

**Purchasing Light Rail Tickets**  
 buy, stamp, ride

**PROOF OF PAYMENT**  
 Light Rail is a 'proof of payment' system. You must be able to show a valid ticket upon request. All one-way and 10-trip tickets must be time-stamped prior to boarding to make them valid. A monthly light rail pass, a monthly or weekly NJ TRANSIT Rail pass (imprinted with a zone number) or any NJ TRANSIT two-zone (or higher) Bus pass, are also valid to ride. Follow the easy steps below. Passengers without a valid ticket are subject to a fine of up to \$100.

**BUY FIRST**  
 If you are not using one of the monthly or weekly tickets above, you must purchase (and time-stamp) a ticket just before boarding light rail cars or before entering Prepaid Fare Zones at Hoboken, Port Imperial, Lincoln Harbor, Tonnelle Avenue, Bergenline Avenue, and 2nd, 9th and 22nd Street stations. Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs) are located near entrances or on platforms and at Park & Ride lots at each station. Proof of Payment details are displayed on TVMs and Ticket Information posters at stations. Prepaid Fare Zones are prominently marked with signs as you approach the platform.

**REMEMBER TO TIME STAMP**  
 You must time-stamp all one-way tickets and 10-trip tickets in Validators located near TVMs just before boarding light rail cars or entering the Prepaid Fare Zones listed above. To time-stamp your ticket, insert it into the time-stamp machine with the print side up and the NJ TRANSIT logo facing to the left. The machine will date and time-stamp your ticket for 90 minutes of use.

**RIDE THE LINE**  
 After you have time-stamped your ticket, simply get on board and ride. NJ TRANSIT Fare Enforcement Officers make random ticket inspections on vehicles and at Prepaid Fare Zones. Keep your ticket handy until exiting your station of destination, as you may be asked to show your ticket more than once during your trip. If you are a senior citizen or passenger with a disability and are traveling with a reduced fare ticket, you must provide a valid form of ID upon request.

**FARE INSPECTION**  
 Customers must present a valid proof of payment as listed above under request. Fare violators are subject to fine under State Law N.J.A.C. 16:87—Proof of Payment.

**Light Rail Fare Options**  
 saving you time and money

We want to make your travel convenient and economical, so we offer lots of options:

**Monthly Passes** Valid for unlimited trips within a calendar month; and can be purchased from Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs), located at light rail stations, beginning at 5pm on the 19th of the month prior. (See Travel Flexibility for more information.) In addition, you can purchase joint HBLR and NY Waterway monthly passes from all HBLR TVMs. Monthly passes should not be validated.

**One-Way Tickets** Valid for one continuous trip. These tickets are good from the date of sale until used and must be validated just before use. You can also purchase an add-on one-zone bus transfer with a one-way ticket from TVMs.

**Round-Trip Tickets** Two one-way tickets for travel to or from your destination. These tickets are good from the date of sale until used and must be validated just before use.

**Discounted 10-Trip Tickets** Ten individual single-use tickets, that are good for 20 days including the date of purchase. Each ticket must be validated just before use.

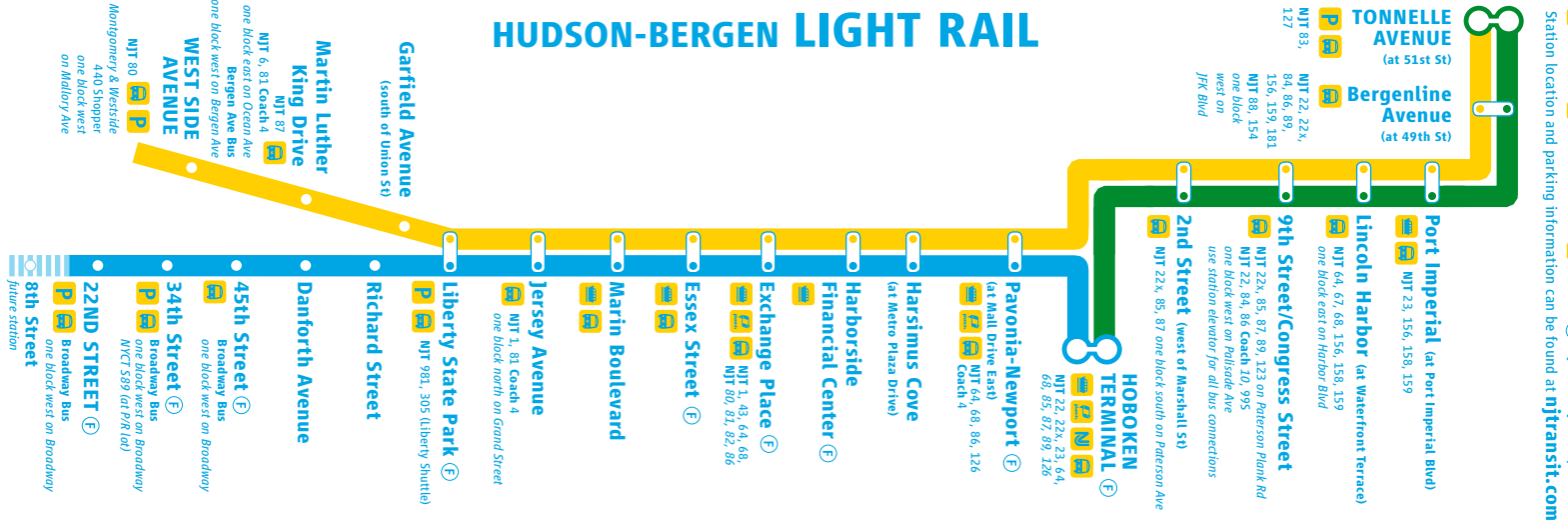
**Senior Citizens (62 and older) and Passenger with Disabilities** travel on light rail at a reduced fare of one-half the regular one-way fare or less at all times. Seniors may be asked to present a valid ID (any ID or document printed with date-of-birth and issued by a government, social service, or mass transportation agency). Also valid: the MTA Reduced Fare Card; PA Senior Citizen Transit ID or PACE Card; Senior Fare Card; or Medicare Card. Passengers with disabilities must present an NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID or Medicare Card.

