

Deep powder nature reserve

Lying between 1 000m and 2 466m in altitude, this area of the Northern Alps benefits from abundant natural snow-fall: 5.90m of accumulated snow at 1 400m (average for Morains over the last 30 years. Source: Swiss customs in Morains); 8.70m at 2 200m (average for Avoriaz over the last 10 years. Source: SERMA). Heavy snow-fall has always been one of the distinct advantages of the Portes du Soleil. The Portes du Soleil is a veritable deep powder nature reserve, spanning over 400 km2.

To ensure that holiday-makers really make the most of the snow and topquality skiing, over 1 050 people are employed on the ski-slopes and skilifts, working behind the scenes. Slope security is provided on a daily basis by over 175 ski-patrollers, and 90 snow-grooming machines ensure the most perfect snow for all snowsports. In addition to nature's supply, 400 hectares of snow can be provided by 700 snow-canons.

- * Avoriaz snowcross
- * Cuboré and Chavanette sectors in Champéry.
- * The Rosta in Les Gets
- * Pointe de Nyon and Pointe de Chamossière in Morzine.
- * In Champoussin, the couloirs down from the Pointe de l'Au the Aiguille des Champeys, and the Combe de Bonavau
- * Couloirs down from the Pointe des Mossettes to Les Crosets

According to market research undertaken by www.mensup.fr in November 2007, based on a ratio of 6 day ski-pass/number of kilometres of ski-slopes, our French-Swiss ski domain has the cheapest ski-passes/slopes ratio. Out of 10 other French ski areas, the Portes du Soleil came up trumps with the best price ratio for their ski-passes...only 0.29€ per kilometre of ski-run!

Since the Portes du Soleil's beginnings (over 40 years ago!) the domain has never ceased to develop: up-grading ski-lifts, new theme-based ski-slopes, and a variety of services designed to satisfy the wishes of ever-more demanding clients!

New ultra-fast ski lift

In Les Crosets: the 4-seater chairlift «Crozets II» has been replaced by a high-speed detachable 8-seater! This is only the second of its size in Switzerland. It has an hourly passenger flow of 4 000, and skiers will be whisked up to the summit in only 3 minutes and 30 seconds!

On ski slopes...

Burton Kids Parkway in Avoriaz: where young riders (from age 8) can begin to grasp how snowparks work. Red and green lights at the start: picturegrammes illustrating how the run should be tackled.

The Little Stash. Following the success of last season's 'Stash' launch, Avoriaz is opening a 'mini-Stash' at the heart of the village exclusively for kids. This new addition - just like its big brother - emphasises the values of new generation snow parks; respect for the environment without limiting snowsports enjoyment.

«Valais Ski Card»: this ski-pass is designed for itinerant skiers, as it gives access to 50 Swiss ski resorts (several of which are Morgins, Champoussin, Les Crosets and Champéry) and nearly 2 800 km of ski-slopes, all with one ski-pass!

Concerned about sustainable development, alongside making life easier for holiday-makers, bus services between resorts in the same valley have been greatly improved. No longer any need to constantly clear the snow off your car, not to mention the hassle of snow-chains and flat batteries! Holiday-makers can hop on the Colombus in the Abondance valley, the Baladaulp'Bus in the Aulps valley and on the train in the Illiez valley.

Abondance

The Ludoffaz. In the village centre, a snowfield specially designed for children. A place for learning to ski in safety, or for having fun with parents: several slopes available for tobogganing, snake-gliss and airboard!

Les Gets

The Grand Cry territory: a genuine American Indian village on the ski-slopes, ideal for children aged 5 to 12. A boarder-cross style run which is perfect for young explorers to discover this unique and magical territory! Boarder-cross for beginners on Chavannes. Bumps, banked corners.

A new tow-rope is in place this winter (215m) long), making skiing a lot more fun for beginners!

Savoie Mont Blanc

An international dog-sleigh race, with Nicolas Vanier as patron: 25 world-class mushers from 15 different countries. The Grande Odyssée Savoie Mont Blanc is one of the 4 biggest dog-sleigh races on the planet. 1 000 kilometres await these competition dogs, who will be spurred on by tens of thousands of spectators.

Main dates of the Savoie Mont Blanc Grande Odyssée

- * 11TH JANUARY: first leg of the 5th year's race in Avoriaz.
- * 12TH JANUARY: Mass Start (in line start) of all 25 teams in La Chapelle d'Abondance.
- * 13TH AND 14TH JANUARY: Long distance stage (140 km): starts in Les Gets, finishes in Champéry, passing through Morzine and Morgins. The pinnacle of the race will be a nocturnal bivouac half-way round the circuit at Erigné, in Morzine's Vallée de la Manche.
