

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PRIMARY ELECTION DAY

The date of the primary election is governed by **KRS 118.025 (3)**:

"Primary elections for the nomination of candidates or slates of candidates to be voted for at the next regular election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the third Monday in May of each year."

GENERAL ELECTION DAY

The date of the general election is governed by **Kentucky Constitution**, **Chapter 148 and KRS 118.025 (4)**:

"......All regular elections of State, county, city, town, urban-county, or district officers shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November."

"......The election of all officers of all governmental units shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November."

Election Schedule Chart Thru the Year of 2013

It is most important for all individuals inquiring about candidate filing requirements to be familiar with the year in which the office they are seeking is on the ballot.

The following chart provides an election schedule listing all offices and the year thru 2013 that offices appear on the ballot. The year in which the office appears on the ballot determines the earliest filing date for candidates as well as the filing deadline date for candidates. The earliest date that candidates may file for an office is no earlier than the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November of the year preceding the year in which the office will appear on the ballot. The latest filing date for candidates running in a primary is not later than the last Tuesday in January preceding the day fixed by law for holding the primary election. The filing deadline for independents or political group/organization candidates (excluding President/Vice President) is not later than the second Tuesday in August preceding the day fixed by law for the holding of general elections. Also, candidates who attain ballot access by the petition process may NOT seek signatures on the petition prior to the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November of the year preceding the year in which the office will appear on the ballot.

The above earliest and latest dates **DO NOT** relate to campaign finance; only ballot access. To obtain information regarding the procedures for candidates to raise and expend campaign money, candidates should contact the **Registry of Election Finance** at 502-573-2226.

Candidate Qualification/Authority Cites for each Elective Office

Possessing the required qualifications for an office is most likely the most critical factor for a candidate to attain ballot access and for maintaining candidate eligibility for a specific office.

The following chart provides the qualifications, constitutional or statutory authority setting forth the qualifications, filing official and filing fee for each elected office.

As mandated by KRS 118.125, the notification and declaration shall be signed by the candidate and by not less than two (2) registered voters of the same party from the district or jurisdiction from which the candidate seeks nomination; shall include a declaration sworn to by the candidate that he or she possesses all the constitutional and statutory requirements of the office for which the candidate has filed; shall be subscribed and sworn to before an officer authorized to administer an oath by the candidate and by two voters making the declaration and signing the candidate's petition for office.

Only persons who are qualified under the provisions of KRS 116.055 to vote in any primary election for the candidates for nomination by the party at whose hands he seeks the nomination shall have his name printed on the official ballot of his party for an office to which he is eligible in that primary.

Board of Education.

Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor.

Mayor or legislative body candidates in cities of second to sixth class conducting **nonpartisan** elections.

Candidate filing requirements for the nonpartisan offices of Board of Education, Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor and Mayor or legislative body candidates in cities of second to sixth class conducting **nonpartisan** elections are listed below:

Board of Education:

Candidates for school board attain ballot access by filing with the County Clerk a **Nominating Petition**. This filing form is prescribed by the State Board of Elections and is numbered SBE 60A. Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing a form titled **Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption** with the county clerk when filing the nominating petition.

The nominating petition shall be signed by the candidate and by not less than **two (2)** registered voters who reside in the school board district from which the candidate seeks nomination. The petition shall be filed with the county clerk no later than the second Tuesday in August preceding the day fixed by law for the holding of general election for the office sought.

Candidates for school board are required to file an affidavit signed under penalty of perjury certifying completion of the twelfth grade equivalent as determined by passage of the twelfth grade equivalency examination held under regulations adopted by the KY Board of Education. This affidavit is to be filed with the County Clerk when filing the nomination petition. A sample affidavit drafted by the KY Board of Education may be viewed on the following pages.

Example for the 2008 General Election: Last day to file Petition (4:00pm) – August 12, 2008

Soil and Water District Supervisors:

Candidates for Soil and Water District Supervisor attain ballot access by filing with the County Clerk in the candidate's county of residence a **Nominating Petition**. Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing an **Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption** form when filing the nominating petition with the county clerk.

