The first official meal covered by the Organizing Committee will be the dinner on 20 April 2010, and the last official meal will be the breakfast on 25 April 2010.

Vienna (Austria) - distance from Piešťany app. 150 km



Visas

Please contact the Slovak Embassy in your country if you need visas to enter Slovak Republic at least 2 months before the tournament. Some countries have a special visa policy to enter Slovakia.

Entry fee

550 EUR per participant, it includes:

- accommodation and full board
- transport from/to Airport/Hotel
- ITTF PTT capitation fee of 30 EUR
- ITTF PTT tournament fee

30% of total Entry fee (non-refundable deposit) must be transferred to our bank account not later than the deadline of the First Entry (see attached Entry Fee Form).

Extra night = EUR 80 per person.

Team members/officials can book a limited number of single rooms for an extra charge (40 EUR/per night).

ITTF Membership

Please note that no nation may compete in this Tournament unless they have paid their membership fee to ITTF in full.

Staff/Players

In case the number of participants after the First Entry exceeds the accommodation capacity, quotas concerning the number of accompanying staff, (i.e. officials, coaches, personal attendants and escorts etc.) and players for the Slovakia Open 2010 will be set in the Second Entry.

Insurance

Each national sport federation is responsible for the appropriate insurance for accidents, health, property and liability of their team.

Events

The following events are going to be staged: Open, singles, teams for men/women classes 1 - 10



Competition rules

The Tournament will be played in accordance with the

rules of the ITTF PTT.

Format of play

All events will be played in accordance with ITTF PTT rules. Every match will be played to the best of five sets.

General rules

The Organiser with the CM reserves the right to cancel/combine events in case there are not enough entries for the event to take place. Any player affected by this will be informed in time for him/her to be placed in a higher class event (except for class 5 and 10 players and except there are already 3 players from the same country in the class). Maximum 3 players and 1 team / per class and country.

Note

A Factor 40 tournament is only open for classified players on the World Ranking list in time of first entry.

Seeding

All competitors will be seeded in order of ranking according to the current International World Ranking List.

Referee/Umpires

National and international ITTF PTT referees and umpires

Equipment

Sports equipment will comply with ITTF and ITTF PTT rules.

Classification All players must hold an international classification card

and presented during tournament.

Entry Deadline First Entry Forms (by numbers) together with 30% of total

entry fee must be returned to the Organising Committee

not later than 15 February 2010.

Second Entry together with final payment of 70% must be returned not later than **15 March 2010.** Entries can be sent

by mail, e-mail or fax.

Individual Entries <u>will not be</u> accepted by organizer – ONLY the NPC or National Sports Association can enter players and team members!!!
