
MAGPUL® FOLDING MACHINE-GUN (FMG9™)

II. DESCRIPTION

The Magpul® Folding Machine Gun (FMG9™) is a rapidly-deployable, ultra-concealable personal defense weapon currently in development for military, law-enforcement and private security operators. It is designed to offer maximum firepower and control in a compact and discreet package.

The non-firing prototype was unveiled during the 2008 SHOT Show in Las Vegas, NV and features a streamlined polymer casing, ready-to-fire push-button deployment, Glock® 17 slide assembly, capability to accept up to 31-round Glock® 18 magazines (in the folded position), top Picatinny (MIL-STD-1913A) rail and a detachable carrying handle with light shield. An Insight Technologies tactical light was mounted on the prototype. Additional space allows for an auto-sear to be installed for qualified users.

The FMG9™ is currently a conceptual prototype. No determination of production of the system has been finalized. If the weapon were to be produced it would be regulated by the National Firearms Act of 1934. The semi-automatic version would most likely be classified as a Short-Barreled Rifle (SBR) or Any-Other Weapon (AOW) depending on an evaluation from the ATF Firearms Technology Branch. This would require a registered transfer only to qualified individuals. Fully-automatic versions would be classified as a post '86 Machine-Gun (MG) and would not be available to individuals other than Class 3 dealers, military and law enforcement personnel.

VI. Frequently Asked Questions

WHY IS IT CALLED THE FMG9™?

The name is an acronym for "Folding Machine-Gun 9mm".

WHEN WILL IT BE PRODUCED AND HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

No information is currently available concerning potential production or pricing of the FMG9™ concept.

Is the **FMG9^m** fully automatic or can it accept an auto-sear for fully automatic function?

The FMG9™ prototype has *semi-automatic only* components. For qualified users, the FMG9™ may be offered in a fully-automatic mode version. NOTE: THE FMG9™ DOES NOT ACCEPT THE GLOCK® 18 SLIDE ASSEMBLY. See below for information on fully-automatic firearm regulations.

CAN I BUY A FULL-AUTO FMG9™?

Distribution of any fully-automatic model of the FMG9™ would be limited to select sales to qualified entities and individuals only. See question below.

How would the FMG9™ be legally regulated?

The FMG9™ would be strictly regulated by the National Firearms Act of 1934 as a Title II weapon. The semi-automatic version would most likely be classified as a Short-Barreled Rifle (SBR) or Any-Other Weapon (AOW) depending on an evaluation from the ATF Firearms Technology Branch. This would require a registered transfer only to qualified individuals. Fully-automatic versions would be classified as a post '86 Machine-Gun (MG) and would be available only to military, law enforcement, and Class 3 firearm dealers as a dealer sample requiring law-enforcement department letterhead.

As a concealed handgun license holder in my state, can I legally carry the FMG9™?

See *Notices and Terms of Use*. Be advised that most jurisdictions would likely consider the FMG9™ a concealed weapon even while openly carried in the folded (stowed) position. State laws and regulations vary concerning which weapons are allowable for legal concealed carry with a permit. Please note that the concealed carry of Title II (aka Class 3) weapons is either legally restricted or highly discouraged due to liability concerns. Please seek legal counsel, knowledgeable in local firearm laws, to advise you.

DOES THE FMG9[™] ACCEPT UNMODIFIED GLOCK® 17 MAGAZINES?

Yes, the FMG9™ prototype will accept standard Glock® 17 magazines in 17, 18 and 31-round capacity.

HOW IS THE WEAPON DEPLOYED FROM THE FOLDED POSITION?

The side-mounted Operating Handle is partially retracted which allows the weapon to unfold.

HOW DOES THE OPERATOR CHARGE THE WEAPON?

The *Operating Handle* is fully retracted to charge the weapon.

CAN THE **FMG9**™ BE CONVERTED TO OTHER CALIBERS?

The prototype uses components specific to the 9x19mm NATO cartridge. Caliber conversions to .40 S&W, .357 Sig (or other cartridges) have yet to be determined.
