Dundas Valley














First settled in the late 18th century, Dundas Valley is located at the eastern end of the Parramatta Local Government Area, some 10 minutes from the Parramatta CBD. The development of the suburb increased during the early 20th century with public housing moving into the area in the 1950-60s.

In a valley environment created by the Ponds Subiaco Creek system, the topography is varied with steep to gentle slopes leading down to the creeks. The area is dotted with several attractive parklands and domestic gardens which support varieties of established native and ornamental trees and shrubs.

Carlingford Court is the major shopping centre in the area but smaller centres provide more localised services including the Waratah Shopping Centre, Telopea Station Shopping Centre, Dundas Valley (Yates Ave) shops and Ermington Shopping Centre.

Where We Are Heading

The Ponds Walk, linking Galaringii Reserve (Carlingford) to the Parramatta River foreshore provides an important role in the suburb. This work improves the access to, and conservation of our natural assets such as the Ponds Subiaco Creek system.

Improving and maintaining cycle and pedestrian access routes throughout the neighbourhoods to local services and facilities helps to create a safer and healthier environment. So too will continuing the upgrade of open space facilities for young people, such as Dundas Park/Curtis Oval.

To build a stronger community, it is important to maintain a balanced mix of public and private housing supported by enthusiastic and effective partnerships between community and government organisations.
