

Police shot 10 people in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. Two of the incidents, at the Danziger Bridge and Habans School in Algiers, are under federal investigation. Here's a summary of the incidents.

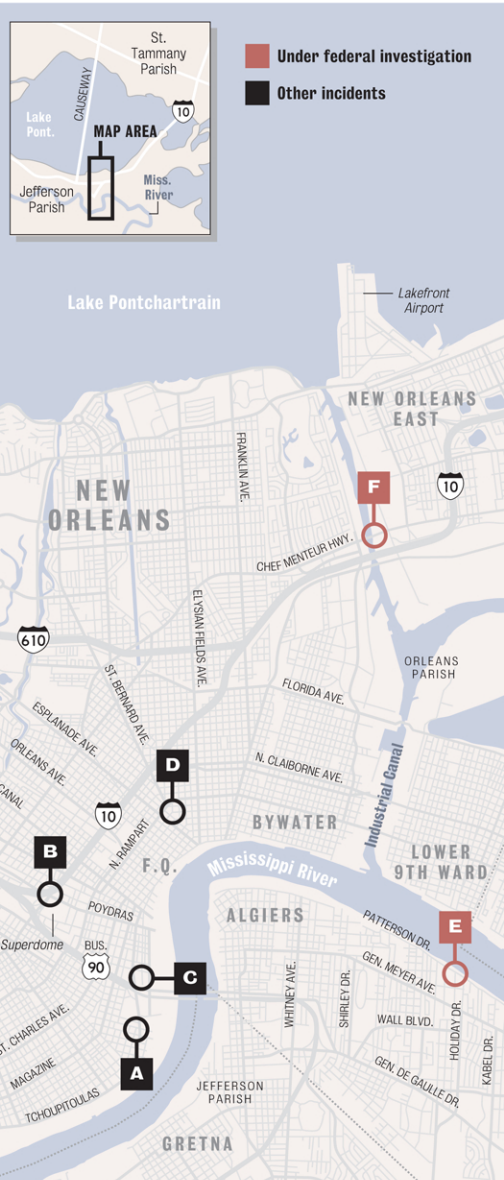

TWO UNKNOWN MEN, SEPT. 1:

Responding to reports of an officer being fired upon near Race and Religious streets, police detained two men a few blocks away. Journalists say they saw one man who they were sure was dead, and a photograph appears to show a second man lying dead. Police said the men were released unharmed, but no police report exists.



B KEENON MCCANN, SEPT. 1: Two NOPD officers repeatedly shot McCann with assault rifles. The officers say McCann was brandishing a handgun, but no gun was recovered. McCann survived and was charged with aggravated assault. But the charges were dropped.



C DANNY BRUMFIELD, SEPT. 3: Brumfield died from a shotgun blast fired from the passenger window of an NOPD cruiser outside the Convention Center. Police say Brumfield attacked an officer through the window with scissors. Brumfield's family said he was trying to wave down the officers and was rammed by the car repeatedly. No charges were filed.



D MATTHEW McDONALD, SEPT. 3: An NOPD officer fatally shot McDonald when he refused to drop a plastic bag containing a handgun. McDonald's family members say the NOPD told them that McDonald was slain by a civilian, that no autopsy was done, and that the NOPD had no idea who killed him.



E HENRY GLOVER, SEPT. 2: Glover was shot in Algiers and brought by a passing motorist to Habans Elementary School, a makeshift headquarters for the NOPD's SWAT unit. The driver of the car says police offered no aid to Glover, instead driving off with him in the car. Glover's remains were discovered in the car, which was burned near a police station.



F RONALD MADISON, JAMES BRISSETTE, SEPT. 4: Police SWAT units opened fire on a group of unarmed civilians at the Danziger Bridge, killing two and injuring four more. Seven officers were indicted on attempted murder charges in late 2006, but the charges were dropped.
