Changing the world by building a better annornoa

Hamid Razavi left his native Iran at age 18, moving to the United States to continue his education.

Like many immigrants, he faced a world that was completely different from the one he left behind.

But he eventually overcame the language and cultural barriers to earn three degrees – including a PhD in political science – and develop successful businesses.

> He never returned to Iran, as originally planned. But he hasn't forgotten what it was like to be a new American.

Today, Razavi and his wife, Dr. Forough Farzani, serve thousands of new immigrants each year Razayi through their medical

practice, Hillcroft Physicians, located in the center of the Gulfton community.

"This is a neighborhood of hardworking people who have come here for a better life," says Razavi. "It's a thriving population that has tremendous appreciation for what they have and what the country offers.

"But they sometimes don't have the means to care for health problems, and it's not just a financial issue. It's culture, language ... a range of obstacles. That's where we can help. We provide the services they need all in one place, from pediatricians to elder care, dentistry, X-rays, a pharmacy. It's easy to access and convenient."

When Hillcroft Physicians opened in 1994, doctors there saw 16 patients the first week – about three a day.

In 2004, more than 100,000 Gulftonarea residents came to the facility for treatment. In total, they represented nearly 50 different nationalities. Those numbers are the result of the community's trust in the doctors and staff.

Razavi savs his goal is to expand the services offered to Gulfton residents by collaborating with agencies such as Neighborhood Centers Inc. He plans to continue working toward that goal over the next few years.

It's about giving back, he says.

"My goal was always to go back to Iran and become a political leader," he remembers. "But life taught me a lesson here. In order to change the world, you have to start with your neighborhood – your family, your friends, your neighbors, the area where you live and work. Let's change the world by building a better community ... that's what we're trying to do here."
