General School Profile

Concord High School is a comprehensive, co-educational school situated in a well-established residential area in Sydney's Inner Western Suburbs.

The Student population is 790 with students predominantly coming from feeder areas of East Concord, Mortlake, Cabarita, Canada Bay, West Five Dock, Russell Lea, Abbotsford, Chiswick and the newly established Newington.

To support the students' education, there are over 60 teachers and 10 ancillary staff.

Surrounded by parks, the school has an open plan and was a Department of Education & Training showpiece in design. Buildings accommodate wheelchair access for disabled students.

It is a community school which offers a friendly atmosphere, a caring welfare program, camps, debating, journalism, strong community support and quality facilities, the latter including a theatrette, gymnasium, a modern library and a *fully staffed Learning Centre for students to pursue independent learning programs*. Computer networks are available for student use throughout the school.

The school's curriculum pattern offers accelerated programs for gifted students, assists those from non English speaking backgrounds and enhances the opportunities of those students with learning difficulties. The school provides a Literacy Support Team to monitor individual progress.

Over 90% of students complete Year 12 with a high percentage choosing to further their education through University or TAFE courses.

General Contributions

Voluntary contributions for Year 7 are \$135. This includes the cost of Literacy and Numeracy Testing, School Diary and Student ID Card.

For Years 8-12 the contribution is \$125 plus some specific subject costs.
