## 2010 Conditions of Play

### Entries

Open to any female professional, and to female amateurs with USGA Handicap Indexes not exceeding 4.4. Entries close May 5.

### Starting Field

156 players

### Schedule of Play

- Thursday, July 8 – First round (18 holes)
- Friday, July 9 – Second round (18 holes)

After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 60 scorers and any ties, and any player within 10 strokes of the leader.

- Saturday, July 10 – Third round (18 holes)
- Sunday, July 11 – Fourth round (18 holes)

### Playoff

In case of a tie after 72 holes, a three-hole aggregate score playoff will immediately follow. If this playoff results in a tie, the tied players will immediately continue to play off hole-by-hole until the winner is determined.

### Sectional Qualifying

36 holes stroke play, scheduled at 20 sites, from May 17 - June 3.

## Ji Wins the 2009 Championship

On a glorious sun-splashed Sunday at Saucon Valley Country Club in Bethlehem, Pa., 23-year-old Korean Eun-Hee Ji produced a stunning come-from-behind victory by holing a 20-foot birdie putt at the 72nd hole to beat Candie Kung by one stroke. Finishing two strokes back were In-Kyung Kim and Cristie Kerr. Ji's even-par 71 in the final round gave her a level-par total of 284.

Ji, whose only previous U.S. victory came at the 2008 Wegmans LPGA in Rochester, N.Y., became the fourth Korean since Se Ri Pak's triumph in 1998 to win the Women's Open. Not since Lauri Merten in 1993 had anyone birdied the 72nd hole to win by one stroke.

"I think this is going to be one of the most memorable moments in my life," said Ji through a translator. "I didn't even dream about winning this tournament."

While Ji was the championship's most consistent player — she posted rounds of 71-72-70-71 — virtually everyone on the grounds of the Old Course Sunday believed 36- and 54-hole leader Kerr would take the title.

The 31-year-old American carried a two-stroke lead over Ji into the final round, but more important, she was the only player among the top seven entering Sunday with a major title on her résumé.

But Kerr's bogey on the par-5 opening hole was a bad harbinger. The 2007 U.S. Women's Open champion turned in 2-over 38 and when she bogeyed the par-4 13th hole, Kerr had fallen out of the lead for the first time since Friday morning. A three-putt bogey at 16 sealed her fate.

"I'm obviously disappointed," said Kerr, who took 35 putts in the final round. "I don't think [this defeat] will

bother me too much because I don't feel like it was mental. I felt like it was more physical today than mental. I hit it out of the rough all day. You're not going to hit it close to the hole like that."

After making clutch par saves at 15 and 16, Kung seemed poised to take the title. The 27-year-old from Chinese Taipei, who won the 2001 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links title, holed a 6-footer at No. 15 and an 8-footer at 16, only to come up just short on a 12-foot par putt at 17 after hitting her tee shot into a greenside bunker at the par-3 hole. Her long birdie attempt at 18 barely missed.

Kung opened the championship with 22 consecutive pars and did not make a birdie until her 42nd hole. With a 68 on Saturday and 69 Sunday, Kung joined Paula Creamer as the only players in the field to post multiple rounds in the 60s (Creamer shot 68 on Friday, 69 Sunday).

"That was very costly on 17, hitting a wedge into a bunker and making bogey," said Kung. "But again, there's nothing I can do. It's over."

When Ji walked off the 10th green with a double-bogey 6, it appeared her championship hopes were over. But unlike Creamer on Saturday, whose triple bogey at 10 led to a 79, Ji didn't let the setback affect the way she performed over the final eight holes.

In fact, Ji said it calmed her down. Birdies at 13 and 14 moved her to within a stroke of the lead, and when Kung bogeyed 17 the stage was set for the dramatic putt at 18.

Admitting to nerves as she made the stroke, she sent her 29th putt of the day into the center of the hole.

"I knew the worst possible scenario was a [three-hole] playoff," said Ji. "So I cleared my mind and thought, 'Let's give it a try' and then it just sunk in."

### Weather

Warm and sunny Thursday and Friday. Warm and sunny Saturday morning turned to clouds in the afternoon. A slight drizzle began to fall as play concluded Saturday afternoon. More than an inch of rain fell late Saturday night but did not delay the start of play Sunday. Warm and sunny Sunday.

