



## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:



**SIX IN TOP SIX:** The inaugural IZOD IndyCar Series race on the streets of São Paulo, Brazil produced exciting racing with 95 on-track passes, seven lead changes and six different teams represented among the top six finishers. Will Power (*shown above*) claimed the victory in his first full season with Team Penske.

**RAHAL RETURNS:** Graham Rahal made history at St. Petersburg in 2008 when he became the youngest race winner in IZOD IndyCar Series history. Then, in 2009, he became the youngest polesitter. A two-race deal will see Rahal return to St. Pete in the No. 67 Dollar General car for Sarah Fisher Racing.

**200 FOR DARIO:** The Honda Grand Prix of St. Petersburg will mark Dario Franchitti's 200th Indy car start (114 in CART/Champ Car, 86 in IZOD IndyCar Series). During that time, Franchitti has claimed two IZOD IndyCar Series titles and is currently tied for 15th on the all-time Indy car victory list with 23.

**ROAD TO INDY:** In late 2009, the Indy Racing League announced plans for the Road to Indy, its official development ladder that provides a defined career path for drivers seeking to reach the IZOD IndyCar Series through the ranks of US F2000, Star Mazda and Firestone Indy Lights. The full ladder system is on display for the first time this weekend.
