LES ELECTIONS AU NOUVEAU – BRUNSWICK**

**1984-2006**

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## INTRODUCTION

When attempting to understand New Brunswick's history, election data is critical, but it does not tell the whole story. Scandals, trends, events, and other happenings cannot be so easily expressed through numbers, though all help to define our province's history.

The decades following the bicentennial were characterized by political firsts and a grim economic situation. A failing economy, blamed predominantly on Ottawa's decision to cut transfer payments to the have-not provinces, saw little improvement during these years. Canada's longest serving Premier, Richard Hatfield, facing scandal and an historic victory by the Liberal Opposition, resigned. The Liberal government, under Frank McKenna, became Canada's second unopposed government.

The bicentennial was ushered in under the leadership of Progressive Conservative Premier Richard Hatfield. During his time in office Hatfield was credited with doing more to improve Francophone/Anglophone relations than any other Premier in history. A well-known promoter of minority rights, Hatfield implemented the Official Languages Act in 1969, making New Brunswick the only officially bilingual province in Canada. Later in his career, however, Hatfield was faced with ongoing problems of an "unsatisfactory" economy and scandal over marijuana possession, of which he was later acquitted. Hoping to avoid election until the scandal died down, Hatfield opted to remain in office for the maximum term of five years, before resigning over his 1987 defeat to Liberal leader Frank McKenna. He served as New Brunswick's Premier for a total of seventeen years.

After his resignation as party leader, Hatfield was appointed to the Senate by then Prime Minister Brian Mulroney in 1990. His career as a senator was cut short, however, when he died of a brain tumor in 1991 at sixty years of age. It is likely, though it was undiagnosed, that he carried this tumor while in office as Premier. Hatfield was posthumously invested into the Order of New Brunswick by Queen Elizabeth

The Order of New Brunswick is the highest honour of the province, which recognizes citizens who have made outstanding contributions to New Brunswick and its residents

McKenna's landslide 1987 election victory, ending a seventeen year reign by Hatfield, saw the Liberal Party claim all fifty-eight seats in the Legislature, making McKenna the second Canadian Premier to ever serve without opposition. Many believed that the House would be unable to function without an opposition, but McKenna took special steps to ensure that the opposition's voices would still be heard. His party mounted a small Opposition, consisting of a paid staff of three and a group of volunteers, who were charged with voicing the opposition views outside of the Chamber. Still, many politicians turned to the media to voice their opinions. McKenna also established a government-funded research office within the Legislative Library in order to provide the unelected opposition party members with the tools to undertake research they were not able to afford out of office. The research office employed three professional researchers. McKenna strongly believed in equality of opportunity and established many commissions and committees to this effect.

In 1991 the McKenna government commissioned an independent electoral boundary redistribution commission. The Electoral Boundaries Commission's goal was to redefine electoral boundaries to ensure equality of voting power, effective representation, as well as respect for population size and natural boundaries. In 1994 the recommendations of the Commission came into effect and the number of constituencies within the province was reduced from fifty-eight to fifty-five.

In power as both the Meech Lake and Charlottetown Accords fell through, McKenna was known for taking strong stances on national issues, a habit which earned New Brunswick a place in the national spot-light. Despite McKenna's best efforts to promote the establishment of new businesses to reduce national dependency, mainly in the field of telecommunication, such as call centers, New Brunswick's economy continued to have a bleak outlook when McKenna stepped down as party leader in 1997, keeping his word to resign after ten years as Premier. In 2004, Premier McKenna, like Premier Hatfield before him, was awarded the Order of New Brunswick for his achievements.

Following McKenna's resignation, the Progressive Conservatives took power under Bernard Lord, New Brunswick's youngest Premier at thirty-three. The Progressive Conservatives had their strongest victory in history under his leadership, winning forty-four of fifty-five seats. Lord subsequently increased his party's seat count to forty-seven by winning three by-elections.

The Lord administration has been referred to as low-profile and business-like, preferring to stress results rather than ambitions. During his election campaign Lord vowed to fulfill twenty promises in two hundred days, promises which included: raising minimum wage, hiring more nurses, putting more money towards education, removing high-way tolls, etc. The Premier achieved, as he put it, nineteen and three-fourths of his promises, in the allotted time, but failed to completely eliminate tolls from highways. Still, he vowed to complete this task as soon as possible, and ultimately did.

The Lord administration has focused on improving New Brunswick's economy through cuts to income and corporate taxes in order to promote business over the long-term. The Premier, seen by many as charismatic, is a strong believer in long-term solutions. Lord's policies are about results, not flash.

