Size 3.75 mm (U.S. 5) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 3 toggles.

SIZES

Hoodie

To fit chest measurement	
6 mos	17 ins [43 cm]
12 mos	18 ins [45.5 cm]
18 mos	19 ins [48 cm]

Finished chest	
6 mos	19 ins [48 cm]
12 mos	21 ins [53.5 cm]
18 mos	22 ins [56 cm]



Booties: To fit **6 mos (12/18 mos)**

TENSION: 24 sts and 32 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: When working from charts, wind small balls of the colors to be used for each separate area of color in the design. To change colors, twist the 2 colors around each other where they meet on WS to avoid a hole.

HOODIE BACK

With MC, cast on **56 (60-64)** sts.
 Beg with a knit row, work 7 rows in stocking st (facing).
Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit, inc 3 sts evenly across. **59 (63-67)** sts.

Work Chart I to row **72 (80-96)** of chart, reading **RS** rows from **right** to left and **WS** rows from **left** to right.
 Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

With MC, cast on **28 (30-32) sts.
 Beg with a knit row, work 7 rows in stocking st (facing).
Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit, inc 1 st at center. **29 (31-33)** sts.

Work Chart I to row **56 (64-80)** of chart, reading **RS** rows from **right** to left and **WS** rows from **left** to right.**

Shape neck: Next row: (RS). Cast off **4 (6-6)** sts (neck edge). Pat to end of row.
 Keeping cont of chart, dec 1 st at neck edge on next **9 (8-9)** rows. **16 (17-18)** sts rem.
 Work Chart I to row **72 (80-96)** of chart.
 Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Left Front.
Shape neck: Next row: (RS). Pat to last **4 (6-6)** sts (neck edge). Cast off last **4 (6-6)** sts.
 Rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts and keeping cont of chart, dec 1 st at neck edge on next **9 (8-9)** rows. **16 (17-18)** sts rem.



Work Chart I to row 72 (80-96) of chart.
Cast off.

SLEEVES

With MC, cast on 44 (48-52) sts.
Beg with a knit row, work 17 rows in stocking st (cuff and facing).

Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit, inc 5 sts evenly across. 49 (53-57) sts.

Work Chart II, reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right, noting side incs at each end of 9th (13th-13th) row and every following 6th (6th-8th) row until there are 59 (63-67) sts.

Work Chart II to row 40 (46-54) of chart.
Cast off.

HOOD

With MC and pair of needles, cast on 95 (99-103) sts.
Beg with a knit row, work 17 rows in stocking st (turnback and facing).

Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit, inc 5 sts evenly across. 100 (104-108) sts. Break MC.

Change to B and cont in stocking st (beg with a knit row) until work from fold line measures 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ (6 $\frac{3}{4}$ -7) ins [16 (17-18) cm], ending with a purl row.

Shape back: Cast off 9 (9-10) sts beg next 8 rows.
Cast off rem 28 (32-28) sts.

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.
With 2 strands of MC, work cross st embroidery in each corner of contrast color squares on all pieces as shown.

Sew shoulder seams.

Left Front Facing: With RS facing and MC, pick up and knit 43 (49-61) sts evenly between neck edge and lower fold line.

Next row: (WS). Knit.
Beg with a knit row, work 6 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Right Front Facing: With RS facing and MC, pick up and knit 43 (49-61) sts evenly between lower fold line and neck edge.

Knit 1 row (WS).
Beg with a knit row, work 6 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Fold Hood in half and sew back seam.
Fold Hood facing to WS along fold line and sew in position.

With 2 strands of A, work blanket st embroidery along fold line of Hood.

Fold facing to RS of Hood as shown. Sew fold-back in position approx every 1 inch [2.5 cm] through all thicknesses.

Place markers on side edges of Fronts and Back 5 (5 $\frac{1}{2}$ -5 $\frac{3}{4}$) ins [12.5 (14-14.5) cm] down from shoulder seams.

Sew on Sleeves between markers.
Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Fold facings on Sleeves and Body to WS and sew in position, noting front facings will layer over hem facings at front corners.

With 2 strands of A, work blanket st embroidery along fold line of Sleeve.

Fold facing to RS of Sleeve as shown. Sew cuff in position approx every 1 inch [2.5 cm] through all thicknesses.

Sew Hood in position.

Toggle Loops (make 3).

Cut 4 lengths of MC 11 ins [28 cm] long. With someone holding opposite end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl tightly. Fold strands in half and secure ends.

Fold loop in half and secure ends tog. Pull fold of loop from WS of work to RS and sew in position. Sew on toggles to correspond to loops.

BOOTIES: The instructions are written for size 6 mos. If changes are necessary for size 12/18 mos the instructions will be written thus ().

With MC, cast on 40 (44) sts

Beg with a knit row, work 3 ins [7.5 cm] in stocking st, ending with a knit row.

Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit, inc 3 sts evenly across. 43 (47) sts. Break MC.

Join B and knit 1 row.

1st row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing for 3 ins [7.5 cm], ending with a RS row. Break B.

Eyelet row: (WS). With C, *P2tog. yo. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Make instep: 1st row: (RS). With C, K28 (31).
Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: P13 (15). **Turn.**

3rd row: K13 (15).

Rep last 2 rows 4 (5) times more, then 2nd row once. Break yarn.

Leave these 13 (15) sts on a spare needle.

Shape foot: Next row: With RS of work facing, pick up and knit 7 (9) sts along right side of instep. K5 (6). K2tog. K6 (7) from left-hand needle.

Pick up and knit 7 (9) sts along left side of instep. Knit across rem 15 (16) sts. 56 (64) sts.

Knit 3 rows across all sts (garter st).

1st row: (RS). [K1. K2tog. K22 (26). K2tog. K1] twice. 52 (60) sts.

