UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON SYSTEM—CREATION AND COMPOSITION

CHAPTER 124

H. B. No. 188

An Act relating to the creation and composition of the University of Houston System; vesting authority in the Board of Regents of the University of Houston System; amending Subchapter B, Chapter 111, Texas Education Code, by adding Section 111.20.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

Section 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 111, Texas Education Code, is amended by adding 63 Section 111.20 to read as follows:

"Sec. 111.20. University of Houston System

- "(a) The University of Houston System hereby created is composed of all those institutions and entities presently under the governance, control, jurisdiction, and management of the Board of Regents of the University of Houston.
- "(b) The University of Houston System shall also be composed of such other institutions and entities as from time to time may be assigned by specific legislative act to the governance, control, jurisdiction, and management of the University of Houston System.
- "(c) The governance, control, jurisdiction, organization, and management of the University of Houston System is hereby vested in the present Board of Regents of the University of Houston, which will hereinafter be known and designated as the Board of Regents of the University of Houston System."
- Sec. 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded conditions of the calendars in both Houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended and the rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on April 5, 1977, by a non-record vote; passed by the Senate on April 27, 1977, by a viva-voće vote.

Approved May 10, 1977.

Effective Aug. 29, 1977, 90 days after date of adjournment.
