THE FACULTY ACCESS GRANT 2008-2009

The Center for Southeast Asian Studies at the University of Wisconsin-Madison announces the availability of grant funds for its Faculty Access program for 2008-2009. Funds are available for faculty at two-year, four-year, or technical colleges to come to the University of Wisconsin-Madison campus for a period of up to 10 days—between October 1, 2008 and May 10, 2009. Faculty consult with Southeast Asian area specialists associated with the Center and utilize the University's Southeast Asian library collections. Faculty are required to submit to the Center a project report (with specific plans to implement the course material) at the conclusion of the project. The grant will cover car mileage, lodging up to 9 nights, and per diem.

Applications accepted immediately through April 30, 2009. Applications submitted after this date are accepted pending available funding.



Application procedure: Fill out the attached Application Form, Budget Request Form, and send with Curriculum Vita. Applications will be accepted immediately up to 6 weeks prior to your first day of residency through the final deadline of April 30 2009. The application and CV must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2009. Applications accepted after this date will be on a space available basis.
