#### INTRODUCTION

Since the 1999 general election, there have been a number of developments that have altered the national electoral landscape. The most fundamental were the 2001 National Population and Housing Census, and the decision by Parliament to increase the number of popularly elected members of the National Assembly from 40 to 57, as well as to increase the total national popularly elected members of Councils from 406 to 490. As required by section 64 (2) (b) of the Constitution of Botswana, in July 2002 a Delimitation Commission was then appointed by the Judicial Service Commission to draw the boundaries of the newly increased constituencies. This rendered the then existing rolls of voters obsolete.

Before new rolls of voters could be attained, however, the Secretary to the Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) was bound by section 5 (1) of the Electoral Act, to divide each of the recently delimited constituencies into polling districts and establish within each of those districts polling stations. The latter would be necessary for any extensive registration exercise, which was clearly imperative. The Minister of Local Government increased the number of polling districts to 490. Accordingly in the period March to July 2003 a demarcation of polling districts and establishment of polling stations exercise was embarked upon by demarcation committees delegated for the task by the IEC Secretary. The committees were set up, and comprised of District Commissioners and District Officers as Chairpersons, Principal Elections Officers as Secretaries, representatives of the various political parties, community leaders, civic organizations as well as non-governmental organizations. The committees demarcated the 490 polling districts, and established 2178 polling stations, facilitating the declaration of the voter registration period.

Another significant development before the 2004 general election, was the promulgation in November 2003 of the Electoral (Amendment) Act. This Act ushered in changes such as the requirement of an applicant for registration to produce his national identity card; introduction of a machine readable Form A, the ability of a registered voter to obtain a duplicate of his/her voter registration card from any registration officer; and the enhanced deposits of P500 and P100 for prospective Parliamentary and Local Government candidates respectively.

#### **VOTER EDUCATION**

After the results of the 1999 General Elections there was concern that the low voter turnout indicated that there was voter disengagement/voter apathy. In view of this, the IEC commissioned the Democracy Research Project (DRP) of the University of Botswana to conduct a voter apathy study to establish the causes for the apparent voter apathy and come up with recommendations.

Some of the major recommendations were that:

- 1. Voter education should be intensified before elections.
- 2. Churches and other civic organizations should be encouraged to make announcements about registration and voting; and urge their members to discuss politics.

Following the recommendations of the Voter Apathy study, the IEC embarked on an intensive voter education campaign to encourage voters to participate in the electoral process. Two advertising agencies for electronic and print media were engaged to assist in developing educational programmes and materials.

The initial campaign strategy was to brand the IEC. This phase of the strategy involved production of publicity materials such as pens, caps, t-shirts, radio jingles and television adverts which were meant to make people aware of the existence of the IEC.

The IEC also developed a web site, published a newsletter and placed adverts in electronic boards, billboards, newspapers and magazines. In all our print adverts we used 'Mmutlanyana-wa-Ditlhopho' a concept that has been associated with elections in Botswana for a long time. A number of sensitization workshops were organized around the country to educate people about the importance of participating in the electoral process and selection of leaders through the ballot. Participants at these workshops were community leaders who among others included chiefs, heads of government departments, political parties, youth and women representatives and the general citizenry.

The IEC through its sponsorship of Matlho-a-Phage programme on Botswana Television gained some mileage towards its branding. This programme provided the electorate with the opportunity to learn more about political parties and other election related issues.

An outreach broadcast vehicle was acquired late this year to enhance the already existing educational programmes. So far the programmes have proved popular as shown by the record attendance in kgotla meetings especially amongst the youth, in the places visited. This vehicle will also be available for utilization by other organizations at a cost to advance programmes that have a relation to elections and HIV/AIDS public education and awareness.

The IEC produced an election song "Ditlhopho di tsile" which has proved very popular with both the young and old. The song helped in advertising the elections. A voter education stage drama 'Tlhopho seabe sa Borena' was also produced. The drama played a major role in sensitizing the public on elections and it was performed in 54 villages around the country.

One of the findings of the voter apathy study was that generally the faith sector did not actively participate in matters relating to democracy and governance and as such did not make announcements about voter registration, elections or even encourage its members to stand for political positions. In that light, the IEC organized a workshop for the faith sector in August 2003 to tackle the problems identified by the study. The faith sector in turn organized workshops in their respective denominations and invited IEC personnel as resource persons.

