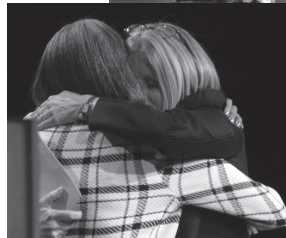


## Events with Eva L. Baker, AERA President 2006–2007