The nominating petition shall be signed by not less than **twenty-five (25)** registered voters who reside in the soil and water conservation district from which the candidate seeks nomination. The petition shall be filed with the County Clerk no later than the second Tuesday in August preceding the day fixed by law for the holding of general election for the office sought.

Example for the 2008 General Election: Last day to file Petition (4:00pm) – August 12, 2008

Nonpartisan City office NOT waiving primary:

Mayoral or city legislative body candidates in a city that by ordinance conducts nonpartisan city elections and does NOT by ordinance waive the primary attain ballot access by filing with the County Clerk in the candidate's county of residence a **Nominating Petition**. Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing an **Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption** form when filing the nominating petition with the county clerk.

The petition shall be signed by not less than two (2) registered voters who reside in the city from which the candidate seeks nomination. The petition shall be filed with the County Clerk no later than the last Tuesday in January of the year their name is to appear on the ballot.

Example for the 2008 Primary Election: Last day to file Petition (4:00pm) – January 29, 2008

Nonpartisan City office WAIVING primary:

Mayoral or city legislative body candidates in a city that by ordinance conducts nonpartisan city elections and by ordinance DOES waive the primary attain ballot access by filing with the County Clerk in the candidate's county of residence a **Nominating Petition**. Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing a form titled **Appointment of Campaign Treasurer & Optional Request for Reporting Exemption** with the County Clerk when filing the nominating petition.

The petition shall be signed by not less than two (2) registered voters who reside in the city from which the candidate seeks nomination. The petition shall be filed with the County Clerk no later than the second Tuesday in August of the year their name is to appear on the ballot.

Example for the 2008 General Election: Last day to file Petition (4:00 pm) – August 12, 2008

Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing an Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption form when filing the Court of Justice Nominating Petition with the Secretary of State.

The petition shall be sworn to before an officer authorized to administer an oath by the candidate and by no less than two (2) registered voters from the district or circuit from which the candidate seeks nomination. The petition shall include a declaration sworn to by the candidate that he or she possesses all the constitutional and statutory requirements of the office for which the candidate has filed.

Each candidate for nomination shall file a petition not earlier than the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November of the year preceding the year in which the office will appear on the ballot and not later than the last Tuesday in January preceding the day fixed by law for holding the primary election for the office.

Write-in candidates must designate a campaign treasurer by filing an **Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption** form when filing the declaration of intent with the filing official.

A person shall be ineligible as a write-in candidate for more than one (1) office in a general or special election. Write-in votes shall be counted **ONLY** for candidates for election to office who have filed with the appropriate filing official (Secretary of State or County Clerk) a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate.

The declaration of intent must be filed **not** less than ten (10) days preceding the date of the general or special election. The filing fee for filing as a write-in candidate is \$50.00, for all offices except the filing fee for candidates seeking a city office in a 5^{th} or 6^{th} class city is \$20.00.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 1. Definitions

- (5) "First name" means an individual's name or names given at birth, as distinguished from a family name or surname.
- (6) "Name" means one or more first names coupled with one or more surnames.
- (7) "Nickname" means a shortened version of an individual's name or a descriptive or alternative name, in addition to or instead of the first name or surname of an individual.
- (10) "Surname" means the family name bestowed at birth, acquired by marriage, or legally adopted by choice.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 6. Definition of a Vote for Write-in Voting Generally.