Two workshops, Democracy and Conflict management, and Political Leadership, were organized for political parties in April 2003 and July 2004 respectively. All these efforts were an endeavour to strengthen our relationships with our core stakeholders and also assist them better manage their organizations.

The IEC collaborated with many organizations such as the Directorate on Corruption and Economic Crime, National AIDS Coordinating Agency, Botswana National Youth Council, Emang Basadi and other NGOs by participating in their seminars, workshops, conferences and fairs where accurate information on the electoral process was provided.

As an extension of the voter education programme the IEC Secretary took a tour of the country to address potential political party candidates for the 2004 general elections. The first tour was conducted between January and February 2004, while the second round was in June 2004.

The purpose of the meetings was to assist potential political party candidates to appreciate their role at nomination and election time. Potential candidates were apprised about the role of IEC and its activities. Such activities included among others, the establishment of Party Liaison Committees for purposes of dealing with disputes on the ground and consultation on matters of mutual interest.

The Secretary's message on the main sought cooperation and collaboration with the prospective candidates so that they could in turn encourage the electorate to register and then vote in large numbers.

This move was applauded by political parties who also assured the Secretary of their support in the electoral process. An impact assessment to evaluate what our voter education programmes achieved is yet to be done.

#### RECRUITMENT AND TRAINING OF POLL STAFF

For each of the 57 constituencies one Returning Officer and fifteen Assistant Returning Officers were identified and appointed. These comprised District Commissioners, District Officers, Chief Executives of Councils and Land Boards as well as Heads of Secondary Schools and other senior government officers. Similarly 2178 Presiding Officers and 8712 Polling Officers were recruited. This category comprises mostly teachers.

Training workshops were run in all the constituencies for Returning officers and their assistants. They were guided through their responsibilities, starting with nominations through voting to the declaration of results. "A Guide to Returning Officers" and the Electoral Act were used as reference material.

Presiding Officers and Polling Officers were also taken through the polling process. Police officers and party agents were also included in this training. A guide in the conduct of elections for this category of officers was prepared and distributed to help them understand the process better. Owing to a lapse of time between the dates of the training workshops and the day of the poll, refresher courses were held in all the constituencies to address any grey areas and to do the necessary demonstrations.

The Independent Electoral Commission recruits officers from the public service, the Unified Local Government Service and the Unified Teaching Service. Our general understanding was that the management of all these services do appreciate the importance of general elections and that once they have been notified of the selection of their members for this national event, staff transfers would be suspended. It is a matter of concern that this did not happen. Even after the issue of the writ we have had to replace a sizeable number of staff.

#### VOTER REGISTRATION AND PREPARATION OF ROLLS

The demarcation of polling districts and the establishment of polling stations exercise in accordance with section 5 of the Electoral Act resulted in 2,178 polling stations being established. Each polling station was to be manned by two registration officers. A total of 4,256 out of school youth were engaged as registration officers. One hundred and seventy (170) supervisors were engaged to oversee the work of the registration officers. Workshops were organised in all the constituencies where these officers were trained on the registration procedures and supervisory techniques for others.

A general registration was conducted from 1<sup>st</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2003 in all the fifty-seven constituencies. On the expiry of this registration period 425,824 voters had been registered. This was satisfactory although our target figure of 675,000 had not been reached. A continuous registration followed from 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2003 to 12<sup>th</sup> March 2004, at which 5,141 voters turned up for registration. A supplementary registration exercise was conducted from 13<sup>th</sup> March 2004 to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2004. Again out of school youth were engaged and a total of 75,476 Batswana were registered.

A final continuous registration exercise was undertaken between 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2004 and 4<sup>th</sup> July 2004 at which 46,407 voters were registered. At the end of all these efforts a total of 552,849 Batswana were registered including 2436 Batswana registered externally. Refer to Appendices K and L.

It was discovered that some of the registration officers had performed very well, while cases of negligence on the part of others were noticed. Such cases of negligence resulted in some voters being omitted from the voter's roll yet carrying voter's registration cards. Fortunately such cases were relatively few and could not have adversely affected the outcome of the general elections.

However, the Commission regrets the occurrence of these incidents as the omission of a voter's name from the roll is a denial of the right to vote.

