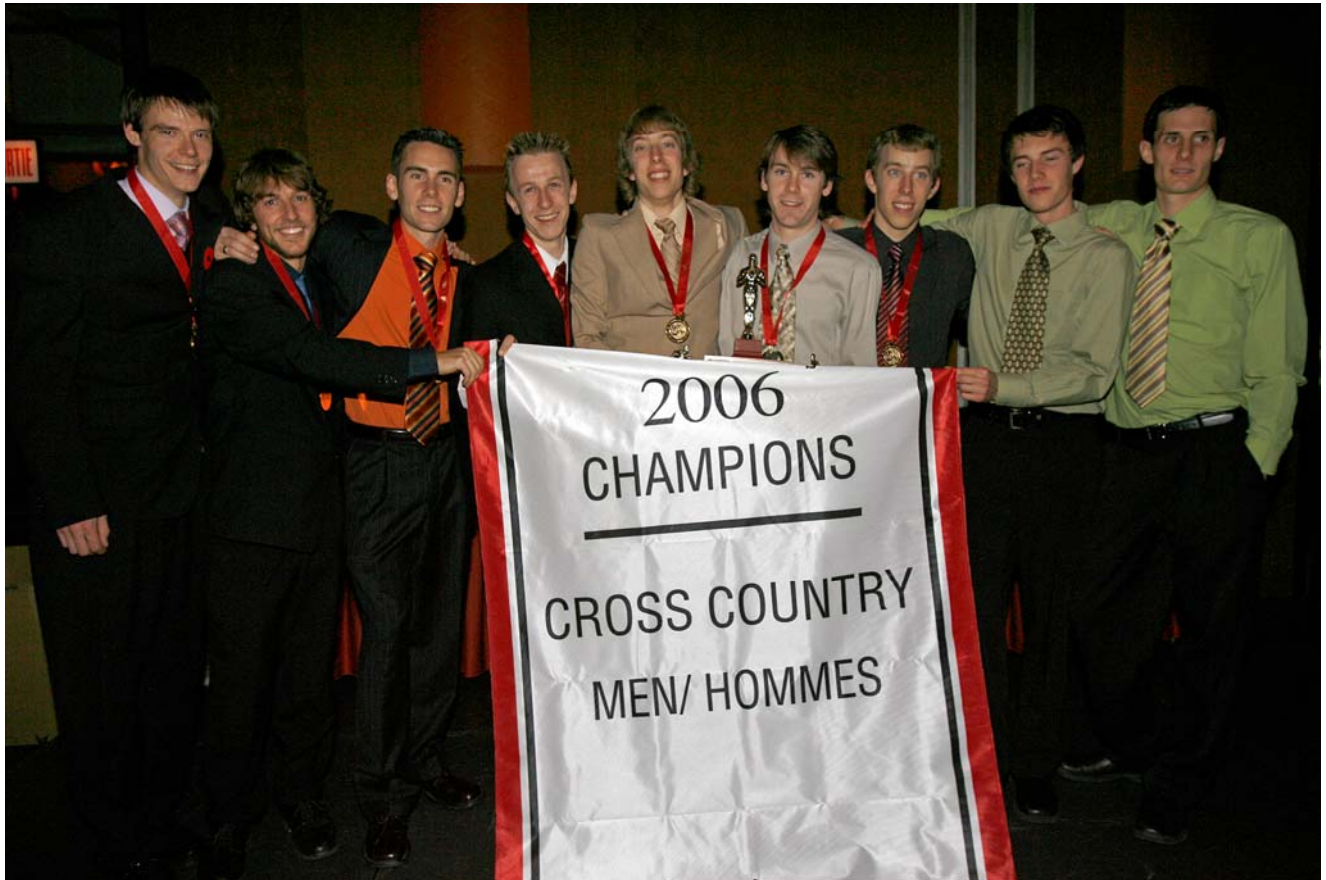

Coach of the year (Fred Foot Award) / Entraîneur de l'année (Prix Fred Foot)

The coach of the year is selected by the CIS Cross Country Coaches Association.

The award honours the memory of the late Fred Foot, one of Canada's top coaches for 60 years. Foot was named the CIAU men's cross country coach of the year seven times, all with the University of Toronto. He was an active coach right up to his death in 2002, when he was working for York University.