- (1) Only votes cast for eligible write-in candidates under KRS 117.265 shall be considered valid and counted.
- (2) A write-in vote for a candidate whose name already appears on the ballot label as a candidate shall not be counted as a vote under KRS 117.265.
- (3) The use of stickers, labels, rubber stamps, or other similar devices shall not be counted as write-in votes.
- (4) Any minor misspelling of the name of a candidate shall be disregarded in determining the validity of a write-in vote as long as the intended candidate can be clearly determined.
- (5) Writing in only the surname of an eligible candidate shall constitute a valid vote, unless there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office. If there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office, writing in only the surname shall not constitute a vote.
- (6) Writing in only the first name of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (7) Writing in only the initials of a candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (8) Writing in only the nickname of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (9) If the voter writes in any other name along with the surname of an eligible write-in candidate, the other name written by the voter shall comply with the variations of names listed by the candidate on SBE/SOS/01, 02, or 03, to constitute a valid vote.
- (10) Writing in the surname of the candidate for Governor or the surname of the candidate for Lieutenant Governor shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.
- (11) Writing in the surname of the candidate for President or the surname of the candidate for Vice President shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.

The statement of candidacy form, numbered SBE 59B, and the nominating petition, numbered SBE 66B, are prescribed by the State Board of Elections. Candidates must designate a campaign treasurer on documents prescribed by the Registry of Election Finance when filing the slate petition.

The **Statement of Candidacy** form must be filed with the Secretary of State not later than **April 1st** preceding the general election. There is **no** filing fee for filing the signed statement of candidacy and failure to file the statement of candidacy by the candidates will result in rejection of the petition of nomination.

Example for General Election of 2007:

Last day to file (4:00pm) - April 2, 2007

(April 1st in the year of 2007 is on a Sunday; therefore form may be filed on next business day.)

The **Nominating Petition** shall be filed with the Secretary of State not later than **second Tuesday in August**. The nominating petition must be signed by the candidates for Governor and Lt. Governor and by no less than 5,000 registered voters. Signatures shall not be solicited prior to the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November preceding the year in which the office will appear on the ballot.

Example for General Election of 2007:

Earliest date to file affix signatures on petition - November 8, 2006 Last date to file (4:00pm) - August 14, 2007

The declaration of intent shall be filed no later than 4 p.m. local time at the place of filing when filed on the last date on which papers may be filed. The declaration of intent shall be on a form prescribed by the Secretary of State.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 1. Definitions

- (5) "First name" means an individual's name or names given at birth, as distinguished from a family name or surname.
- (6) "Name" means one or more first names coupled with one or more surnames.
- (7) "Nickname" means a shortened version of an individual's name or a descriptive or alternative name, in addition to or instead of the first name or surname of an individual.
- (10) "Surname" means the family name bestowed at birth, acquired by marriage, or legally adopted by choice.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 6. Definition of a Vote for Write-in Voting Generally.

- (1) Only votes cast for eligible write-in candidates under KRS 117.265 shall be considered valid and counted.
- (2) A write-in vote for a candidate whose name already appears on the ballot label as a candidate shall not be counted as a vote under KRS 117.265.
- (3) The use of stickers, labels, rubber stamps, or other similar devices shall not be counted as write-in votes.
- (4) Any minor misspelling of the name of a candidate shall be disregarded in determining the validity of a write-in vote as long as the intended candidate can be clearly determined.
- (5) Writing in only the surname of an eligible candidate shall constitute a valid vote, unless there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office. If there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office, writing in only the surname shall not constitute a vote.
- (6) Writing in only the first name of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (7) Writing in only the initials of a candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (8) Writing in only the nickname of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (9) If the voter writes in any other name along with the surname of an eligible write-in candidate, the other name written by the voter shall comply with the variations of names listed by the candidate on SBE/SOS/01, 02, or 03, to constitute a valid vote.
- (10) Writing in the surname of the candidate for Governor or the surname of the candidate for Lieutenant Governor shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.
- (11) Writing in the surname of the candidate for President or the surname of the candidate for Vice President shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.

A notification of nomination from the Secretary of State will be sent to each candidate by certified mail, with return receipt requested, that he/she will appear as a candidate on the primary ballot of his/her party, provided that the candidate returns the notice of candidacy form sent by the Secretary of State and the \$1000 filing fee not later than 4:00pm on the last Tuesday in January preceding the day fixed by law for holding the primary election.