Though never Premier, another politician has stood out during the past twenty years. Elizabeth Weir, the first woman ever to lead a New Brunswick political party, was elected as New Democratic Party leader in 1988, and became the first female leader of a party ever to sit in the Chamber when she was elected as a Member of the Legislative Assembly for Saint John Harbour in 1991. Known as a brilliant speaker, Weir was a prominent and oft-quoted figure, even though her party never held more than one seat in the Chamber at any given time. She earned a "hard-as-nails" reputation for her tireless efforts to protect the disadvantaged and defend against discrimination. Weir announced that she would be stepping down as party leader in 2004, to care for her mother and brother, both of whom were seriously ill, but agreed to stay on until a new leader could be elected.

To better understand our history, election results must be interpreted within the framework of the time period. Changes in parties, leadership, and seat distribution are all directly influenced by the period. To understand the statistics one must comprehend the setting.

## INTRODUCTION

Lorsqu'on tente de comprendre l'histoire du Nouveau-Brunswick, les données sur les élections sont cruciales, mais ne révèlent pas tout. Les scandales, les tendances, les événements et d'autres faits ne peuvent être exprimés facilement par des chiffres, bien qu'ils contribuent tous à définir l'histoire de notre province.

Les décennies qui suivent le bicentenaire sont caractérisées par des premières sur la scène politique et par une très mauvaise

situation économique. La responsabilité du déclin de l'économie, qui connaît peu d'améliorations durant la période en question, est surtout attribuée à la décision d'Ottawa de réduire les paiements de transfert aux provinces défavorisées. Le premier ministre provincial qui a occupé le poste le plus longtemps dans l'histoire du Canada, Richard Hatfield, démissionne à la suite d'un scandale et d'une victoire historique du Parti libéral. Le gouvernement libéral, sous la direction de Frank McKenna, devient le deuxième gouvernement du Canada à ne pas avoir d'opposition à la Chambre.

Le bicentenaire est célébré pendant le mandat du premier ministre progressiste-conservateur Richard Hatfield. Au cours de ses années au pouvoir, Richard Hatfield se voit attribuer le mérite d'avoir contribué davantage que tout autre premier ministre provincial de l'histoire à l'amélioration des relations entre francophones et anglophones. Défenseur bien connu des droits des minorités, Richard Hatfield met en oeuvre en 1969 la *Loi sur les langues officielles*, qui fait du Nouveau-Brunswick la seule province officiellement bilingue du Canada. Plus tard au cours de sa carrière, il doit composer avec les problèmes continus qui découlent d'une économie « insatisfaisante » et d'un scandale lié à une accusation de possession de marijuana, pour laquelle il est plus tard acquitté. Dans l'espoir d'éviter des élections jusqu'à ce que le scandale se dissipe, Richard Hatfield décide de rester en poste pendant le mandat maximum de cinq ans, avant de démissionner à la suite de la défaite que lui inflige en 1987 le chef libéral Frank McKenna. Au total, Richard Hatfield est premier ministre du Nouveau-Brunswick

pendant 17 ans.

Après sa démission en tant que chef du parti, Richard Hatfield est nommé au Sénat en 1990 par le premier ministre de l'époque, Brian Mulroney. Toutefois, sa carrière de sénateur est courte, et il meurt d'une tumeur au cerveau en 1991, à l'âge de 60 ans. Bien que la tumeur n'ait pas été diagnostiquée, il est probable que Richard Hatfield l'avait déjà lorsqu'il était premier ministre. Il est nommé à l'Ordre du Nouveau-Brunswick, à titre posthume, par la reine Elizabeth.

L'Ordre du Nouveau-Brunswick est la plus haute distinction honorifique conférée par la

province. Il est remis à des personnes qui ont fourni des contributions exceptionnelles au Nouveau-Brunswick et à sa population.

La victoire écrasante de M. McKenna aux élections de 1987 met fin au règne de M. Hatfield, qui a duré 17 ans, et voit le Parti libéral remporter la totalité de 58 sièges de l'Assemblée législative. M. McKenna devient le deuxième premier ministre provincial du Canada à gouverner sans opposition officielle. De nombreuses personnes croient que la Chambre ne pourra pas fonctionner sans une opposition officielle, mais M. McKenna prend des mesures spéciales pour que l'opposition puisse tout de même se faire entendre. Son parti met sur pied une petite opposition, composée d'un personnel rémunéré de trois personnes et d'un groupe de bénévoles, qui sont chargés de faire connaître les points de vue exprimés par l'opposition à l'extérieur de la Chambre. De nombreux politiciens se tournent néanmoins vers les médias afin d'exprimer leurs opinions. M. McKenna crée aussi un bureau de recherche financé par le gouvernement au sein de la bibliothèque de l'Assemblée législative afin de fournir aux membres des partis de l'opposition, qui n'ont pas été élus, les outils nécessaires pour entreprendre des recherches qu'ils n'ont pas les moyens d'effectuer en ne siégeant pas à la Chambre. Le bureau de recherche emploie trois chercheurs professionnels. M. McKenna croit fermement à l'égalité des chances et, à cette fin, crée un grand nombre de commissions et de comités.