The voter registration task led to the compilation and maintenance of electoral database, as well as the production of the voters' rolls. A large amount of information had to be gathered in a short period of time, and a large volume of resources and materials were required to accomplish this. Voter registration is often the single most costly component of an election as was the case in this election. The sheer magnitude of the voter registration exercise led to the adoption of an Optical Mark Reading (OMR) Scanning System for voter registration purposes. OMR typically involves a scanner reading particular kinds of marks in a defined set of locations on a form. This necessitated the introduction of the machine readable voter registration form. The voter registration form itself is simple and straight forward and is intended to gather basic information on the voter.

Two large scanners were acquired. Each scanner has the capacity to process up to ten thousand (10,000) forms per an hour. The adoption of this new technology for electoral purposes was not a radical departure from the existing practice.

The accuracy of the voters' rolls was dependent upon the information available at the National Registration (OMANG) System as well as what was recorded on the form by the registration officers at the time of registration. There were few cases where, the elections system rejected people because they carried OMANG cards with non-existing numbers at the Department of National Registration.

Also, there were quite a number of cases where the shading and the recording of information into the voter registration cards was erroneous resulting in the voters being unable to cast their vote as they did not appear on the voters' rolls. These are avoidable mistakes. The Commission undertakes to minimise the occurrence of these mistakes in future by enhancing training of both supervisors and registration officers.

#### **LOGISTICS**

Following the demarcation of polling districts and establishment of polling stations, it became apparent that additional election materials were going to be required for the 2004 General Elections. However, the stock in hand of polling booths and ballot boxes proved adequate to cover both Parliamentary and Local Government Elections.

Local companies were engaged to repair damaged polling booths and modify approximately 5000 ballot boxes to comply with the amended Electoral Act. Equipment in the form of marque tents, cadac lamps and consumable items such as padlock seals (to replace padlock and keys) candles, markers, pens etc, were ordered and stockpiled.

Transport requirements by type were identified and necessary requests made to Central Transport Organization depots around the country. Where there was a shortfall Local Authorities were approached.

These vehicles were required for the registration exercise and for the distribution of election materials and transportation of personnel during polling to various polling stations. Arrangements were also made for air transport and boats to areas that were inaccessible by land.

The Independent Electoral Commission in consultation with the Government Printer engaged the services of a United Kingdom company for the design and production of the base stock for the printing of ballot papers. Security features were incorporated in the design and manufacturing of base stock paper. The paper was shipped from the United Kingdom to a printer in South Africa for the printing of the ballot papers. As ballot papers would be area based, printing had to await the outcome of nomination of candidates which took place on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2004.

#### Distribution of election materials

The election materials were packed according to polling stations and Returning Officers had to verify them against the check-list before collection.

#### DISSOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT AND ISSUANCE OF WRIT OF ELECTION

His Excellency the President dissolved the National Assembly with effect from the 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2004, and on the 17<sup>th</sup> September 2004 he issued a writ of election for each of the 57 constituencies. In these writs, the President appointed the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2004 and the 30<sup>th</sup> October 2004, as nomination and polling days, respectively.

In terms of sections 154 (2) of the Electoral Act (Cap 02:09), the Honorable Minister of Local Government issued 490 election instruments for the nomination and election of City/Town or District Council representatives. The instruments also appointed the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2004 and 30<sup>th</sup> October 2004 as nomination and polling days, respectively.

#### **NOMINATIONS**

#### Presidential

In compliance with section 7 (1) of the Presidential Elections (Supplementary Provisions) Act, the Secretary to the IEC appointed authenticating officers (Government Notice No. 361 of 2004 in Government Gazette Vol. XLII No. 72 dated 16<sup>th</sup> September 2004). These included District Commissioners, District Officers and senior police officers.

The Chief Justice, as the Returning Officer for Presidential Elections, received nomination papers of the Presidential candidates on the 25<sup>th</sup> September 2004 between 1000 hours and 1300 hours, and between 1400 hours and 1700 hours at the High Court in Lobatse. At the close of business four leaders of political parties were declared validly nominated as candidates for election to the office of President as follows:

# Parliamentary and Council Nominations

Parliamentary and Local government nominations were held in terms of the Electoral Act on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2004 in all the fifty seven constituencies and 490 polling districts.

The number of duly nominated parliamentary candidates were as follows:-

Out of the 178 validly nominated candidates 22 obtained less than  $^{1}/_{20}$  of the total number of votes cast in their constituencies, and therefore lost their deposits.

Out of the 1360 nominated candidates 88 obtained less than  $^{1}/_{20}$  of the total number of votes cast in their polling districts and therefore lost their deposits.

