

knit v-neck sweater

LT1546 Easy Easy Designed by Ann E. Smith.

Directions are for Size Small; changes for Medium, Large, and Extra Large are in parentheses.

TLC® "Amore®": 3 (3, 3, 4) Skeins No. 3822 Skyway.

Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9]. Circular Knitting Needle: 5.5mm [US 9] – 24". 2 Stitch markers, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 22 sts = 6"; 22 rows = 4" in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

To Fit Bust: 30-32 (34-36, 38-40, 42-44)". **Finished Bust:** 38 (42, 46, 50)".

BACK: Cast on 70 (78, 84, 92) sts. Beg with a P row, work in St st until 14" from beg, end P row.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 9 (11, 12, 15) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work even on 52 (56, 60, 62) sts until 20 (20 1/2, 21, 21 1/2)" from beg, end P row.

Divide for Neck/Shoulder: K11 (13, 15, 16) sts, join a new skein and bind off center 30 sts, K to end. Working sides separately and at the same time, dec 1 st at each neck edge every row 3 times. Work even on rem 8 (10, 12, 13) sts for each shoulder until 21 1/2 (22, 22 1/2, 23)" from beg, end P row. Bind off.

Lower Edge Trim: With wrong side facing, pick up and K70 (78, 84, 92) sts across cast-on edge. Bind off knitwise.

FRONT: Work as for Back until 11 (11 1/2, 12, 12 1/2)" from beg, end P row.

Divide for V-Neck: K35 (39, 42, 46) sts, join a new skein and K to end. Work sides separately and at the same time.

Next Row: Purl.

Dec Row: K across to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1; for next side, K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K to end. Rep last 2 rows 8 times **more**, then dec every 4th row 9 times AND AT THE SAME TIME, when 14" from beg, shape armholes same as for Back. After all decreases, work even on 8 (10, 12, 13) sts for each shoulder until same length as Back, end P row. Bind off. Work Lower Edge Trim same as for Back.

SLEEVE CABLE PANEL (Worked over 18 sts): Row 1 (Right Side): P1, K2tog, yo, K2, P1, K6, P1, K2tog, yo, K2, P1.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: P1, K2tog, yo, K2, P1 yo; slip next 3 sts onto right-hand needle, K in front and back of next st, K2, pass the 3 slipped sts over the 4 sts just worked – cable made; yo, P1, K2tog, yo, K2, P1.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 1 and 2. Rep Rows 1-8 for Sleeve Cable Panel.

SLEEVES: Cast on 38 (40, 42, 44) sts.

Foundation Row (Wrong Side): P10 (11, 12, 13) sts, place marker; K1, P4, K1, P6, K1, P4, K1, place marker, P10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): K to marker, sl marker, work Sleeve Cable Panel Row 1 to next marker, sl marker, K to end.

Row 2: P to marker, sl marker, work Sleeve Cable Panel Row 2 to next marker, sl marker, P to end.

St st and panel are now established. Keeping continuity of panel rows and working sts outside markers in St st, shape sides by inc 1 st each end of 11th row, then every 6th row until there are 54 (58, 60, 64) sts, working added sts in St st. Work even until 14 1/2 (15, 15 1/4, 16)" from beg, ending wrong side row. Bind off. Add Trim to lower edge as for Back.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves, sewing upper 2 1/2 (3, 3 1/4, 4)" to bind-off sts of body. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With right side facing and circular needle, beg at right front, pick up and K45 sts up to shoulder, 43 sts across back, and 45 sts down left front to center "V" – 133 sts. Do not join but work back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): P1, * K1, P1; rep from * across. **Row 2:** K1, * P1, K1; rep from * across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for ribbing for 3 1/4". Bind off in ribbing. Cross right over left band and tack in place.



TLC® "Amoré®", Art. E515 (6 ounce/278 yard solid color; 4.5 ounce/214 yard multi-color skein).

ABBREVIATIONS: beg = beginning; dec = decrease; inc = increase; K = knit; lp(s) = loop(s); mm = millimeters; P = Purl; pat = pattern; psso = pass the slipped st over the Knit st; rem = remaining; rep = repeat; sl = slip; St st = Stockinette stitch (K on right side rows; P on wrong side rows); st(s) = stitch (es); tog = together; yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



crochet woven ribbons blanket

Blanket measures approximately 38" x 38".

TLC® "Baby Amore™": 12 Ounces No. 9940 Baby Print CA, 6 ounces each No. 9631 Mint CB and No. 9001 White CC.

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]. Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4"; 14 rows = 4" in pat. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

Long dc: Yo and insert hook in indicated sc, draw up lp to height of row in progress, [yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice. For easier access of skipped sts, fold crochet rows back to expose lps of skipped sts. Do not work around skipped rows – the long dc should sit on the surface of the right side of the blanket.

To Change Colors In Sc: With working color, draw up a lp in next st, drop working color and pick up new color, draw new color through 2 lps on hook.

BLANKET

With CA, ch 109.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across: turn – 108 sc.

Row 2: With CA, ch 1, sc in first sc, * ch 2, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * to last 3 sc; ch 2, skip next 2 sc, sc in last sc changing to CB; turn. Do not cut CA but carry it loosely up side of rows until needed again.

Row 3: With CB, ch 1, sc in each sc and ch across; turn.

Row 4: With CB, sc in each sc across changing to CA in last sc: turn.

Row 5: With CA, ch 1, sc in first sc, * long dc in next 2 skipped sc 3 rows below, skip next 2 sc on Row 4 **, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * to last sc, end at **; sc in last sc; turn.

Row 6: With **CA**, ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, * ch 2, skip next 2 sc **, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, end at **; sc in last 5 sts changing to **CC** in last sc; turn.

Rows 7 and 8: With CC, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Row 9: With **CA**, ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, * long dc in 2 skipped sc 3 rows below, skip next 2 sc on Row 8 **, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * to last 5 sc, end at **; sc in last 5 sc; turn.

Rep Rows 2-9 for pat until approximately 36" from beg, end Row 9; turn.

Next Row: With CA, ch 1, sc in each st across; fasten off

FINISHING: With right side facing, join CA at lower right corner; ch 1, sc in each row end up right side edge of blanket. Fasten off.

With right side facing, join **CA** in upper left corner; ch 1, sc in each row end down left side edge of blanket. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Border: With right side facing, join **CA** in any sc. **Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same sc as joining, * ch 3, skip next sc **, sc in next sc; rep from * around, end at **; join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: With right side facing and holding ch-3 lp back, join **CB** in any skipped sc on Rnd 1; ch 1, sc in same sc, * ch 3, push Rnd 1 to front and *working* **behind** Rnd 1 sts, sc in next skipped sc, ch 3, push Rnd 1 to back and *working in* **front** of Rnd 1 sts, sc in next skipped sc; rep from * around; join with a sl st in top of first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
