators or participants
- Harassment of visiting team fans
- Interfering with the progress of the game, going onto the field or throwing any object onto the field
- Failing to follow instructions of stadium personnel
- Selling items or tickets in the stadium or on sports complex grounds
- Attempting to sit in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat
- Destroying property

Event patrons are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and/or persons occupying their seats. Please respect the rights of others. Event patrons and guests who choose not to adhere to these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund.

SECURITY SCREENING

Prior to entering stadium gates, all guests will be subject to security screening, which includes pat-downs and inspection of all bags and items entering the stadium. Any prohibited item must be returned to your vehicle. To ensure that you are in your seat in time for kickoff, please allow an extra 30 minutes at the turnstile entrances.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

For the safety and security of our fans, the following items are prohibited in Arrowhead Stadium:

- Firearms, weapons of any type or fireworks
- Bags larger than 81/2" x 11" x 6"
- Backpacks
- Sports balls
- Coolers any size, any type
- · Plastic, metal or glass cups, cans or containers
- Thermos bottles or flasks
- Food
- Beer or liquor
- Video cameras or professional cameras/lenses
- Boom boxes
- Portable heaters
- Flammable liquids
- Noisemakers air horns, klaxon, bells, whistles, etc.
- Laser pointers of any type, poles or rods
- Large strollers
- Any other items deemed dangerous or unacceptable by security



ALLOWED ITEMS

The following items are permitted into the stadium:

- Fanny packs (unattached from your body)
- Purses no larger than 81/2" x 11" x 6" (must fit in template at the gate as you enter the stadium)
- Banners, signs and flags (no larger than 3' x 5') are permitted as long as they do not interfere with other quests
- Small diaper bags (if infant is with quest)
- Plastic baby bottles
- One sealed, 20-oz. or smaller bottle of water per person guest may refill the bottle at any water fountain inside the stadium
- Binoculars and case
- Small still camera and case
- Hand-held radios and TV's are permitted if they do not interfere with other quests - an ear piece must be used to listen
- Small compact umbrella (rainy games only)
- Seat cushion lightweight foam with sealed plastic cover

TAIL GATING

Tailgating is not a "sometime" thing for Chiefs fans. It's part of their football lifestyle. Whenever the team plays at Arrowhead Stadium, the parking lots are filled with red-and-gold-clad fans enjoying a party. The smoke of thousands of grills creates a sweet-smelling fog that hangs over the stadium

The Chiefs encourage fans to come early and enjoy the camaraderie of fellow believers, but we ask that you follow some important guidelines. Remember to respect the rights of others; we appreciate your cooperation.

- One vehicle per parking space
- Parking passes and parking spaces are for vehicles only, and cannot be used for trailers, grills, tables, additional tailgating spaces, etc.
- All vehicles pulling a trailer of any kind will be charged for an extra parking space and must park in the grass
- · You must tailgate in front of or behind your vehicle
- Saving spaces is not permitted
- Parking passes do not guarantee a specific parking spot
- Roadways, aisles, and other parking spaces must be kept free of tailgating equipment so that vehicles may park or pass
- If your vehicle is too large to fit in the 8' x 16' space in the lot, you
 must park in the back of the lot or on the grass
- Violations of these policies may result in the loss of reserved parking

Ticket-Information





As a Chiefs Season Ticket Holder, you have access to My Chiefs Account by Ticketmaster. It is your one-stop shop for all online account management. Now you can make payments, renew your season ticket package, track ticket usage, manage your tickets and update your profile, all from your own personal online account. As a season ticket holder, you will also receive special ticket offers that can only be claimed online.

- Make payments online
- Update your account profile
- Forward your tickets to friends via e-mail
- Post your tickets for sale

POST YOUR TICKETS FOR SALE WITH TICKET EXCHANGE

Can't make it to a game? Now you can sell your season tickets anonymously to other fans by logging into your personal Chiefs account. There is no fee for posting tickets and the process is secure - simply highlight the tickets you wish to sell, choose the selling price and the expiration date, and submit the listing. Editing your posting at any time is quick and easy.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN MY TICKETS ARE SOLD?

Once your posted tickets are purchased, the amount of the sale price is credited to your Chiefs Account, less the 10% seller fee. The barcodes on your sold tickets are cancelled and new barcodes are issued. The new tickets are then electronically delivered to the buver via TicketFast® for at-home printing using any standard printer, without the hassle and delay of standard mail delivery.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY TICKETS DON'T SELL?

You will be notified via e-mail if your tickets do not sell before your indicated expiration date. Your listing will be automatically removed and your original tickets will still be valid for entry. If you cannot attend the game, you also have the option of e-mailing your tickets to a friend via Ticket Forwarding.

F-MAIL YOUR TICKETS

Now you can send your tickets to virtually anyone up to 2 hours before the game via Ticket Forwarding. This service allows you to e-mail tickets to friends, family or clients when you can't attend a game. Simply log in to your personal account and select the ticket or group of tickets you wish to send, enter the recipient's information and select Forward. It's so easy – you don't even need to have the tickets in hand. Avoid the hassles of overnight and in-person delivery and start enjoying the benefits of this new service.