### Notes

The championship was the 78th in Pennsylvania and the seventh Women's Open held in the state ... Pennsylvania has hosted more USGA championships than any other state ... There were 26 USGA champions in the field, including eight Women's Open

champions. Five made the cut, including 1988 winner Laura Davies, who received a special exemption to play in the championship ... Three-time champion Annika Sorenstam, who had announced her retirement in 2008, was expecting her first child and did not play in the Women's Open for the first time since 1994 ... Runner-up Candie Kung, the 2001 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links champion, was vying to become the first WAPL winner to also claim the Women's Open ... Jennifer Song, who the month before won the WAPL title, earned low-amateur honors for the second time ... The youngest player in the field was 14-year-old Alison Lee, who was 16 days younger than Alexis Thompson. Both were among the seven of 28 amateurs who made the cut ... Lee and Thompson were two of 31 players under the age of 20 in the field ... In Sunday's final round, Thompson was paired with two-time champion Juli Inkster. At age 49, Inkster was 35 years older than Thompson ... Nine players withdrew, which tied the record set at the 1972 championship ... The USGA announced prior to the start of the championship that there would be a change from two stages of qualifying to one in 2010 ... A record 1,278 entries were received, the sixth consecutive year the number of entries surpassed 1,000 ... Paula Creamer threw out the first pitch at a Philadelphia Phillies game on the Monday night of championship week ... Creamer was in contention until the 10th hole of the third round, when she was derailed by a triple bogey.

## Championship History

The U.S. Women's Open was added to the USGA's roster of championships in 1953, 58 years after the first U.S. Women's Amateur. The reason for the USGA's relatively late assumption of the Women's Open is simple: women's professional golf is fairly new. When Opal Hill turned professional in 1938, she and Helen Hicks were two of the very few women golf professionals in the world. Unlike the other 12 national championships conducted by the USGA, the Women's Open was created by another organization. In 1946, the short-lived Women's Professional Golfers Association introduced the Women's Open at match play at the Spokane (Wash.) Country Club. The Spokane Athletic Round Table, a men's fraternal organization, contributed the \$19,700 purse from its slot machines proceeds.

The first Women's Open was the only one conducted at match play. Patty Berg won the 36-hole qualifying medal in 1946, with rounds of 72-73-145, then won the championship by defeating Betty Jameson, 5 and 4, in the 36-hole final.

The small membership of the WPGA ran the championship for three years. By 1949, however, women's professional golf was making significant strides and the Ladies Professional Golf Association was founded. A group of 11 women, including Berg, Jameson, Louise Suggs and Babe Didrikson Zaharias, established the new association to provide organized tournaments for women professionals. The LPGA ran the Women's Open for four years, but in 1953 asked the USGA to conduct the championship. The first Women's Open under the USGA flag was played at the Country Club of Rochester, in upstate New York, where Betsy Rawls won the second of her four Women's Open titles (1951, 1953, 1957, 1960).

Conducted by the USGA ever since, the Women's Open is the oldest championship open to women professionals and amateurs. Rawls and Mickey Wright, the only other four-time winner (1958, 1959, 1961, 1964) were the championship's dominant players from 1957 through 1964, winning six Women's Opens between them during those eight years. In 1967, Catherine Lacoste, daughter of French tennis player Rene Lacoste and 1927 British

Ladies Amateur Champion Simone Thion de la Chaume, became the only amateur to win the Women's Open.

In its 63-year history, the U.S. Women's Open has reigned as the world's greatest women's championship, attracting steadily increasing numbers of entries and spectators. Whereas only 37 contestants played in 1953, in 1976 the field jumped to 205 players and sectional qualifying was introduced. In 2001, a record 980 contestants entered. A four-day attendance record of 41,200 was set at Brooklawn Country Club, Fairfield, Conn., in 1979. At the 50th Women's Open, in 1995, that record was more than doubled at The Broadmoor Golf Club in Colorado Springs, Colo.

In recent years, the U.S. Women's Open has truly become the world arena of women's golf. Nine of the last 20 champions have been foreign-born, whereas only three of the first 41 champions were foreign-born. The emergence of the Women's Open as a great international contest came in 1987, when England's Laura Davies prevailed in an 18-hole playoff against Japan's Ayako Okamoto and JoAnne Gunderson Carner of the United States. Another foreign-born player, Annika Sorenstam of Sweden, established the 72-hole scoring record of 272,

8-under par, at Pine Needles Lodge & Golf Club in 1996. Juli Inkster, an American professional, matched that 72-hole score of 272, also setting a record in relation to par with 16 under, in 1999.

In 1965, the final round of the championship was televised nationally for the first time. The Women's Open has been televised ever since, with all four rounds now broadcast.

In 2002, qualifying for the Women's Open was held in two stages for the first time — 18 holes for local qualifying and 36 holes for sectional qualifying. In 2010, there will be one stage — a 36-hole sectional qualifier.

A three-hole aggregate score playoff to immediately follow the end of regulation play was adopted in 2007.

## Championship Results: 1946 to 2009
