Fun Freebie from Butt Knitson Baby Mittens

These cute little mittens are thumbless and perfect for babies and toddlers. Both mittens are worked from the finger tips to the cuff at the same time using the magic loop method.

Skill Level:

Advanced Beginner

Size:

Infant (toddler)

Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in two colors

Gauge: 5.5 sts = 1" in st st

Needles & Notions:

Size US 7 and US5 needles, tapestry needle, stitch marker

Directions:

With color A and using a figure 8 CO; CO 20 sts (10 on each needle) for both mittens. Round 1: Knit Round 2 (Increase Round): *Kfb, K to last st, Kf b* repeat from * on each needle to complete round. Repeat these two round until 28(32) sts on needles per mitten.

Work st st until mittens measures $2''(2\frac{1}{2}'')$ Work chart 1. Work $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3/4") in main color st st. Work decrease round: *K2, K2tog* repeat from * to complete round. 21(24) sts remain With smaller needles, *K2 tbl, p1* repeat from * to complete round for 2.5" or desired length Bind off using sewn BO and weave in ends.