Democratic and Republican Presidential Preference Primary Candidate Ballot Access Pursuant to KRS 118.581

The Kentucky State Board of Elections will meet in Frankfort, Kentucky on January 8, 2008 for the purpose of nominating as Presidential Preference Primary candidates all those candidates of the political parties for the office of President of the United States who have qualified for matching federal campaign funds.

The Kentucky State Board of Elections will contact the Federal Election Commission just prior to the January 8, 2008 meeting to obtain a list of these candidates. Immediately upon completion of this requirement, the board will transmit a list of all the nominees selected to the Secretary of State and will also release the list to the news media.

The names of candidates for President and Vice President shall be certified in lieu of certifying the names of the candidates for presidential electors.

As provided on the nominating petition, petitioners will further place in nomination a list of presidential electors providing the name, residential address and signature of each presidential elector.

The nominating petition and \$500 filing fee shall be filed with the Secretary of State no later than 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the first Tuesday in September preceding the date fixed by law for election of electors. The names of candidates for President and Vice President shall be certified in lieu of certifying the names of the candidates for presidential electors.

As provided on declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate filing form, the names of the pledged presidential electors must be listed. The names of candidates for President and Vice President shall be certified in lieu of certifying the names of the candidates for presidential electors.

KRS 117.265 (4): Persons who wish to run for President and Vice-President shall file a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate, along with a list of presidential electors pledged to those candidates, with the Secretary of State not less than ten (10) days preceding the date of the regular election for those offices. Write-in votes cast for the candidates whose names appear on the ballot shall apply to the slate of pledged presidential electors, whose names shall not appear on the ballot.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 1. Definitions

- (5) "First name" means an individual's name or names given at birth, as distinguished from a family name or surname.
- (6) "Name" means one or more first names coupled with one or more surnames.
- (7) "Nickname" means a shortened version of an individual's name or a descriptive or alternative name, in addition to or instead of the first name or surname of an individual.
- (10) "Surname" means the family name bestowed at birth, acquired by marriage, or legally adopted by choice.

31 KAR 6:030, Section 6. Definition of a Vote for Write-in Voting Generally.

- (1) Only votes cast for eligible write-in candidates under KRS 117.265 shall be considered valid and counted.
- (2) A write-in vote for a candidate whose name already appears on the ballot label as a candidate shall not be counted as a vote under KRS 117.265.
- (3) The use of stickers, labels, rubber stamps, or other similar devices shall not be counted as write-in votes.
- (4) Any minor misspelling of the name of a candidate shall be disregarded in determining the validity of a write-in vote as long as the intended candidate can be clearly determined.
- (5) Writing in only the surname of an eligible candidate shall constitute a valid vote, unless there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office. If there is more than one (1) filed candidate with the same surname for that office, writing in only the surname shall not constitute a vote.
- (6) Writing in only the first name of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (7) Writing in only the initials of a candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (8) Writing in only the nickname of an eligible candidate shall not constitute a valid vote.
- (9) If the voter writes in any other name along with the surname of an eligible write-in candidate, the other name written by the voter shall comply with the variations of names listed by the candidate on SBE/SOS/01, **02**, or 03, to constitute a valid vote.
- (10) Writing in the surname of the candidate for Governor or the surname of the candidate for Lieutenant Governor shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.
- (11) Writing in the surname of the candidate for President or the surname of the candidate for Vice President shall be sufficient to cast a write-in vote for the slate.

CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL

Pursuant to KRS 118.212 (1-5) candidates may withdraw at anytime by filing a written, signed and properly notarized statement that the nomination or election would not be accepted. The statement of withdrawal must be filed with the same filing official, Secretary of State or County Clerk, that received the candidate filing documents.

The notice of withdrawal **must** be filed prior to the time of the certification of candidates for the name **not** to appear on the ballot. If the withdrawal notice is filed after the deadline of the certification of candidates, the candidate's name will appear on the ballot but a notice will be conspicuously displayed in each polling place advising the voters of the withdrawal and any votes cast for the withdrawn candidate will **not** be tabulated or recorded.

