Financial Summary

General

Animals Asia Foundation (AAF) is a Hong Kong-based government-registered animal welfare charity founded by Jill Robinson MBE in 1998. Animals Asia Foundation has corporate presence in various countries and is audited in accordance with local regulations in each of the jurisdictions. We also have charitable status in Hong Kong, UK, Australia, Italy, Germany and 501(c)(3) status in USA - all donations are tax deductible in these countries. The Moon Bear Rescue Centres are located in Chengdu, China and Tam Dao, Vietnam.

The following is a financial summary of the audited accounts of AAF Hong Kong for the fiscal year 2007/2008.



Operating results

Total income for the year decreased by 6.64% to \$3,959,920 due to a downturn in donations in the final quarter. Total expenditure for the year Increased by 6% to \$3,807,357 and we ended the financial year with an operating surplus of \$152,563 (2007: \$650,286). As a result of our policy of ensuring donations are applied as efficiently as possible, 83.7% of expenditure for the year was spent on our various programmes. Our administrative expenses to provide organisational support for the year were \$383,403, amounting to 10.1% of total expenditure. A total of \$235,652 amounting to 6.2% of total expenditure was spent on Fund Raising. Total expenditure is summarised in the chart below.
