



Blue Mountain Handcrafts

Blackberry Patch Scarf



Completed scarf measures approximately 49" long is done in two pieces

You will need:

size 9 straight needles

1 7" or longer size 9 DPN

6 oz. BSYC worsted weight yarn

2 row counters—one for counting rows, one for counting pattern repeats

4 stitch markers—the kind you can slide from needle to needle

1 cable needle

1 tapestry needle

Stitch Explanations:

sl 1—slip 1 stitch from left needle to right needle

m1—make one, this stitch is used during the leaf part of the pattern, I knit 1 in the back of the stitch preceding or following the m1 depending on the stitches. Ex. k2tog, m1, p1—I would m1 in the back of the stitch to be purled before purling Or ex. p3, m1, sl 1—I would m1 in the back of the last stitch to be purled

4 in 1—literally means make four stitches in the next stitch (k1, p1, k1, p1) before slipping the stitch off of the left hand needle

cb3—slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back

***** the backslash mark (/) indicates where the moveable stitch markers should be placed to help keep track of where you are in the pattern as it is done in sections******

*****TO BEGIN:** cast on 36 stitches and knit 4 rows

Blackberry Canes (mock eyelet cable)—repeat pattern 6xs (24 rows)

Row 1: k4, p5, *sl 1, k2, pss0, p2* repeat 3 more times from * to *, k4

Row 2: k4, k5, *p1, yo, p1, k2* repeat 3 more times from * to *, k4

Row 3: k4, p5, *k3, p2* repeat 3 more times from * to *, k4

Row 4: k4, k5, * p3, k2* repeat 3 more times from * to *, k4

Canes & Berries—repeat pattern 3xs (12 rows)

Row 1: k3 / p10 / p1, sl 1, k2, pssso, p2, sl 1, ks, pssso, p1 / p10 / k3

Row 2: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k1, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1, yo, p1, k1 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 3: k3 / p10 / p1, k3, p2, k3, p1 / p10 / k3

Row 4: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k1, p3, k2, p3, k1 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Berries—repeat pattern 3x's plus 2 rows (14 rows, you will end with row 2) **leave your markers in, you'll need them later**

Row 1: k3 / purl across to last 3 stitches / k3

Row 2: k3 / *4 in 1, p4tog*—repeat from * to * across row to last 3 stitches / k3

Row 3: repeat Row 1

Row 4: k3 / *p4 tog, 4 in 1*—repeat from * to * across row to last 3 stitches / k3

Berries & Leaves

Row 1: k3 / p7 / p5, k1, p1, k1, p1, m1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k4 / p7 / k3

Row 2: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p2tog / p5, k2, p1, k1, p1, k5 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p2tog / k3

Row 3: k3 / p6 / p4, k2, p1, k1, p2, m1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k3 / p6 / k3

Row 4: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / p4, k3, p1, k1, p2, k4 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Row 5: k3 / p9 / p3, k2tog, k1, yo, p1, k1, p3, m1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2 / p9 / k3

Row 6: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / p3, k4, p1, k1, p3, k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 7: k3 / p6 / p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, p4, m1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1 / p6 / k3

Row 8: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / p2, k5, p1, k1, p4, k2 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Row 9: k3 / p9 / p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, p1, k1, p5, m1, sl 1, k1, pssso / p9 / k3

Row 10: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k7, p1, k1, p5, k1 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 11: k3 / p6 / k2tog, k1, yo, k3, p1, k1, p7 / p6 / k3

******Blackberry stitches stop here.....leave your markers in!******

Row 12: k3 / k6 / k7, p1, k1, p6 / k6 / k3

Row 13: k3 / p6 / k4, k2tog, m1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p5 / p6 / k3

Row 14: k3 / k6 / k5, p1, k1, p1, k2, p5 / k6 / k3

Row 15: k3 / p6 / k3, k2tog, m1, p2, k1, p1, k2, p4 / p6 / k3

Row 16: k3 / k6 / k4, p2, k1, p1, k3, p4 / k6 / k3

Row 17: k3 / p6 / k2, k2tog, m1, p3, k1, p1, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p3 / p3 / k3

Row 18: k3 / k6 / k3, p3, k1, p1, k4, p3 / k6 / k3

Row 19: k3 / p6 / k1, k2tog, m1, p4, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p2 / p6 / k3

Row 20: k3 / k6 / k2, p4, k1, p1, k5, p2 / k6 / k3

Row 21: k3 / p6 / k2tog, m1, p5, k1, p1, k2, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p1 / p6 / k3

Row 22: k3 / k6 / k1, p5, k1, p1, k7 / k6 / k3

Row 23: k3 / p6 / p7, k1, p1, k3, yo, k1 sl 1, k1, pssso / p6 / k3

Row 24: k3 / k6 / p6, k1, p1, k7 / k6 / k3

******Repeat Leaf Pattern (between markers 2 & 3) in rows 1-13 of Berries & Leaves knitting or purling the berry sections according to the side facing, continue with k3 on each end.**

Berries & Leaves picking up berries again

Row 14: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k5, p1, k1, p1, k2, p5 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Row 15: k3 / p9 / k3, k2tog, m1, p2, k1, p1, k2, p4 / p9 / k3

Row 16: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k4, p2, k1, p1, k3, p4 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 17: k3 / p6 / k2, k2tog, m1, p3, k1, p1, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p3 / p6 / k3

Row 18: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3, p3, k1, p1, k4, p3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Row 19: k3 / p9 / k1, k2tog, m1, p4, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p2 / k9 / k3

Row 20: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k2, p4, k1, p1, k5, p2 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 21: k3 / p6 / k2tog, m1, p5, k1, p1, k2, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, p1 / p6 / k3

Row 22: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k1, p5, k1, p1, k7 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Row 23: k3 / p9 / p7, k1, p1, k3, yo, k1, sl 1, k1, pss0/ p9 / k3

Row 24: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / p6, k1, p1, k7 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

*****Start Berries pattern with Row 1, repeat pattern 6x's (24 rows) with k4 at beginning and end of rows—you will only need 2 markers now, move them as necessary.**

*****Start Canes & Berries pattern, repeat pattern 3x's (12 rows) beginning and ending with k3—move markers as necessary.**

Canes & Berries with Twist

Row 1: k3 / p10 / p1, cb3, p2, k3, k3 from cable needle, p1 / p10 / k3

Row 2: k3 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k1, p3, k2, p3, k1 / 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog / k3

Row 3: k3 / p10 / p1, k3, p2, k3, p1 / p10 / k3

Row 4: k3 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k1, p3, k2, p3, k1 / p4tog, 4 in 1, p4tog, 4 in 1 / k3

Start Canes & Berries pattern again and repeat 3x's (12 rows) beginning and ending with k3

Start Berries pattern and repeat 5x's (20 rows) beginning and ending with k4

When last Berries section is done transfer stitches to long DPN.

Second section of scarf: repeat from beginning cast on ending with 1 repeat (4 rows) of Berries pattern that follows Berries & Leaves section. With right sides together, do triple needle bind off leaving a 24" tail. Thread the tail onto blunt tapestry needle and stitch down ridge created by bind off weaving in loose ends.

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
