I was lucky enough to know her as a friend for the past nine years and she was a delightfully bubbly, caring and thoughtful person.

When Monique met Hoops as a teenager she would not have known that he had a prodigious talent for hockey and that she was going to marry into an extraordinary hockey family. They did marry many years later (it is still the best wedding that I have ever been to) and Monique continued to support Hoops whilst he was playing and then coaching hockey at the top level within the club. At games she was always the



smiling face in a crowd and at social functions she was full of enthusiasm and support for all of the club members and their activities.

John and Joyce Hooper are legends of the Forestville club and will miss Monique not just because she was their beautiful daughter in law that made their son a better man. Monique's skills as an administrator and P.A to the firm Price Waterhouse Coopers are well know across Australia but she always responded immediately to phone calls from John and Joyce when they had problems with modern gadgets. She helped bring them into the 21st Century and was as indispensable to them as she was to accounting and auditing firms around the country. She was everyone's go to person.

On the 12th of January 2007 Monique gave birth to a beautiful daughter, Annie. Not surprisingly there were fewer trips to Yorke Peninsula with friends, less kayaking adventures around the beaches of Adelaide and no more backgammon competitions with Hoops, Patti and me. She was a terrific mother and it is immensely sad that she will not have the joy of watching her daughters, Annie and Poppy grow up.

The funeral service took place last Monday and was well attended by Club members past and present, who all found it difficult to know what to say but were there because they wished to show their support for the Hooper and Conlon Families and their love for Monique.
