YARN

Rowan Cotton Jeans

13 14 14 15 16 17 17 18 x 50gm

or

Rowan Natural Silk Aran

15 16 16 17 18 19 20 21 x 50gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

1 pair 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle

BUTTONS – 6 x 00350

TENSION

Cotton Jeans: 19 sts and 26 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Natural Silk Aran: 19 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

BACK

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 83 [87: 91: 97: 103: 107: 113: 119] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 [0: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0: 1], P3 [0: 2: 3: 2: 3: 1: 3], *K1, sl 1, K1, P3, rep from * to last 1 [3: 5: 2: 5: 1: 4: 1] sts, K1 [1: 1: 2: 1: 1: 1: 1], (sl 1, K1) 0 [1: 1: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, P0 [0: 2: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0].

Row 2: P1 [0: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0: 1], (K1, sl 1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0: 1], K1 [0: 2: 1: 2: 1: 1: 1], *P3, K1, sl 1, K1, rep from * to last 1 [3: 5: 2: 5: 1: 4: 1] sts, P1 [3: 3: 2: 3: 1: 3: 1], K0 [0: 2: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 42 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st until back meas 38 [38: 37: 40: 39: 41: 40: 42] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.



Shape armholes

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

75 [77: 81: 85: 91: 93: 99: 103] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3: 5: 5: 7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 3 [3: 2: 3: 2: 2: 1: 2] alt rows, then on foll 4th row.

61 [63: 65: 67: 71: 73: 77: 79] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [20: 21: 21: 22: 22: 23: 23] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 5 [6: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

51 [51: 53: 55: 57: 59: 61: 63] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 5 [6: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts, K until there are 10 [9: 10: 11: 10: 11: 11: 12] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 6 [5: 6: 7: 6: 7: 7: 8] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 21 [21: 21: 21: 23: 23: 23: 23] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)

Using 4½mm (US 7) needles cast on 24 sts.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 37 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Row 38 (WS): P6, (M1, P6) 3 times. 27 sts.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 42 [44: 46: 49: 52: 54: 57: 60] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 [0: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0: 1], P3 [0: 2: 3: 2: 3: 1: 3], *K1, sl 1, K1, P3, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2: P2, K1, sl 1, K1, *P3, K1, sl 1, K1, rep from * to last 1 [3: 5: 2: 5: 1: 4: 1] sts, P1 [3: 3: 2: 3: 1: 3: 1], K0 [0: 2: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 41 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Place pocket

Next row (WS): Rib 7 [8: 9: 10: 12: 13: 15: 16], cast off next 27 sts in rib, rib to end.

Change to 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Next row (RS): K8 [9: 10: 12: 13: 14: 15: 17], with RS facing K across 27 sts

of first pocket lining, K to end.

42 [44: 46: 49: 52: 54: 57: 60] sts.

Beg with a P row, work in st st until 4 rows less have been worked than on back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front slope

Dec 1 st at end of next and foll alt row.

40 [42: 44: 47: 50: 52: 55: 58] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8] sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row.
35 [36: 38: 40: 43: 44: 47: 49] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 3 [3: 5: 5: 7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 3 [3: 2: 3: 2: 2: 1: 2] alt rows, then on foll 4th row **and at same time** dec 1 st at front slope edge of next and foll 2 [2: 1: 1: 1: 1: 0: 0] alt row, then on every foll 4th row. 23 [24: 26: 26: 28: 29: 32: 32] sts.

Dec 1 st at front slope edge **only** on 4th [4th: 2nd: 4th: 4th: 4th: 2nd: 4th] and every foll 4th row until 16 [17: 18: 19: 20: 21: 23: 24] sts rem.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 5 [6: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 [5: 6: 7: 6: 7: 7: 8] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 42 [44: 46: 49: 52: 54: 57: 60] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, P3, *K1, sl 1, K1, P3, rep from * to last 1 [3: 5: 2: 5: 1: 4: 1] sts, K1 [1: 1: 2: 1: 1: 1: 1], (sl 1, K1) 0 [1: 1: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, P0 [0: 2: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0].

Row 2: P1 [0: 0: 2: 0: 1: 0: 1], (K1, sl 1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0: 1], K1 [0: 2: 1: 2: 1: 1: 1], *P3, K1, sl 1, K1, rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 41 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Place pocket

Next row (WS): Rib 8 [9: 10: 12: 13: 14: 15: 17], cast off next 27 sts in rib, rib to end.

Change to 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Next row (RS): K7 [8: 9: 10: 12: 13: 15: 16], with RS facing K across 27 sts of second pocket lining, K to end. 42 [44: 46: 49: 52: 54: 57: 60] sts.

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 43 [43: 45: 45: 47: 47: 49: 49] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K0 [0: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2], P2 [2: 3: 3: 3: 3: 3], *K1, sl 1, K1, P3, rep from * to last 5 [5: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2] sts, K1 [1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2], (sl 1, K1) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0] times, P2 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0].

Row 2: P0 [0: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2], (K1, sl 1) 0 [0: 1: 1: 1: 1: 1: 1] times, K2 [2: 1: 1: 1: 1: 1: 1], *P3, K1, sl 1, K1, rep from * to last 5 [5: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2] sts,

P3 [3: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2], K2 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 22 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 7th [5th: 7th: 5th: 5th: 5th: 5th] and every foll 8th [8th: 8th: 6th: 6th: 6th: 6th] row to 55 [63: 63: 51: 51: 59: 63: 71] sts, then on every foll 10th [-: 10th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th] row until there are 61 [-: 65: 67: 69: 71: 73: 75] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 46 [46: 47: 47: 48: 48: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

53 [53: 55: 55: 57: 57: 59: 59] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on every foll 4th row until 31 [31: 33: 33: 35: 35: 37: 37] sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 25 sts, then on foll 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 19 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Front band

With RS facing and using 4mm (US 6) circular needle, beg and ending at cast-on edges, pick up and knit 79 [79: 77: 82: 81: 85: 84: 87] sts up right front opening edge to beg of front slope shaping, 52 [52: 54: 54: 56: 57: 58: 58] sts up right front slope, 29 [29: 29: 29: 31: 31: 31: 31] sts from back, 52 [52: 54: 54: 56: 57: 58: 58] sts down left front slope to beg of front slope shaping, then 79 [79: 77: 82: 81: 85: 84: 87] sts down left front opening edge. 291 [291: 291: 303: 303: 315: 315: 321] sts.

Row 1 (WS): P3, *K1, sl 1, K1, P3, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, sl 1, K1, *P3, K1, sl 1, K1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for 1 row more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 4 (RS): Rib 1 [1: 3: 3: 3: 2: 1: 3], *work 2 tog, yrn (to make a buttonhole), rib 13 [13: 12: 13: 13: 14: 14: 14], rep from * 4 times more, work 2 tog, yrn (to make 6th buttonhole), rib to end.

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib (on WS).
