Criteria for Data Collection:

- > Unduplicated headcount as of the 15th day of classes
- > Students in degree credit courses of instruction only
- > If a student attends multiple campuses of one college or university, one campus is selected based on preponderant enrollment.

¹ Fiscal Year 2009 is the first year that the merger between the Medical University of Ohio and the University of Toledo is recognized in the Preliminary Headcount Report. The headcount for the University of Toledo now includes the enrollment at the Medical University of Ohio. For prior years, the Medical University of Ohio and the University of Toledo were reported as two separate institutions.

Note: Preliminary Headcounts are the total enrollments for the Autumn academic term as of the end of business on the 15th calendar day of the Autumn academic term. This count includes all enrollments in degree-credit courses of instruction where the start date is on or before the 15th calendar day of the Autumn term. Preliminary Headcount data usually differs from finalized end-of-term headcounts.