Certification of candidates for primary election is not later than the second Monday after the filing deadline for the primary.

Example for the 2008 Primary: February 11, 2008

Certification of candidates for a general election in non Presidential election years is not later than the second Monday after the filing deadline for the general election. In Presidential election years, the candidate certification deadline is not later than the Monday after the Friday following the first Tuesday in September.

Example for the 2008 General: September 8, 2008

NOMINATIONS BY POLITICAL PARTIES

Party Definition: A "political party" is an affiliation or organization of electors representing a political policy and having a constituted authority for its government and regulation, and whose candidate received at least twenty percent (20%) of the total vote cast at the last preceding election at which presidential electors were voted for." KRS 118.015 (1).

Vacancy in Candidacy governed by KRS 118.105:

- (3) If a vacancy occurs in the nomination of an unopposed candidate or in a nomination made by the primary before the certification of candidates for the regular election made under KRS 118.215, because of death, disqualification to hold office sought, or severe disabling condition which arose after the nomination, the governing authority of the party may provide for filling the vacancy, but only following certification to the governing authority, by the Secretary of State, that a vacancy exists for a reason specified in this subsection. When such a nomination has been made, the certificate of nomination, shall be signed by the chairman and secretary of the governing authority of the party making it, and shall be filed in the same manner as certificates of nomination at a primary election.
- (4) If a vacancy occurs in the nomination of an unopposed candidate or in a nomination made by the primary before the certification of candidates for the regular election, and if that party's nominee was the only candidate for the office sought, the governing authority of each party may nominate a candidate for the regular election, provided that no person has sought that party's nomination by filing a notification and declaration.

VACANCY IN OFFICE/NOMINATIONS FOR UNEXPIRED TERMS

Governed by KRS 118.115

Except as provided in subsection (2)(b) or KRS 83A.045 governing vacancy in candidacy, candidates for unexpired terms to be filled at a regular election shall be nominated at the primary next preceding the regular election, if the vacancy occurred not less than one hundred thirty-four (134) days before the primary. If the vacancy occurred less than one hundred thirty-four (134) days before the primary, the nomination shall be made in a manner determined by **the governing authority of the political party** concerned. In the preparation of ballots, candidates for full terms shall be grouped together, and candidates for unexpired terms shall be grouped together, under appropriate headings, so that the voter may easily distinguish the candidates for full terms from the candidates for unexpired terms.

A vacancy in office for Governor, Congressional representative and member of the General Assembly are filled by calling of a **special election**. KRS 118.710 thru KRS 118.775 governs the procedures and deadline for the party nominations and petitions when there has been a call for a special election to fill a vacancy for one of the above offices.

A sample **certificate of nomination** used by the governing authority of a party to nominate a candidate when a vacancy in candidacy exist or to nominate a candidate for an unexpired term when the vacancy occurs with less than one hundred thirty-four (134) days before the primary may be viewed on the following page. 30 KAR 2:010. Certification of vacancy in nominations.

RELATES TO: KRS 118.105

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 118.105

NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: Senate Bill 223, enacted during the 1990 Regular Session of the General Assembly, amended KRS 118.105(1), (3) and (4), governing certification by the Secretary of State that a vacancy exists in a nomination governed by KRS 118.105. This administrative regulation is required to establish the procedure for the determination and certification of a vacancy under the provisions of KRS 118.105.

Section 1. Notification of Vacancy. (1) The Secretary of State shall be notified of the vacancy in a nomination governed by KRS 118.105.

- (2) The notification shall:
- (a) Be written;
- (b) Be dated;
- (c) State the reason for the vacancy;
- (d) Contain documentation to substantiate the reason for the vacancy;
- (e) Be signed by the person making the notification; and
- (f) Be notarized.
- (3) The notification may be made by:
- (a) The candidate:
- (b) The governing authority of a party;
- (c) A registered voter; or
- (d) An opposing candidate.
- (4) The notification shall be delivered to the Secretary of State by:
- (a) Certified mail; or
- (b) The person making the notification.

