RACE FUN FACTS

*The Asian Beau Stakes was originally named the Kankama Quality and was first run in 1982 when won by Nitro Lad for trainer Wally Mitchell and jockey Grant Wootton. Since then the race has also been known as the Belmont Community Quality, Budget Quality and Singapore Quality before becoming the Asian Beau Stakes in 1994.

*The Asian Beau Stakes was named after the champion sprinter/miler who raced in the late 70s early 80s, winning 12 of 18 starts including the 1979 Railway Stakes.

*The Asian Beau Stakes was originally run over 1200m between 1985 to 1992. Asian Incline was victorious in the first 1400m running of the race in 1993.

*Three horses have completed the Asian Beau/Railway Stakes double: Bold Extreme (1996), Willoughby (1998) and El Presidente (2007).

*The shortest-price winner of the Asian Beau Stakes was Fimiston (1986) at 10/9 while the longest-priced winner was 33/1 chance Paragon of Virtue (1984).

*Only two trainers have won more the Asian Beau on more than one occasion: Wally Mitchell with Nitro Lad (1982), Future Edition (1991) and Bold Extreme (1996); and Ross Price with Power Prince (1987), Medicine Kid (1989) and Pago Escort (1992).

*Patrick Carbery is the only jockey to have won the Asian Beau Stakes three times: Classy Dresser (1994), Look Of Success (1997) & Umah (1999).

*In 2003 the Asian Beau Stakes was run at Belmont Park due to Ascot track maintenance, when by outsider Track Jester for trainer Warren Radford and jockey Jason Whiting.
