## AIR VICE-MARSHAL JOHN HARVEY

Air Vice-Marshal (AVM) John Harvey joined the RAAF in 1977 and conducted navigator training at East Sale before being posted to Canberra aircraft at RAAF Amberley. After a four year tour on Canberra aircraft he spent one year as the escort officer to the Minister for Defence.

After a three year flying tour of F-111's he completed the RAAF Aero systems course and returned to Australia for a three year posting in Technical Intelligence at the Joint Intelligence Organisation. On return to Australia he worked on staff at the Australian Defence College, then became Director Military Strategy in HQADF before being promoted and appointed **Director General Aerospace** Development. In September 2002 he was appointed as Director General New Air Combat Capability. In November 2006 he was promoted and appointed as Program Manager New Air Combat Capability in the Defence Materiel Organisation.
