George McCready Price Papers

Biographical Information

Born in New Brunswick, Canada (Aug. 26, 1870), author and educator George McCready Price early became a Seventh-day Adventist and served the church as a colporteur. He received a B.A. degree form Loma Linda College in 1912, and the M.A. degree from Pacific Union College in 1918. Price s teaching career began in New Brunswick in 1897, and in 1903 he became principal of the Famington Industrial Academy, Nova Scotia. After a period of research work in New York City and Washington, D.C., he taught English at San Fernando Academy until 1913 and 2chemistry and physics at Lodi Academy from 1914 to 1920. From 1924 to 1928 he did research work in Europe, taught geology at Stanborough College, and was its president for a short time. His next appointment was to Emmanuel Missionary College where he was professor of philosophy and geology form 1929 to 1933. He held the same position at Walla Walla College from 1933 to 1938. Price retired from the classroom in 1938 to devote his time to writing. He produced 23 books in all his best known prepared in the field of geology and contributed numerous articles to various journals. Among his more significant works are <u>God s Two Books</u>, <u>The New Geology</u>. As an ardent creationist, he was a vigorous opponent of the theory of biological evolution. Price died at Loma Linda, California, in the winter of 1963. (Jan. 24).

<u>Scope</u>

In May 1973, Dr. Leroy Froom of Washington, D. C., appointed custodian of the unpublished manuscripts and correspondence of George McCready Price, committed the Price papers to the Heritage Room Archive at the James White Library, Andrews University. Additional materials and correspondence covering the period 1962 to 1968 and pertaining to Price s publication, <u>The Time of the End</u>, were received from the Southem Publishing Association in June 1973. The Price collection contains correspondence, manuscripts, articles and poems written by Mr. Price, his wife, and others during the course of his life. Some of the books authored by Price have been catalogues and placed in the Heritage Room.

<u>Arrangement</u>

Where possible the material has been kept in the arrangement made by George McCready Price himself. The envelops and folders are referred to as env and fld. There are numbered on the basis of chronological, alphabetical, or topical sequence. To call for items in the collection, use C 2" with box and folder number as indicated in the following inventory. Citations to the collection or items in the collection should include the following: George McCready Price Collection, Heritage Room, James White Library, Andrews University.