#### **POLLING DAY**

Section 61 of the Electoral Act requires the Secretary of the Independent Electoral Commission to facilitate voting by polling officers and police officers who will be engaged at polling stations away from where they are registered to vote and are therefore unlikely to be able to vote on polling day. This, according to the said section shall be not earlier than 15 days before the date fixed for the taking of the general poll. To fulfill the provisions of the above section this category of people voted on the 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2004 at all the 57 constituencies. For the first time, these officers were able to vote for local government candidates, as they did for parliamentary candidates.

No incidents were reported at this poll except at Gaborone Central where, due to an unanticipated turn out, some officers could not vote as the station had run out of ballot papers. It was however suggested to the Commissioner of Police, as most of these were police officers, to deploy the officers where they could vote on the 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2004.

The general elections took place on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2004. Most polling stations opened at 6:30 O'clock in the morning and closed at 7:00 O'clock in the evening. There were however instances of polling stations which closed after the stipulated closing time. This was due to long queues at those polling stations.

Polling staff in the delta were flown to and from their polling stations by BDF helicopters. As flights in the delta stop at 6:00 O'clock in the evening, polling stations in the affected area were ordered to operate between 6:30 O'clock in the morning and 5:00 O'clock in the afternoon.

Batswana electorate had come to the polling stations in good numbers and took up queues, some as early as 5:00 O'clock in the morning. By and large Batswana continue to demonstrate patience and mutual respect during elections. There were no reported incidents of election – related violence or intimidation, except isolated cases where some youth demanded preferential treatment to be allowed to vote first. These were however easily contained.

Polling did not take place at all for council seats in two polling districts. These are Mosetse Polling District in Nata/Gweta constituency and Boikhutso Polling District in Francistown South constituency. At Mosetse a Botswana Alliance Movement candidate died before polling day leading to the notice of poll being countermanded in terms of section 47 of the Electoral Act while at Boikhutso voting was postponed because there was a mistake on the ballot papers for that polling district.

#### **EXTERNAL VOTES**

In accordance with section 5 (3) of the Electoral Act, 44 polling stations were established outside Botswana. However during registration at one polling station namely Brussels nobody came to register. For the external voting 15 officers were appointed Assistant Returning Officers. These were Botswana Ambassadors, High Commissioners and Consuls General in their countries of accreditation. At the polling stations 43 members of the Embassy staff were appointed Presiding Officers while 88 other Batswana, mainly students in those countries were appointed Polling Officers. Like their counterparts at home they were also trained on the electoral process by officers from IEC headquarters.

Botswana citizens residing outside the country voted on the 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2004. Upon completion of the election the ballot bags were sealed and brought back to Botswana by the respective Assistant Returning Officers. Political party candidates, agents, observers and the media were invited to witness the receiving and sorting of ballots. At the Botswana High Commission polling station in Pretoria it was discovered on polling day that three (3) voter registration books containing sixty-six (66) voters had not been returned to the IEC. Consequently these voters did not appear on the voters roll for that polling station. On polling day twenty (20) of these voters turned up to cast their vote and could not as they were not on the voters roll.

The number of Batswana who voted was 1214 out of a total of 2436 who registered, representing 49.54 %.

Given the magnitude of the logistical preparations involved the Commission recommends that the provision relating to external voting be revisited or more funds should be made available.

#### **OBSERVERS**

The 2004 general elections attracted a lot of interest from both local and international observers. A briefing session for observers was conducted to familiarize them with the electoral legislation, the code of conduct for observers and general expectations. The same briefing was also attended by international and local media. All were given letters of accreditation, which they carried everywhere they went, as it was a requirement to access polling stations and counting centres.

Some observers attracted criticism that they came on the eve of election day and as such have missed out on a lot of things. Nonetheless, their presence demonstrates our commitment to transparency throughout the electoral process.

The IEC is awaiting feedback through observers' reports, and will carefully consider their recommendations. Six officers from the Independent Electoral Commissions of Lesotho, Zambia and South Africa were here on attachment to appreciate our electoral process and as a capacity building effort.

#### **COUNTING CENTRES**

After the closing of the polls, ballot boxes were transported from polling stations to the designated counting centres. Some of the polling stations particularly in the Okavango constituency are some 200 km away from the counting centre. These also work as a contributing factor to the delay in the release of results.

Present at the counting centres were returning officers and their assistants and police officers. Political party candidates and their spouses, party counting agents, observers and the media were also present at the various counting centres. Members of the public, as permitted by returning officers also attended.