Section 2. Documentation to Substantiate Reason for Vacancy. (1) Documentation to substantiate the reason for a vacancy shall be filed with the notification by the candidate or governing authority of the party as provided by this section. For:

- (a) Death of a candidate: a certificate of death or other evidence satisfactory to the Secretary of State;
- (b) Disqualification to hold the office sought: evidence of legal disqualification; and
- (c) Severe disabling condition: medical evidence of the condition.
- (2) Medical evidence of a severe disabling condition shall consist of medical evidence provided by:
- (a) A licensed and practicing:
- 1. Physician;
- 2. Osteopath:
- 3. Psychologist:
- 4. Psychiatrist; or
- (b) Other medical professional qualified to make a determination that the candidate is suffering from a severe disabling condition.
- (3) The documentation filed to substantiate the reason for vacancy may be challenged, in writing, by:
- (a) The governing authority of an opposing party;
- (b) An opposing candidate; or
- (c) A registered voter.
- (4)(a) The Secretary of State shall review all documentation relating to the reason for a vacancy.
- (b) If he determines that additional documentation is required, he shall request a review:
- 1. Of the medical evidence of a severe disabling condition filed with the notification;
- 2. By a medical professional specified in subsection (2) of this section.

Section 3. The Secretary of State shall not certify that a vacancy exists if he determines that the documentation filed to substantiate the reason for the vacancy does not establish that a vacancy exists because of:

- (1) Death;
- (2) Disqualification to hold the office sought; or
- (3) A severe disabling condition which arose after the nomination. (17 Ky.R. 155; eff. 9-13-90.)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. If I am seeking office as Republican or Democratic candidate must I be registered as a member of that specific party and which filing form do I use?

Yes. Candidates must be eligible to vote in their party's primary to be eligible to have their name printed on the ballot as a candidate of that party. For partisan offices other than President and Governor/Lt. Governor, the filing form is a Notification and Declaration (SBE 66) on page 24.

2. If I am seeking office as an Independent or political group candidate must I be registered Independent or registered as a member of a political group?

Yes. A candidate's registration status on January 1 preceding the general election for which the person seeks to be a candidate can not be Republican or Democrat. For partisan offices other than President and Governor/Lt. Governor, the filing forms are a Statement of Candidacy (SBE 59A) & Nominating Petition (SBE 59 & 59-2) on page 28 and 29-30.

3. What is the deadline date to change party affiliation to be a candidate of a specific party or an independent or political group candidate?

December 31st is the last date for an individual to change party affiliation with the county clerk to be eligible as a candidate in the subsequent primary of that specific party or to be eligible as an independent or political group candidate in a general election.

4. If I am a registered Republican or Democrat and do not file for office as a Party (Rep. or Dem.) candidate may I seek office as an Independent candidate in the general election.

No. To be eligible as an Independent candidate in a general election the candidate must have changed their party affiliation by the deadline of December $31^{\rm st}$ preceding the general election for which the person seeks to be a candidate.

5. What is the candidate filing deadline?

For Republican and Democratic candidates:

The last Tuesday in January (4:00 p.m.) preceding the day fixed by law for holding the primary election.

Example for 2008: January 29, 2008

For most Independent and political group/organization candidates:

The filing deadlines are April 1 (4:00 p.m.) for statement of candidacy and the second Tuesday in August (4:00 p.m.) preceding the general election for which the person seeks to be a candidate for filing the required petition. For President and Vice President in the general election the filing deadline is not later than the Friday following the first Tuesday in September preceding the date fixed for the election of electors.

Example for 2008:

Statement of Candidacy filing deadline: April 1, 2008 (Candidates for federal office and partisan city offices in cities of the second to sixth class are exempt from filing a statement of candidacy.)

