ARIS 2008

- ARIS 2008 replicates the methodology of ARIS 2001
- Based on a national telephone survey
- Using RDD sample of 50,000 American adult respondents
- The basic open-ended religious identification question:
 - What is your religion, if any?





No Religion Population by State, 2001




Percent Male Among Atheist, Agnostic and No Religion Adults

How the No Religion Population Grows over the Life Cycle

Both parents of No Religion when growing up.	14%
No Religious Initiation (baptism, etc.).	37%
Identified with No Religion at Age 18.	50%
Had a non-religious marriage ceremony.	50%
Expect a non-religious funeral.	72%