En 1991, le gouvernement McKenna met sur pied une commission indépendante de délimitation des circonscriptions électorales. L'objectif de la Commission de délimitation des circonscriptions électorales est de redéfinir les limites des circonscriptions afin d'assurer l'égalité du droit de vote, une représentation efficace ainsi que le respect de l'effectif de la population et des frontières naturelles. En 1994, les recommandations de la commission entrent en vigueur, et le nombre des circonscriptions de la province passe de 58 à 55.

À l'époque de l'échec de l'Accord du lac Meech et de l'accord de Charlottetown, M. McKenna est connu pour ses positions fermes sur les questions nationales, une habitude qui vaut au Nouveau-Brunswick une place prépondérante sur la scène nationale. Malgré tous les efforts que M. McKenna déploie pour promouvoir la création de nouvelles entreprises afin de réduire la dépendance à l'égard du gouvernement fédéral, surtout dans le secteur des télécommunications, par exemple, les centre

d'appels, les perspectives économiques du Nouveau-Brunswick demeurent sombres lorsque M. McKenna démissionne comme chef du parti en 1997. Il tient ainsi la promesse qu'il a faite de démissionner après avoir été premier ministre pendant 10 ans. En 2004, le premier ministre McKenna, comme avant lui le premier ministre Hatfield, reçoit l'Ordre du Nouveau-Brunswick pour ses réalisations.

Après la démission de M. McKenna, les Progressistes-Conservateurs prennent le pouvoir sous la direction de Bernard Lord ; à 33 ans, il est le plus jeune premier ministre du Nouveau-Brunswick. Sous sa direction, les Progressistes-Conservateurs remportent leur plus grande victoire de l'histoire en décrochant 44 des 55 sièges. Par la suite, M. Lord fait passer à 47 le nombre de sièges de son parti en remportant trois élections partielles.

Le gouvernement Lord a été décrit comme étant discret et pragmatique, préférant mettre l'accent sur les résultats plutôt que sur les ambitions. Au cours de sa campagne électorale, M. Lord s'engage à remplir 20 promesses en 200 jours, notamment à augmenter le salaire minimum, à engager du personnel infirmier additionnel, à consacrer davantage d'argent à l'éducation, à supprimer le péage, etc. Le premier ministre déclare avoir rempli 19  $\frac{3}{4}$  de ses promesses dans le délai qu'il s'est fixé, mais ne réussit pas à supprimer complètement le péage. Pourtant, il s'engage à terminer la tâche dès que possible et, en fin de compte, il y réussit.

Le gouvernement Lord met l'accent sur l'amélioration de l'économie du Nouveau-Brunswick au moyen de réductions de l'impôt sur le revenu et de l'impôt applicable aux corporations afin de promouvoir les affaires à long terme. Le premier ministre, considéré par bien des gens comme étant charismatique, croit fermement aux solutions à long terme. Les politiques de M. Lord visent à obtenir des résultats et non à éblouir.

Bien qu'elle n'ait jamais été première ministre, une politicienne se distingue depuis 20 ans. Elizabeth Weir, la première femme à être chef d'un parti politique au Nouveau-Brunswick, est élue chef du Nouveau Parti démocratique en 1988 et devient la première femme chef d'un parti à siéger à la Chambre en se faisant élire députée de la circonscription de Saint John Harbour en 1991. Avec une réputation de brillante oratrice, M<sup>me</sup> Weir est une personnalité éminente, qui est souvent citée, même si son parti n'a jamais détenu plus d'un siège à la Chambre. Elle se taille une réputation de fermeté

pour les efforts inlassables qu'elle déploie afin de protéger les personnes défavorisées et de défendre les gens contre la discrimination. M<sup>me</sup> Weir annonce qu'elle démissionne comme chef du parti en 2004 afin de prendre soin de sa mère et de son frère, tous les deux gravement malades, mais elle accepte de demeurer à son poste jusqu'à l'élection d'un nouveau chef.

Pour mieux comprendre notre histoire, il est nécessaire d'interpréter les résultats des élections dans le contexte de la période considérée. Les changements au sein des partis, les changements de chefs et ceux qui touchent la répartition des sièges sont tous directement influencés par la période. Pour comprendre les statistiques, il faut comprendre le contexte.
