Welcome to La Seu d'Urgell, one of the worlds most renowned Canoe Slalom courses.

Over the years, La Seu has built a reputation for its innovation in Canoe Slalom. The city held the 1992 Olympic Games on an artificial course for the first time. Later, a recycling pumping system was designed for the artificial course to imitate a river's natural rough waters and eddies using the same body of water. La Seu began using the electronic result system in 1981 and then introduced the computerised judging system. In addition to its high-tech advances, La Seu was the first to introduce the canoe escalator!

This heritage and the compact venue with a superb backdrop of this wonderful town makes an obvious choice for our World Championships.

The tradition of innovation will continue for the 2009 World Championships. Along the course will be positioned 9 automatic cameras to be used for technical analysis by competing teams, as well as microchips worn by the athletes that will be used for the first time in Slalom Championships for split times during the race.

The organisers continue to strive for innovation which guarantees the improvement of our sport.

These Championships will again move our sport forward. I would like to thank the organisers, the local authorities and the local volunteers for all their dedication and efforts in organising this World Championships. INNOVATIONS: AUTOMATIC CHRONO SYSTEM AND VIDEO TRACKING

Aim of our new automatic Timing and Video Tracking system is to provide split times and video of each boat that can be used by coaches and athletes for technical analysis.

10 antenas are fitted along the length of the canal: one on the start line, 8 intermediate and one on the finish line. Additionally, 10 video cameras with a zoom function and remote control are set up along the course. Each video camera's field of view can be adjusted by a controller according to the training/competition course design and the paddlers movement.

The paddler wears an electronic chip within his/her bib. When the paddler with his/her chip approaches an antenna (start, intermediate, finish), it will be identified and will then activate:

- a) Timing control
- b) Video camera

This procedure is repeated at each of the antennas.

There is a file/table of intermediate (split) timing and total timing of each boat's run.

When the last antenna is crossed all timing details and the full video is automatically available. The video tracking is edited when the finish line is crossed or within 2 minutes of passing the last antenna.

The video file and split information is accessible on our wireless network (for each team with a password provided by Parc del Segre) within the slalom course area. Coaches can watch the information and download it for further analysis.

The system will be used as ICF video feed during the 2009 Canoe Slalom World Championships.

In addition to wireless distribution, the video signal will be distributed by cable to all team tents, in a format that it can be opened by commercial sport analysis programmes (i.e. Dartfish).

Athletes video viewing area will provide one screen with official TV feed, a second one with official live ICF video feed

The Chief Judge will have access to the competition analysis through

- 1/ Official ICF video tracking of every athlete (via bib number)
- 2/ Feed of all cameras not included on the video tracking
- 3/ Images of 3 complementary cameras.

During the race, video control will be situated on the finish line next to the timing hut.

Connectors for cable access should be BNC male or alternatively RCA male (see pics below).

Main advantages of this system are:

- Operational fully automatic no operator needed.
- Reliable live feed for all athletes.
- Accessible for computers via wireless or cable.
- Available on PC or McIntosh.
- Accuracy 1/100 of a second.
- Storage of images of all cameras at all time.

The Parc Olímpic del Segre is constructed in a branch of the river Segre, which was rechannelled after the damage caused by the exceptional flood of 1982. The slalom course's specific features are as follows:

- Length: 300 m
- Drop: 6,5 m
- Flow: 12 m³/s
- Course features: concrete bottom, banks and obstacles of natural boulders
- Spectators capacity: 5.000 people

The Competition Course is accompanied by a beginners course which is 130 m long with a drop of 1,5 m. The designed flow ranges from 3 to 10 m^3/s .

The design of the artificial canals includes a system of complementary canals and mechanical conveyor belts which enable canoeists to return to their starting point without having to leave their boats. The dynamic conception of the whole facilities leads to intensive use all year round and separation of canoeists according to their levels of skill and ability.

The drop in the Slalom course is created naturally via channels that branch from the river Segre, with a very gentle slope. The feeder canal, 165 in length, and mainly the flat water canal, 650 m in length and 20 m in width, are set aside for training in flat water canoeing and the necessary practice that sport lovers require in waters with a steady current.
