## Lodging Industry: 2009 State Overview

Iowa's hotels are an important segment of the state's economy. 8.6 percent of all jobs in the state are directly or indirectly related to the lodging industry, with hotels, motels, resorts, or lodges generating $\mathbf{\$ 4 3 2}$ million in tax revenue for state and local governments.
Many of our properties are small businesses, a sector that created 61.9 percent of new jobs in the state.
Our industry reaches far beyond just providing our guests with comfortable rooms or convenient meeting spaces-we are interlinked with many other industries, such as transportation, restaurants, agriculture, manufacturing, and recreation, supporting \$11.1 billion in total sales throughout the state.