2nd and alt rows: Knit.

3rd row: [K1. K2tog. K20 (24). K2tog. K1] twice. 48 (56) sts.

5th row: [K1. K2tog. K18 (22). K2tog. K1] twice. 44 (52) sts.

7th row: [K1. K2tog. K16 (20). K2tog. K1] twice. 40 (48) sts.

9th row: [K1. K2tog. K14 (18). K2tog. K1] twice. 36 (44) sts.

11th row: [K1. K2tog. K12 (16). K2tog. K1] twice. 32 (40) sts.

13th row: [K1. K2tog. K10 (14). K2tog. K1] twice. 28 (36) sts.

14th row: Knit. Cast off.

Sew sole and back seam.

Fold facing to WS and sew loosely in position leaving eyelet row free.

With 2 strands of A, work blanket st embroidery along fold line.

Drawstring: Cut 4 lengths of MC 30 ins [76 cm] long. With all strands tog, hold one end and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Weave twisted cord through eyelet row.

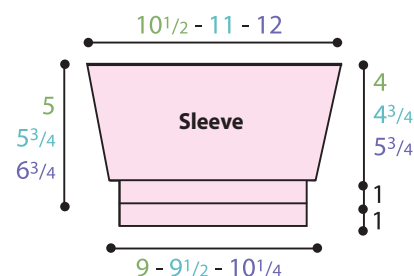
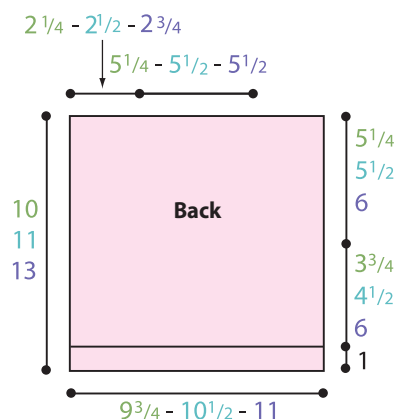
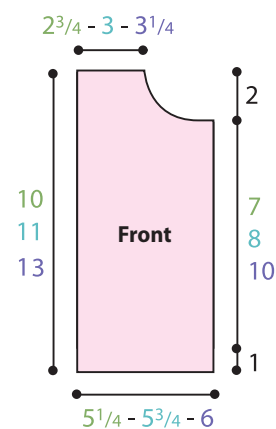
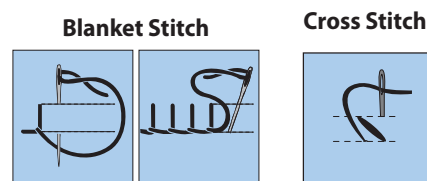
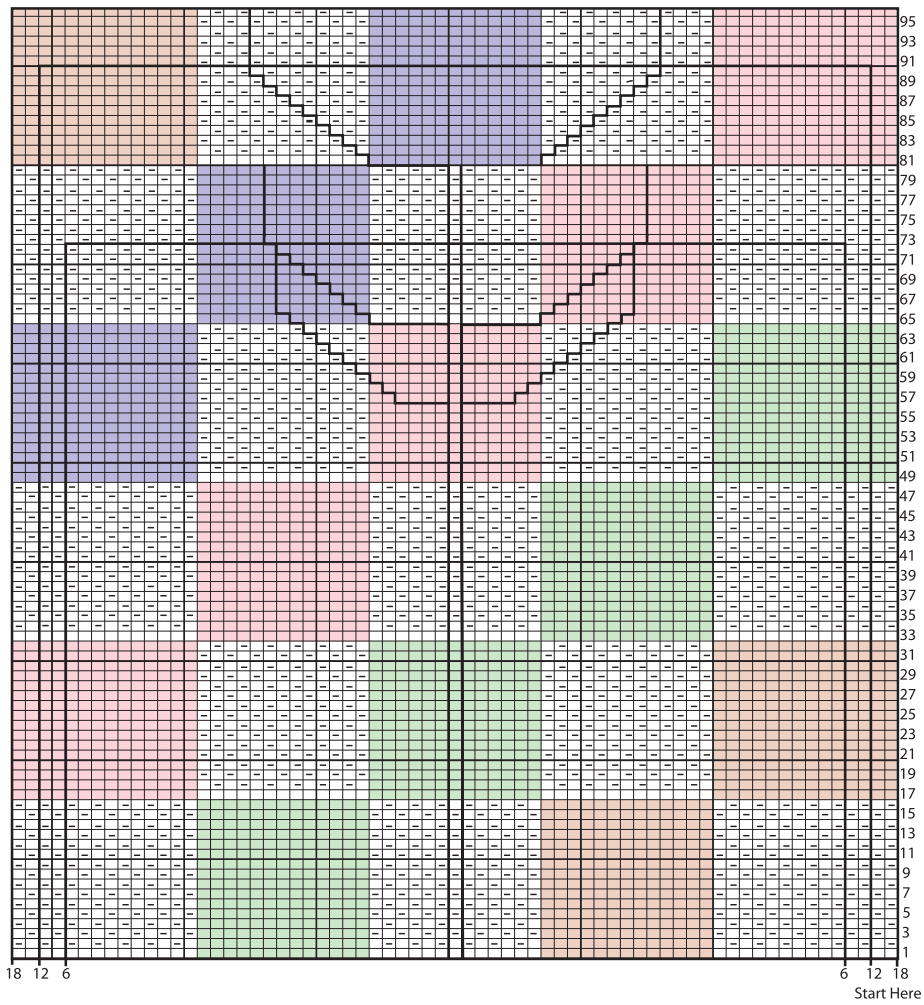







-  = With MC, knit on RS rows, and purl on WS rows.
