

Guest/Escort Policy

The residence in which you live is your home. It is also the home to others, so respecting the rights of those around you is paramount to successful community living. Therefore, it is important that the residents of each hall know and respect these simple guidelines:

Accountability:

Students should be reminded that they are accountable for their guests. Should your guest breach the rules of residence outlined in the Residence Discipline Code, you will be held accountable.

Permission:

Each host must have the permission of their roommate (if applicable) to entertain overnight guests. This permission needs to be granted each time a person stays overnight.

Courtesy:

As a courtesy to both those residing on the floor and to student staff, it is advised that CAs be advised of any potential overnight guests in advance.

Escort Policy:

Hosts must escort their guests on floors other than where their host resides. In some cases, this escort policy will be extended to the entire hall.

Room Capacity:

Each room will have a maximum of two overnight guests per night.

Length of Stay:

Overnight guests are permitted to stay in residence no more than 3 consecutive nights, and must have a minimum of 7 days between.

The Guest/Escort policy is not applicable during Move-In and Move-Out periods. During these times, no guests are permitted.

Parking for Guests:

If you are expecting a visitor, you may purchase a "Next Day" permit for your guest ahead of time at any Parking Kiosk or at the Parking Office. If your visitor arrives after the kiosks are closed and intends to leave the vehicle on campus overnight, make sure a daily permit is picked up at that Parking Kiosk before 9 am the next morning. Parking on campus is free on Sundays.