As any ballot box was received from any polling station the returning officer proceeded to verify the ballot paper accounts of that polling station. Despite the amendment to the law to verify as ballot boxes arrived, the process took inordinately long at most counting centres. Some results were only released after two days. We look forward to sharing the experiences of returning officers on this process at evaluation workshops.

Staff at the counting centres are bound to make mistakes in the process due to long hours taken to verify, count and announce the results. This is due to the fact that such activities take place at one counting centre for both parliamentary and local government elections. The Commission views counting at polling district headquarters for local government elections as the answer and this is under active consideration.

#### **RESULTS**

In the 2004 General Elections, 552,849 voters registered. Out of this, a total of 421,272 voted. This represents a turnout of 76.20 percent of the total registered voters.

The Commission received the first results early Sunday morning on 31st October 2004. The results continued to trickle in until the final results arrived on Monday, 1st November 2004.

The total number of rejected votes was 8,893, which translates into 2.11 percent of the total votes cast compared to 4.93 percent in 1999. The rejections were mostly due to: a voter marking against more than one party, marks being made outside the appropriate boxes on the ballot papers and a voter not indicating their choice.

Seven political parties contested the parliamentary elections. Out of the 57 contested constituencies, Botswana Democratic Party won 44 seats, Botswana National Front 12 seats and Botswana Congress Party 1 seat.

Botswana Democratic Party was returned unopposed in 1 constituency in the Parliamentary Elections and 7 polling districts in the Local Government Elections.

See Appendices A and B for detailed Parliamentary results and Appendices E and H for Local Government results.

On Sunday evening 31<sup>st</sup> October 2004, the Chief Justice was informed that more than fifty percent of the Members of Parliament had declared their support for Festus Gontebanye Mogae in the Presidential Election. The Chief Justice as the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election declared Festus Gontebanye Mogae duly elected as President. The President took the oath of office on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2004.

#### **EXPENDITURE**

As preparing for elections is a process spanning several years we have in the following table recorded actual recurrent expenditure for each financial year from 2000/2001 to 2003/2004 for appreciation. The amounts reflected under 2004/2005 are the approved amounts while those in brackets under the same column are actual expenses paid up to mid December, 2004. There are still more outstanding payments as the financial year has not ended yet.

The major activities concerning the 2004 elections were voter registration and the elections themselves. Both attracted payment of huge allowances to the officers involved. This explains the large difference between the personal emoluments for the 2003/2004 financial year (possibly 2004/2005 as well) and for the other years. The other big spenders were voter education, advertising and publicity and internal traveling to prepare for the elections.

There were also purchases of the outreach broadcast vehicle and the scanners which cost P4.1 million and P900,000 respectively. These acquisitions which were aimed at improving voter education and data capture for the 2004 and future elections are however not included in the above table as they were met under the development budget.

### **EVALUATION/CONCLUSION**

The 2004 General Election was yet another milestone in the life of the Commission.

The major activities include:

- The Voter Apathy Study, which was conducted to establish the causes for apathy amongst the voters and was followed by intensive civic and voter education.
- The increase of constituencies to 57 which was followed by the Delimitation of Constituencies.
- Demarcation of 490 polling districts, establishment of 2178 polling stations and identification of external polling stations in all Botswana Embassies and Consular Missions, including other places with a fair concentration of Batswana as suggested by Botswana Envoys.
- The procurement of the Optical Mark Reading Scanners.
- The procurement of the Outreach Broadcast Vehicle.
- The amendment of the Electoral Act.

The Commission is encouraged by the level of participation of all stakeholders and the electorate in the whole electoral process and believes that conditions existed for a free expression of will by the electors and that the results reflect the wishes of Batswana.

The Commission recognizes some of the problems it encountered during the preelection and election periods and has already begun addressing them.

Throughout various stages of the electoral process there were international and domestic organizations conducting formal evaluations. In conjunction with the anticipated feedback from the Observers, the Audit Consultants and a series of consultative meetings/seminars with election staff, political parties, faith sector and non–governmental organizations, a plan of action will be developed to map the way forward towards 2009.





# PARLIAMENTARY SEATS WON








# % OF SEATS OBTAINED BY CONTESTING PARTIES


# NUMBER REGISTERED BY AGE


# PERCENTAGE REGISTERED BY AGE-GROUP




