

## PROJECT HERO - LOYALIST COLLEGE

## SCHOLARSHIP FOR DEPENDENTS OF DECEASED CANADIAN FORCES PERSONNEL

Loyalist College has established a scholarship program to provide financial assistance towards the post-secondary education of dependents of Canadian Forces personnel deceased while serving in an active military mission.

Loyalist College will provide financial assistance for tuition fees for up to six semesters and on-campus residence fees for the first two semesters.

This scholarship program is effective from September 1, 2009 to August 31, 2014. After this period, the program could be renewed following an assessment. However, recipients of the scholarship before August 31, 2014 will be entitled to continue benefiting from the scholarship as per the details of the program below.

To be eligible, the recipient must be:

- 1. a dependent of a Canadian Forces personnel deceased while serving in an active mission (Dependent defined as a child of a Canadian fallen soldier)
- 2. under the age of 26
- 3. registered as a full-time post-secondary student at Loyalist College, in a program of study eligible for funding by the province of Ontario

The scholarship is valid for:

- 1. a period of up to six full-time semesters in the case of the tuition fees, and
- 2. the first two full-time semesters in the case of the on-campus residence fees

Eligibility to the scholarship program of Canadian Forces personnel deceased while serving in an active mission will be determined by Canadian Forces criteria.

Dependents' status will be determined as per the Revenue Canada criteria.