**Children's Fares** Small kids, small fares: ages 5-11 save at least 50% on regular one-way fares; 4 and under (up to three children) ride free with a passenger paying any valid fare.

**Family SuperSaver Fares** NJ TRANSIT allows two children ages 5-11 to ride free with a passenger paying any valid fare—weekends and holidays from 7pm Friday (or day before a holiday) to 6am Monday (or day after a holiday).

Flexibilidad

Use su pase para tren o autobús Puede usar su pase de tren mensual o semanal de NJ TRANSIT (con el número de zona impreso) o cualquier pase de autobús mensual de 2 zonas para viajar en cualquier tren del Light Rail sin cargo adicional durante el periodo de validez del pase.

Use su pase del Light Rail Puede utilizar su pase mensual del Light Rail para viajes de una (1) zona, sin pagar una tarifa adicional, para viajar en las líneas de autobuses operadas o contratadas por NJ TRANSIT y líneas de autobuses locales privadas contratadas que aparecen en tarjetas de autobús de NJ TRANSIT.

Trasbordos para boletos de ida Los pasajeros pueden obtener un trasbordo de una zona, válido para hacer conexión con el Light Rail, pagando 60¢ al conductor del autobús de la línea NJ TRANSIT. Los pasajeros que obtengan sus boletos en las máquinas expendedoras (TVMs) del Light Rail pueden comprar al mismo tiempo el trasbordo de una zona válido para hacer conexión con un viaje de una zona en autobús.

Conexiones

Las líneas de autobuses de NJ TRANSIT y las líneas de autobuses privadas ofrecen servicio desde localidades cercanas a la mayoría de las estaciones del Light Rail. En el mapa de esta tabla de horarios se indican muchas rutas de conexión de autobuses.

PATH ofrece servicio de trenes entre las estaciones Hoboken y la calle 33 en New York, Newark y el World Trade Center. Es posible hacer conexiones con el Light Rail en las estaciones Pavonia Newport, Exchange Place y Hoboken. Para obtener más información, llame al 1 800 234 7284.

En la terminal de Hoboken, hay conexiones con trenes de NJ TRANSIT de las líneas Main/Bergen County, Morris y Essex, Montclair Boonton, y Passack Valley. Para obtener detalles del servicio de conexiones consulte el mapa del sistema y los itinerarios.

ANTES DE VIAJAR

Todas las estaciones de servicio del Light Rail tienen acceso para personas incapacitadas.

Mascotas Los únicos animales que pueden viajar a bordo de NJ TRANSIT son los animales entrenados para brindar ayuda que acompañen a pasajeros incapacitados o sus entrenadores; los perros peludos y las mascotas pequeñas en jaulas de mano para viajes.

Fumar Está prohibido fumar en las estaciones del Light Rail y en las vagones.

Teléfonos celulares y dispositivos electrónicos Escuche música y hable a un volumen que no moleste a otros pasajeros.

Bicicletas y patines en línea Está permitido viajar con bicicletas y Segways en los vagones del Light Rail fuera de las horas pico durante los días de semana de 9:30am a 4pm y de 7pm a 6am y durante todo el día de sábados, domingos y feriados estatales. Usted puede viajar con patines de una sola hilera de ruedas (patines en línea) sin llevarlos puestos.

PRIMERO LA SEGURIDAD Al subir o bajar del tren Párese siempre a aproximadamente 3 pies del borde de la plataforma y la línea de seguridad. No se apoye en las puertas. No camine ni se pare sobre las vías; no se trepe a los postes ni arroje objetos a los trenes del Light Rail.

Al cruzar las vías Los trenes del Light Rail tienen un andar suave y silencioso. Mire a ambos lados antes de cruzar las vías y sólo cruce las vías en los cruces designados donde existen señales o semáforos.

Manténgase alerta Los cables aéreos que llevan electricidad a los vagones del Light Rail son peligrosos. Manténgase siempre lejos de los mismos.

En caso de emergencia Escuche los anuncios y siga las instrucciones del personal del Light Rail o NJ TRANSIT.

FERIADOS

El servicio Hudson Bergen Light Rail operará según el horario de sábados/domingos el 1 de enero, Martín Luther King Jr. Day, President's Day (Día de los presidentes), Memorial Day, Independence Day (4 de Julio), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day (Día de acción de gracias), el viernes siguiente al Día de acción de gracias y el día de Navidad. Operará según el horario normal de día de semana en la víspera de Año Nuevo.

ESTACIONAMIENTO

Las siguientes estaciones tienen servicio Park & Ride: calles 22 y 34 en Bayonne; West Side Avenue y Liberty Street en Jersey City; y Tonnelles Avenue en North Bergen. Los pasajeros pueden comprar el permiso de estacionamiento mensual o diario junto con los boletos del Light Rail en las TVMs ubicadas en las estaciones con servicios Park & Ride. El permiso de estacionamiento diario es válido durante 24 horas a partir del momento de compra. El permiso de estacionamiento también se ofrece sin la compra de un boleto de transporte y sólo es válido en la playa de estacionamiento si lo es compra.