Example for 2008:

Nominating petition filing deadline for candidates excluding President and Vice President: August 12, 2008

Example for 2008:

President & Vice President nominating petition and certificate of nomination for electors of President and Vice President:

September 5, 2008

6. Who do I file my papers with to be a candidate?

- a. The Secretary of State if the office sought is voted for by the electors of more than one (1) county.
- (ex: Commonwealth's Attorney, Members of Congress,
- Members of the General Assembly; and all Judges
- of the Court).
- b. The County Clerk if the office sought is voted for by electors of the county (excluding Judges of the Court) or a district less than a county.
- (ex: candidates voted for by a city whose boundaries extend beyond a single county file with the county clerk in county in which candidate resides).

7. How much is the candidate filing fee?

For statewide elected office or congress	\$500
For Commonwealth's Attorney	\$200
Judge of the Court	\$200
For General Assembly	
For office in city of 5 th & 6 th class	\$ 20
For all other partisan offices (excluding President/Vice	\$ 50
President & Gov/Lt. Gov	

8. What form of payment is acceptable for the filing fee?

The Secretary of State accepts personal checks, campaign account checks, cash or money order. Candidates who file with the County Clerk should contact the county clerk in their county of residence for acceptable forms of filing fee payment.

9. What is the earliest date that I may file as a candidate (excluding Presidential primary) for an office?

No earlier than the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November of the year preceding the year the office will appear on the ballot.

10. How many signatures must I have to file as a candidate?

If filing as a Republican or Democrat: * Two (2) *The two (2) individuals must be registered voters of the same political party as the candidate and reside in the district or jurisdiction from which the candidate seeks nomination.

If filing as Independent or political group/organization candidate, the required number varies by office:

State officer or any officer for whom all the electors of

11. Which filing form do I use to file for the nonpartisan office of school board, soil and water conservation district supervisor or a nonpartisan city office?

The filing form is a nominating petition (SBE 60A and 60A-2) on page 35. In addition to filing the nominating petition, school board candidates are required to file an affidavit for candidacy and membership on page 37.

12. Must a candidate be registered with a specific party affiliation to file for a Court of Justice office and which filing form do I use?

No. The candidate must be a registered voter but all judicial offices are nonpartisan and no party designation or emblem of any kind nor any sign indicating any candidate's political belief or party affiliation shall be used on voting machines or special ballots. The filing form is a Court of Justice Nominating Petition (SBE 68) on page 39.

13. What is the deadline for withdrawing as a candidate?

Candidates may withdraw at anytime; **however**, if a candidate does not want their name to appear on the ballot, they must officially withdraw prior to the certification of candidates. Certification for a primary election is not later than the second Monday after the filing deadline for the primary and not later than the second Monday after the filing deadline for the general election except in a Presidential election year. The certification date in a Presidential election year is not later than the Friday following the first Tuesday in September preceding the date fixed by law for the election of electors.

Example for 2008 Primary: February 11, 2008 Example for 2008 General: September 8, 2008

14. Where do I file the withdrawal notice?

Candidates must file the notice of withdrawal with the same filing official, Secretary of State or County Clerk, that received the candidate's filing documents.

15. Will my filing fee be returned if I withdraw?

No. There is no statutory authority for returning a filing fee.

16. What are the most common errors made by candidates seeking ballot access?

- a. Title of Office an District Number if applicable omitted or improperly stated.
- b.Name in full as desired on ballot not conforming to statute requirements of KRS 118.129.
- c. Failure to sign and/or improper notarization of candidate's signature.
- d.Failure of candidate to verify voter registration and party affiliation of the two persons signing the filing documents. For partisan offices, must be registered voters and members of same party as the candidate and reside in the district or jurisdiction of which the candidate is seeking office. For nonpartisan offices, signers must be registered voters and reside in the district or jurisdiction of which the candidate is seeking office.
- e. Failure to sign and/or improper notarization of the two signors signatures.
- f. Failure to submit the required filing fee.
- g. Failure to submit the filing by the deadline date and time.