HOW IT WORKS

Each of your season tickets carries a unique barcode, ensuring that they are authentic. During the forwarding process, the barcode on your original season ticket is cancelled and a new one issued electronically. The recipient is e-mailed a new ticket with a unique barcode via TicketFast® that can be printed using any standard printer.

WHAT IS THE FEE?

Ticket Forwarding is an inexpensive alternative to other overnight delivery and courier services. Now for a nominal fee of only \$1.95 per ticket, you can enjoy the convenience of this innovative technology that provides a secure alternative method to ensure your tickets get used.



MAKE PAYMENTS

My Chiefs Account allows you to make payments on your ticket invoices. Simply log in to your personal account and select the View/Pay Invoices option. Here you can view your invoices and make payments to your season tickets. Take advantage of this option and avoid the hassles of making payments in person or over the phone.

FDIT PROFILE

With new online access to your season account, you can easily update your account profile at any time. This includes important contact information such as mailing address, phone number and e-mail address. If you are interested in receiving our online offers such as the Border Showdown or Big 12 Championship, be sure to keep your e-mail address up-to-date.

LOST OR STOLEN TICKETS

Season ticket holders with lost, stolen or destroyed tickets should contact the Chiefs Ticket Office at 816.920.9400 to request duplicate tickets. Certain fees will apply.

FANS GIVE BACK


The Kansas City Chiefs and Ticketmaster are teaming up with Chiefs fans to give back to the community through the donation of tickets to the team's home games. By donating Chiefs tickets you are unable to use or by purchasing them for the purpose of donating them, ticket holders have an opportunity to pass them along to a youth charity or member of our Armed Forces. The specific charity will issue you a receipt for the value of the tickets that you can use for tax purposes. Each person who receives a donated ticket will be given a complimentary small soda and hot dog. To donate tickets, log onto your My Chiefs Account and go to the Manage Your Tickets section. Follow the instructions for forwarding tickets free of charge. To allow the charities sufficient time to distribute the donated tickets, tickets must be donated 3 days prior to the game date.

WILL CALL

Due to renovation, the Chiefs Ticket Office will operate on gameday from a portable location on the southeast side of the stadium. Please visit www.newarrowhead.com for any construction updates.

FLEX SCHEDULING

The NFL will implement flexible scheduling for the final seven weeks of the regular season. Season ticket holders will be notified of any changes via e-mail. Schedule changes will also be communicated via www.kcchiefs.com, print, radio and television. This potential time change could affect the Chiefs home games on 11/16, 11/23, 12/14 and 12/21. Please make sure the Chiefs Ticket Office has your current contact information.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

There are parking spaces available to you if you are a disabled ticket holder, provided you have the proper state-issued hang-tag or license plate. You do not need a reserved parking hang-tag to park in the accessible spaces. The spaces are located in the front of Lots A, B, C, F, G, H, and J. They are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

ACCESSIBLE SEATING

Reserved and non-reserved accessible seating areas are located on the lower level concourse. Non-reserved areas are behind Sections 127 and 128.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Policies pertaining to alcohol are in place so that you can enjoy the game in a safe and comfortable environment.

Should you have in your possession alcoholic beverages not purchased at Arrowhead Stadium or carried in a prohibited container, you will be asked to surrender them and they will be disposed of by one of our attendants. You will be refused admission to the stadium if it appears you are intoxicated and will be taken to the Security Office for evaluation.

- State law requires that all persons consuming alcohol be 21 years of age.
- If you are under the age of 35, you will be asked to show a valid identification as to your age prior to purchasing any alcoholic beverages. If it is determined you used a false ID, you may be subject to arrest.
- Only two (2) alcoholic beverages per ID may be purchased at one time.
- No alcoholic beverages will be sold to anyone perceived to be alcohol impaired or intoxicated.

As part of the Chiefs commitment to public safety, ticket holders
can take advantage of the Budweiser Good Sport Designated

Sprint - located on each level of Arrowhead Stadium, where
you will be issued a wristband and a coupon for one free soda

ANNOUNCEMENTS/PAGING

Paging is not possible during any event. If you know the ticket holder's seat location, we will make every possible effort to locate that person for you. If you lose someone or can't find someone, contact the Security Office at Section 118, 816.920.4200 or text message 816.679.7555.

ARROWVISION

There are two video boards, one on each end of the field.

ARROWHEAD CLUB

The Arrowhead Club is located at the 50-yard line on the north side of the stadium. On gameday, it is open to Club members and their guests only. The Club is operated by Levy Restaurants and is available to rent out for other functions as well. Please call 816 920 4701

AUTOGRAPHS

Players are unable to sign autographs during games. For information on community programs, visit www.kcchiefs.com/chiefsway.



AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES (ATMS)

There are seven ATMs located throughout the stadium – on Field Level at each spiral (Sections 105, 114, 124, and 131), on the Club Level at the H ramp, and on the Upper Level at Spirals B and F. There is also one ATM located in the Pavilion.

AUTOMOBILE ASSISTANCE

Tow trucks are on the property in the parking lots to assist fans who encounter problems with their vehicles before, during, or after Chiefs events. Please call Chiefs Security at 816.920.4200.

BABY CHANGING STATIONS

Guests may go to our First Aid stations located at Sections 118 and 101.

CFLL PHONES

Cell phones are permitted in the stadium as long as they do not interfere with other guests' enjoyment of the game.

CHEERI FADERS

For information regarding the Chiefs Cheerleaders, appearances, Teen, Junior, or Angel cheerleader programs, and tryouts, please call 816.920.4843.

CHIEFS KINGDOM

Chiefs Season Ticket Holders live in 48 states (all but Vermont and Maine) and the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and Canada.

CREDIT CARDS

The following credit cards are accepted at Arrowhead Stadium: MasterCard, American Express, Visa, and Discover.

CROWD SYSTEMS INC. PERSONNEL (CSI)

The Chiefs have CSI staff at the top of the aisles throughout the stadium to check tickets and answer any questions from fans. They can be found wearing CSI shirts/jackets. Chiefs employees wearing green shirts also perform similar duties.

DECIREL LEVEL

Arrowhead is known to be the "Loudest Stadium in the NFL," which gives us a great home-field advantage. According to the Acoustical Design Group, Inc. of Mission, Kansas, the following is how the Chiefs rank in maximum sound levels, dBA:

- Threshold of pain 130
- Arrowhead Stadium 116
- 727 landing overhead 106

DESIGNATED DRIVER PROGRAM

Guests who wish to enroll in the Budweiser Good Sport Designated Driver Program should visit a Fans First Booth – Powered by Sprint - located on each level of Arrowhead Stadium (see page 27). You will be given a wristband and a coupon for a free soda or O'Doul's. Individuals will also be registered in a prize drawing at that time.

DONATIONS

The Chiefs are proud to support non-profit organizations and charitable fundraisers within the two-state region of Kansas and Missouri. Due to the high number of requests received, the Chiefs are unable to make other out-of-state donations. Charitable donations are strictly limited to Chiefs articles. Requests for monetary contributions or tickets are not accepted.

- Your non-profit organization must be a 501(c)(3) charity, a school, or a church. You must include your tax ID number. Without a tax ID number, we will be unable to consider your request.
- Chiefs donations are limited to Missouri and Kansas.
- All requests for donated items must be made at least 30 days in advance of an event.
- The Chiefs only donate one item per year per organization.
- The Chiefs do not sponsor businesses.

DROP-OFF POINTS

If you are unable to walk long distances or cannot park in an accessible parking space, you can be dropped off as close to the stadium as possible. Traffic personnel will assist you. For further information, please contact the Stadium Operations Department, 816.920.9300.

EJECTION

The Chiefs reserve the right to eject any patron whose behavior is against policy, unruly or illegal in nature. Game tickets will be forfeited without refund. Revocation of season tickets or arrest is possible.



ELEVATORS/RAMPS

There is a passenger elevator located at Gate E which is available to any ticket holder requiring special assistance on gameday. Please make advance arrangements through the Stadium Operations Department at 816.920.9300. Otherwise, guests are encouraged to take the stairs or ramps.

EMERGENCIES

Should you need immediate assistance, please notify the nearest security guard or fan assistant, or visit a Fans First Booth – Powered by Sprint (see page 27). To contact someone at the stadium in case of an emergency on gameday, please call 816.920.9300.

FVACIJATION

Should there be an immediate need to evacuate the stadium, fans will be given instructions via the public address system. Stadium personnel will help direct you to the nearest concourse so you can proceed to the closest spiral ramp and exit the stadium at street level.

FANS FIRST BOOTHS - POWERED BY SPRINT

Booths are located on each level of Arrowhead Stadium. Chiefs representatives will assist you. Booths are located at the following spiral ramps:

Lower Level – Ramps B, D, F, H Club Level – Ramps B, F Upper Level – Ramps B, D, F, H

FAN MAIL

Mail for players and coaches should be addressed to their individual attention and mailed to the stadium at One Arrowhead Drive, Kansas City, MO 64129. Please note the Kansas City Chiefs assume no responsibility for lost or damaged items.

FIRST AID

First aid is located on the lower concourse at Sections 101 and 118.

FOOD

Fans who have special food needs due to medical reasons may call in advance of the event to our Security Manager at 816.920.9300. Otherwise, patrons are not allowed to bring food into the stadium.

FUNDRAISING

Our concessionaires, Centerplate & Levy Restaurants, are looking for local groups that want to raise money for their activity by vending products at Arrowhead (must be over 21 years of age to sell beer). Your group of 10 or more people (16 years of age or older with adult supervision) should be available to work as few as one or as many as eight events this season. 



Lots and Stadium Access to Arrowhead and Kauffman Stadiums




